

Financial needs for each child:

Many children are not able to attend school because of lack of finances. Many do not go beyond primary school because of the cost.

Primary children need \$5.00 every term for development fund and examination fund.

Uniforms, which cost about \$30 for each child, are another challenge many children and guardians fail to acquire in order to go to school.

Tuition for secondary school—depending on which secondary school selected—vary in range from \$50-350 per term (that is in public or community secondary schools and not private).

As you can see by faithfully donating \$10 or even \$5 a month will greatly help the children who come up short in their financial needs to attend school and to enable us to continue supplementing their diet.
