



We have spent much time studying about the Spiritual Gifts. We learned that Spiritual Gifts are given to members of the Body of Christ when we are born again and filled with the Holy Spirit. We learned that the Spiritual Gifts are given for the purpose of equipping the saints for ministry, for edifying (building up) the Body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man - to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ. (Ephesians 4:11-13) Each child of God is to use his/her Spiritual Gift to extend the Kingdom of God on this earth, until Jesus splits the eastern sky at His return. (Matthew 24:27)

As the saints serve as walking billboards, advertising God's redemptive love, as we demonstrate the Fruit of the Spirit, the Kingdom of God will extend across the earth. The unsaved will take notice and, by so doing, many will become aware that here is a better way to live, than the way which the god of this world(Satan) has blinded and deceived them to believe. As the saints demonstrate the Fruit of the Spirit, many of the unsaved will decide they no longer want to continue to live the carnal (fleshly) way of life, which results in pain, misery, and destruction.

The Fruit of the Spirit is the nature of Jesus Christ produced in the lives of the saints, by the Holy Spirit. The <u>Fruit of the Spirit</u> is the manifestation of a Christian's transformed life. As we study and understand the attributes of the "Ninefold" Fruit produced in us by the Holy Spirit, we will mature in our walk with Christ. The Fruit of the Spirit displays the development of a person's character as they are transformed to the image of Christ. The Fruit is the evidence of a true Holy Spirit filled Christian.

If you notice, when I speak of the "Gifts of the Spirit" I use Gifts in the plural sense, however when I speak of the "Fruit of the Spirit" I use Fruit in the singular sense. Why?

Paul is saying, when we are guided by the Holy Spirit, the <u>Fruit</u> of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control is given to us as a whole package, like a Fruit Basket. Spiritual Gifts are not given to any one person as a package – one person may be given the Gift of Teaching, while another is given the Gift of Healing – however, every born again, Holy Spirit filled person is given a package of <u>Fruit</u> of the Spirit. The Fruit has nine qualities. All of these are the <u>Fruit</u> of a life lived for Jesus and guided by the Holy Spirit. So, Paul's expression of "The Fruit of the Spirit" refers to one (1) Fruit with nine qualities, and not multiple fruits.
