It was suggested we find out if we could put in at a Sheriff's auction. Dale will put together specifications to present at the next meeting for the purchase of a new truck. He asked the Board for input on options, and wants to consult with the city and county as to how they standardize specifications. After discussion the Board agreed the new vehicle should be the smaller or Ranger size and have a low gear ratio.

Dale reported the last update on the snow pack was SNOW PACK 62% and precipitation was 75%.
