Ten West Link Project Draft EIS Public Meetings

DCR Transmission, LLC (DCRT) has filed a right-of-way (ROW) application with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), proposing to construct, operate, and maintain a 500kV transmission line (the Project) spanning approximately 114 miles across both Arizona and California. The Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) for the proposed project was released on August 31, 2018 and marked the beginning of the 90-day comment period. The BLM invites you to attend any of three public meetings to answer questions about the proposed project or the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process. Substantive written comments on the DEIS submitted at the public meetings or prior to the close of the comment period, **November 28, 2018** will be considered in the final version of the EIS.
