



2024 Desert Sky Archers Tournament Point Series

DSA is proud to announce we are continuing our tournament points series for 2024. We are adding more tournaments as the series grows. All archers that enter the tournaments are eligible and automatically entered. There is no additional cost. Archers must stay in the same bow, gender, and age discipline in all tournaments. Some tournaments have combined ages/genders and bows. The registration for Shamrock is combined but it will be set up for you to select the division you will be shooting in the points series. If you skip the Shamrock, then it will be by the Vegas Vengeance selection. By July Juggernaut, you must have shot in one of the tournaments to be eligible, July Juggernaut will have Points Series selections. Tournaments that do not have age or gender separation do not impact this eligibility. Please see the tournament list and dates below. For 2024, we will allow 2 drops, two lowest tournament results are dropped. We are also implementing a points system to keep the competition tight through the entire year. Points system described below. Archers that decide to use a drop and shoot in another discipline remove their eligibility from points series (no trophy hunting). I.e. U18 Male Compound in Shamrock selects U18 Male Recurve for Vegas, removes eligibility to compete in points series.

- Shamrock Slam qualifying round. U13 and U15 shoot in Youth, U18 and older must shoot in adult. March 1-3, 2024. Must participate in eliminations too.
- Vegas Vengeance completed tournament. All divisions offered. May 18-19, 2024.
- July Juggernaut qualifying round. Ranked by archers' registration selection from Shamrock Slam. All ages are combined. July 27-28, 2024.
- Summer Sizzle completed tournament. All divisions offered. August 3-4, 2024.
- DSA Iron Archer qualifying round. Ranked by archers' registration selection from Shamrock Slam. All ages are combined for tournament itself. September 28-29, 2024.
- November Tournament. U13 and U15 shoot in Youth, U18 and older must shoot in adult. Nov 21-22, 2024.
- Candy Cane Crunch complete tournament. U13 and U15 shoot in Youth, U18 and older must shoot in adult. December 16-17, 2024

Winners of each division win a trophy and a \$40 in cash. Trophy given to 2nd and 3rd place in each division.

Each tournament will have finishing position points awarded by how they finish against archers in their own division and class set forth by the Shamrock Slam (and Summer Sizzle, they would

have to be the same to be eligible). Archers' points are not based on how they finish against other archers not of their class and discipline.

Points are based on the following

- 1st 15 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 2nd 12 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 3rd 10 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 4th 9 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 5th 8 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 6th 7 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 7th 6 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 8th 5 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 9th 4 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 10th 3 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 11th 2 Points + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.
- 12th + 1 Point + the number of archers competing in the tournament in their class and division.

If any one of the top 3 positions have a tie at the end of the Candy Cane Crunch, there will be a one arrow shoot off after the Candy Cane last qualifying round to select finish positions. If archer is not present at Candy Cane then they lose the one arrow shoot off by default. If neither are present, it will be decided by a coin flip by a randomly selected individual.

Ties at any one particular tournament will share that position and its points. If two archers tie for second, they both receive 12 points +, the next archer will come in 4th.

Ties are based on World Archery or NFAA rules set forth at any particular event.
