

Frost, William Mayhew

William Mayhew Frost, 86, resident of Country Gardens in Pigeon and formerly of Broken Rocks in Port Austin, died Monday, Sept. 24, 2007.

He was born in Fort Worth, Texas on Dec. 30, 1920, the son of Caroline Eliza (Mayhew) and Royal Harword Frost.

He grew up in Shreveport, La. and graduated with honors in accounting from Tulane University, New Orleans, La. Following graduation he received his CPA in the state of Louisiana.
