

MINUTES
WALKER ART COMMITTEE MEETING
February 18, 2016

The Walker Art Committee met on Thursday, February 18, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall with the following present: Wanda Taylor, Chairman; Candy Hewes, Marcia Mader, John Wilson and Sonia Jones. Absent: Marcia Wiltsey, Jenelle Klehammer and Phyllis Adams. Also present: City Manager Joyce Martin.

Wanda called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

MINUTES

A motion was made by John, seconded by Sonia to approve the minutes of January 21, 2016. The motion was unanimously approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer's Report shows a balance of \$10,352.38. Additional revenues have been received for the juried art show. The report was approved as presented.

CURATOR'S REPORT

Sonia said that she had selected some pieces from the Garnett Art Collection and hung them in the west gallery.

Joyce said that Robert Cugno would be giving a large portion of his personal collection to the museum at Washburn University.

OLD BUSINESS

Jenelle has been working on getting the gallery signs completed. They should be available soon.

Sonia gave a report on the juried art show that will close to entries on Saturday, February 20, 2016. City crews will be asked to hang the WAC special event banners no later than the first of March. Marcia Wiltsey will receive and catalog all entries. Joyce will make sure the large, black trash sacks are available. Sonia will get names to Joyce for the wall labels that will be made by Garnett Publishing. Jenelle and her husband will be responsible to hang the entries, take them down at the end of the show and get them ready to be shipped back to the respective artists. Joyce said that funds would be available from the creative arts grant to help pay some of the juried show expenses. Marcia Mader prepared an article about the show for both papers however **The Advocate** was the only one that included it in their paper.

Marcia Mader reported that she had researched information on the spheres of light. More information will be presented at the next meeting. The idea came from Greensboro, North Carolina.

NEW BUSINESS

Desiree Donovan, Chamber administrative assistant and Carol Barnes, Chamber Board member attended the meeting to discuss the Tastes & Talents that will be held on Saturday, October 8, 2016. The event, which has been revamped and expanded, will start at the gallery at 4:00 p.m. This is the same date as the Lake Garnett Grand Prix Revival. Members agreed to be present at the gallery. It was agreed to make sure the posters featuring letters about the collection will be done and exhibited that day. The pictures of the letters need to be 600 dpi.

The date for the next meeting is March 17, 2016 at 4:00 p.m. at City Hall. Very little business will be discussed as Sonia would like for members to prepare thank you cards to those people who entered the juried art show.

There being no further business to discuss, Wanda adjourned the meeting at 5:05 p.m.
