Sept 6 day trip 2012 on the American Angler (Use to be the Turners Rod & Reel Club Trip) By Richard Jenkins

We were informed by Lori the boarding master for the American Angler that sign up's would start at 7:00AM. People started showing up at around 4:30 AM and forming a line to board the AA. When Glenn, Martha and I arrived at 6:45 AM we were fifth in line. The sign up went well and around 10:30 we where told we could board the boat. Everyone got settled in and off we went to the bait receivers to load our precious bait. It took over two hours to get the job done because the bait was not in good shape but we found what we needed and off we went on our adventure.

Next morning we started trolling and it did not take long and we had a three way hook up on Albacore, nice way to start the trip. We trolled the rest of the day and picked up a couple more Albacore and some Blue Fin Tuna.

Day three found us still trolling but on this day everything we caught were Yellow Fin Tuna of various sizes. We where starting to put together a nice trip.

Day four was a different day, on this day we found the Yellow Tail and they wanted to play. The fish were averaging around 25 pounds and boy were they tough. We caught them on the yoyo, dropper loop and sliding sinker with squid. What ever your choice was you were bit. I caught 9 for the morning. Everyone on board caught all they wanted. Then it was back to the trolling where we caught some more Tuna.

Day five was the same more Yellow Tail, on both day's the bite started early Am and lasted until around 9:00 AM, but on this day instead of trolling right after we went to a place where we caught and released some of the biggest Calico I haven't seen in a long time. I personally caught a 4.7, 5.9 and a 6.5 plus many more of various sizes. Again everyone caught all they wanted and all released to swim again. Next we did go outside and did the trolling thing again. For those of you who don't know while we trolled a crewmember would be up in the Crows Nest with a very high powered pair of Bino's looking for kelp paddies. Well he found a big one for us and it was loaded with Dorado. We made two passes on it and caught over 60 of the better grade average around twenty pounds. What a fun day.

Friday day 6 we were trolling again and on one stop Glenn Bummer hooked a bait fish that would turn out to be the 1st place Jack Pot fish for the trip. We put a bunch more on the boat then it was time to head for home.

As always the food was fantastic and the new people we met on the trip were great.

The Turner Club had a good showing we had 7 members on the trip. Glenn and Martha Bummer, Brian Peale, Dennis Dickson, Scott Taves, Rick McPherson and myself Rich Jenkins. Plus many people we have picked up over the years. We sure did miss Jim Clough, Jerry Watkins, Warren Harper, Laney Hackman, Ernie Branch and Tall Paul Dawson. Hope you guy's can join us next year. Maybe we can get this trip back to a Turners Club trip.
