Around noon, Capt. Tim headed towards the shore and anchored on a Kelp/hard bottom area off Del Mar. The fish responded immediately to Live bait and we caught a mix bag of fish. Most Calico's were shorts with several keepers; white fish, mixture of rock fish, mackeral and sheephead.

Our last stop, Capt. Tim moved up the coast off Solana Beach where we Fished in similar grounds. Here we caught more bass with several keepers.
