Kendall was raised as the son of a soldier / civil engineer and a school teacher in various parts of the world. Kendall's high school years were spent in Prince George's County, MD, a mere 2 and 1/2 miles from College Park Airport (the oldest continuously operated airport in the world). It was ironic because Kendall had traveled all over the world and would often get cockpit tours without ever thinking "I too can fly an airplane."

Kendall earned his degree in Computer Science at the University of Southern California. Shortly after graduation, Kendall earned his Airmans Certificate (Private Pilot License) at 23 and bought his first plane at the age of 24. While working in Southern California as a computer scientist, developing intelligent computer systems at TRW, the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL), and Xerox, Kendall continued flying throughout the western region of the United States.

His work brought him back to the DC/Maryland/and Virginia (DMV) region and gave me the opportunity to fly my plane solo across the United States in 1986, where he continued his career as a Knowledge Engineer, developing expert systems.

As his technical experience grew, so did his desire to own and fly faster, more complex aircraft that would permit him to explore a wide variety of aviation adventures in the Eastern region of the USA, as well as the Caribbean. That desire necessitated, he earned his instrument and multi-engine privileges.

Flying and technology has so greatly enhanced his life, Kendall enthusiastically wants to share his knowledge and experiences with others. His is part of the aviation ministry at his church. Kendall participates working with youth on simulators as well as assisting with the coordination of tours of the latest aviation advancements at the Patuxent River Naval Air Station. He currently supports projects for the next generation aircraft carrier landing systems and unmanned carrier aviation as a Systems Engineer/Integration Architect, employed by his own company.
