

## Memory vs grace by lcl

**Psa 51:1** *To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came to him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba.* Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your loving-kindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions.

**Psa 51:2** Wash me completely from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

**Psa 51:3** For I confess my transgressions; and my sin is ever before me.

**Joh 14:26** But the Comforter, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things and bring all things to your remembrance, whatever I have said to you.

**Exo 33:20** And He said, You cannot see My face. For there no man can see Me and live.

**Exo 33:21** And Jehovah said, Behold! *There is a place by Me, and you shall stand upon a rock.*

**Exo 33:22** And it will be, while My glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by.

*But, more than this, there comes a sadness at my having failed in the eyes of God and caused him sadness as well. Against all this there is only one hope that is given below.*

**Joh 14:27** Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

*I must continually remind myself to give these burdens to Christ who is the only one capable of carrying them and hiding them from the remembrance of the Father. Christ bears the sins of all who believe and trust in him to cancel*
