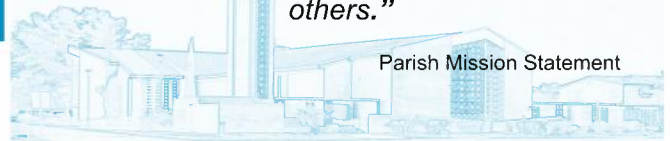

Baptisms—Baptismal arrangements must be made by the PARENTS of the child at the Parish Office. Parents and godparents *must* attend a baptismal preparation class before the baptism. Other requirements will be discussed at the initial interview.

Marriage preparation is to begin at least 6 months prior to the wedding. It is strongly recommended that a couple planning to be married at St. Joseph contact the Parish before making any contractual arrangements with a facility for their reception. During the initial interview with the priest of the Parish, the couple will be provided with all the necessary information needed for their preparation experience.

Many times, I told the Bishop that instead of studying the Philosophy of Hans Urs Von Balthasar and Martin Heidegger, the Theology of Karl Rahner and Thomas Aquinas, I should have taken up courses in electrical, plumbing, landscaping, interior design, etc. Why, because this are exactly what I had to deal with. But, I must confess, I enjoyed it.

INVESTING IN YOUR OWN PARISH! Since May, we have spent over \$100,000.00 in improvements in our Parish. Thanks to very generous parishioners who dipped into their own resources to make this happen. As a result, we have done the following:

Renovation of Healy Hall – new paint, new porcelain tile flooring, tile décor, new audio visual equipment, stage lights, purchased 350 brand new banquet chairs, repair of air-conditioning system, stage carpeting, repainting of the old metal chairs to be used by our school children and frontage plant decor.

New Church windows – We changed the church windows to double-pane, energy efficient glass which brings in a lot of light and the exterior mirror effects update the look of our 50 year old church. We should see the power savings at the same time next year.

Landscaping – We have begun the process of landscaping beginning with the frontage of our school and extending towards the front and north side of the church. We also purchased a new professional ride on lawn mower for our school's soccer field and courtyard.

School cleaning, general upkeep and painting - At the end of the last school year, all the furniture from every classroom was removed so that the floors can be stripped, waxed and buffed. The "Ramada" was power washed, bathroom doors and urinals fixed, broken glass panes replaced, minor painting done at the entrance and the bathrooms. We have also contracted the services of a new cleaning service – Environment Control.

¡INVIRTIENDO EN SU PROPIA PARROQUIA! Desde mayo, hemos gastado mas de \$100,000.00 en mejorar nuestra parroquia. Gracias a los generosos parroquianos que echaron mano de sus propios recursos para hacer que esto sucediera. Como resultado, hemos hecho lo siguiente:

Renovación del Healy Hall - pintura nueva, pisos nuevos de porcelana, decoración de azulejos, nuevo equipo audiovisual, luces en el escenario, se compraron 350 sillas nuevas para banquetes, se reparó el sistema de aire acondicionado, se alfombró el escenario, se repintaron las sillas de metal viejas para ser utilizadas por nuestros niños de la escuela y decoró la fachada del jardín.

Nuevas ventanas en la iglesia - Cambiamos las ventanas de la iglesia a doble cristal, vidrio eficiente de la energía que nos mejora la iluminación interior y los efectos del vidrio exterior actualizan el aspecto de nuestra iglesia de 50 años de edad. Al mismo tiempo, veremos los ahorros de energía el próximo año.

Jardinería - Hemos comenzado el proceso de jardinería, comenzando con la fachada de nuestra escuela y extendiéndose hacia el frente y lado norte de la iglesia. También compramos una maquina nueva corta-césped profesional para el campo de fútbol y el patio de nuestra escuela.

Limpieza de la escuela, mantenimiento general y pintura - Al final del último año escolar, todos los muebles de cada salón de clases fueron removidos para que los pisos pudieran ser limpiados, encerados y pulidos. La "ramada" fue lavada con maquina eléctrica, las puertas de los baños y urinarios arreglados, los cristales rotos reemplazados, pintura menor se hizo en la entrada de los baños. También hemos contratado los servicios de un nuevo servicio de limpieza - Control Ambiental.

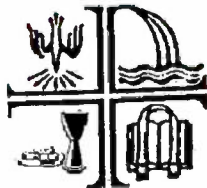

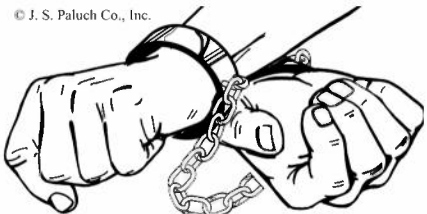
