9 10 11	Mayor Carrie Roecks called the meeting to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.
12 13 14 15	Roll call took place. Those present were Mayor Carrie Roecks, Councilmembers Clint Stevenson, Micki Harnois, Tim Fricke, and William Benson. Councilmember Brian Laude was not in attendance. Public Works' Dave Thompson was also in attendance.
16 17	A few residents had participated in a quick tour of the lagoon facility prior to the meeting.
17 18 19 20 21	Mayor Roecks stated this meeting was to specifically discuss how we got to where we are today with the lagoon loan, and loan payment options. Approximately 20 people were in attendance for the discussion
22 23 24 25	The Mayor gave a brief background of the events that took place since the original 2012 mandate from the Dept. of Ecology. That mandate stated the town was required to bring the wastewater we were discharging into Rock Creek into compliance with Ecology standards.
26 27 28	There were some questions from the citizens, and then the mayor distributed several different spreadsheets showing loan repayment options that included adjusting rates versus not adjusting current rates for:
29	1. The original anticipated \$1.2M loan
30 31 32	 The final loan amount of \$584,332 The final \$584,332 loan after paying down \$200,000 already in reserves
33 34 35	After much discussion, the overwhelming consensus of those in attendance was to keep the existing rates and pay off the loan as quickly as possible. The conservative calculations show it will take a little over 5 years to collect what is needed.
36 37 38 39 40	Mayor Roecks said the final decision on how to handle the loan repayment would be made by council in an upcoming regular meeting.
