The Newark Police Department (NPD) would like to announce the promotion of Officer Ethan Derr to the rank of Police Sergeant. After graduating from Newark High School in 2010, he served four years with the US Marine Corps where he attained the rank of Lance Corporal. In the Corp, he served as an infantryman and was stationed for two years in Camp Lejeune, then two-years in Washington, D.C. as a squad leader with the Marine Corp Honor Guard. During his service he earned the Navy and Marine Corp Achievement Medal for Leadership. After being honorably discharged from the Marine Corp, Sgt.
