

### What is TRIAD?

**TRIAD is a COUNTY** agreement between the Sheriff's office, local Police departments, and senior adults in the community working together to reduce and prevent crimes against seniors

*TRIAD is a COUNTY-WIDE* joint approach to crime issues that affect older citizens. It is a community service offering crime prevention tips & lessons for mature adults

*TRIAD is* accomplished through monthly Seniors and Law EnforcementTogether (S.A.L.T.) lessons, guest speaking/teaching by the TRIAD Coordinator, and senior oriented events throughout the county

## All Triad programs are a *free community service*

### Personal Safety Tips

- Participate in a monthly prevention lesson to receive a new information & tips each month
- Watch weekly safety tips on Facebook by following Oklahoma County Sheriff's Office
- Lock your car door immediately when you get into your car
- Carry a cell phone and keep it turned on and charged
- Never wear a cross body purse
- Never carry your wallet in your back pocket & pair down what you carry
- Always be aware of your surroundings & identify exits
- Limit your distractions by having your keys in hand and your packages secure before you leave the place of business
- Always use a peep hole or window to determine the identity of someone before unlocking the door
- Have your keys in your hand and ready to push your panic button should you need to draw attention
- Glance in your backseat before opening your car door

# Prevent Consumer Fraud

- Keep your devices updated—cell phone, laptop, tablet, etc
- Always take your time when making a financial decision and don't be afraid to say "no"
- Beware of offers that sound too good to be true—they usually are
- Do not share your personal or financial information
- Do not answer your phone except for immediate family membersyour caller ID can be "spoofed"
- Do not click on links in texts or emails unless you requested the link
- Do not pay taxes or handling fees on a "free prize"
- Beware of open wi-fi networks
- Do not overshare on social media
- Add a PIN, pattern, or biometric to your cell phone
- Never pay in gift cards, crypto or wire transfer — gift cards are for giving and receiving gifts ONLY
- When shopping online check out as a guest and do not save your information on the site
