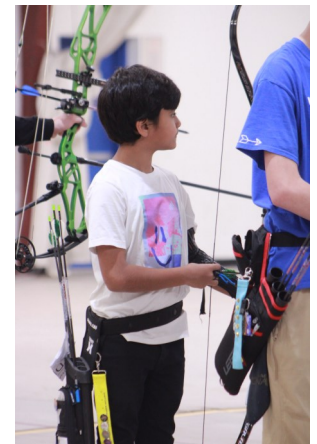

MAAPP

Tournament Format

- ⇒ 3 Arrow ends of 2 Minutes
- ⇒ 1 round of 60 arrows
- ⇒ Check [BetweenEnds](#) for your lane assignments
- ⇒ Electronic timer in use
- ⇒ Electronic and paper scoring
- ⇒ AB/CD target format-see bale layout on page 4
- ⇒ AB will shoot first on odd ends
- ⇒ CD will shoot first on even ends
- ⇒ Please make sure your archers are skilled in scoring



Dress Code

The USA Archery (USAA) Dress Code Policy applies to the following individuals when in front of the Spectator Line at USAA Sanctioned Events: athletes, coaches, managers, credentialed media, team officials, tournament officials, and archer agents.

1. Must present a professional, athletic appearance while on the field. (torn, ripped or heavily soiled clothing articles are not allowed.).
2. Shorts, skirts and skirts must be professional in appearance and length.
3. Camouflage clothing is only disallowed for broadcast/live streamed medal matches at national events and after the first cut at U.S. Team Trials Events.
4. Denim is allowed, but must not be torn, ripped or have holes. See Appendix A.
5. Leggings (tight fitting/yoga-type stretch pants) are allowed, but must not be transparent/translucent above the knee.
6. Upper garments must cover the front and back of the body, and the midriff when at full draw. They must also have sleeves.
7. Shoes must cover the entire foot unless pre-approved by USAA due to an injury or disability. Sport/athletic shoes are recommended.
8. At no time will any article that bears wording, insignias, innuendo or images determined by USAA to be offensive or inappropriate be allowed on the field of play.



Arrow Requirements

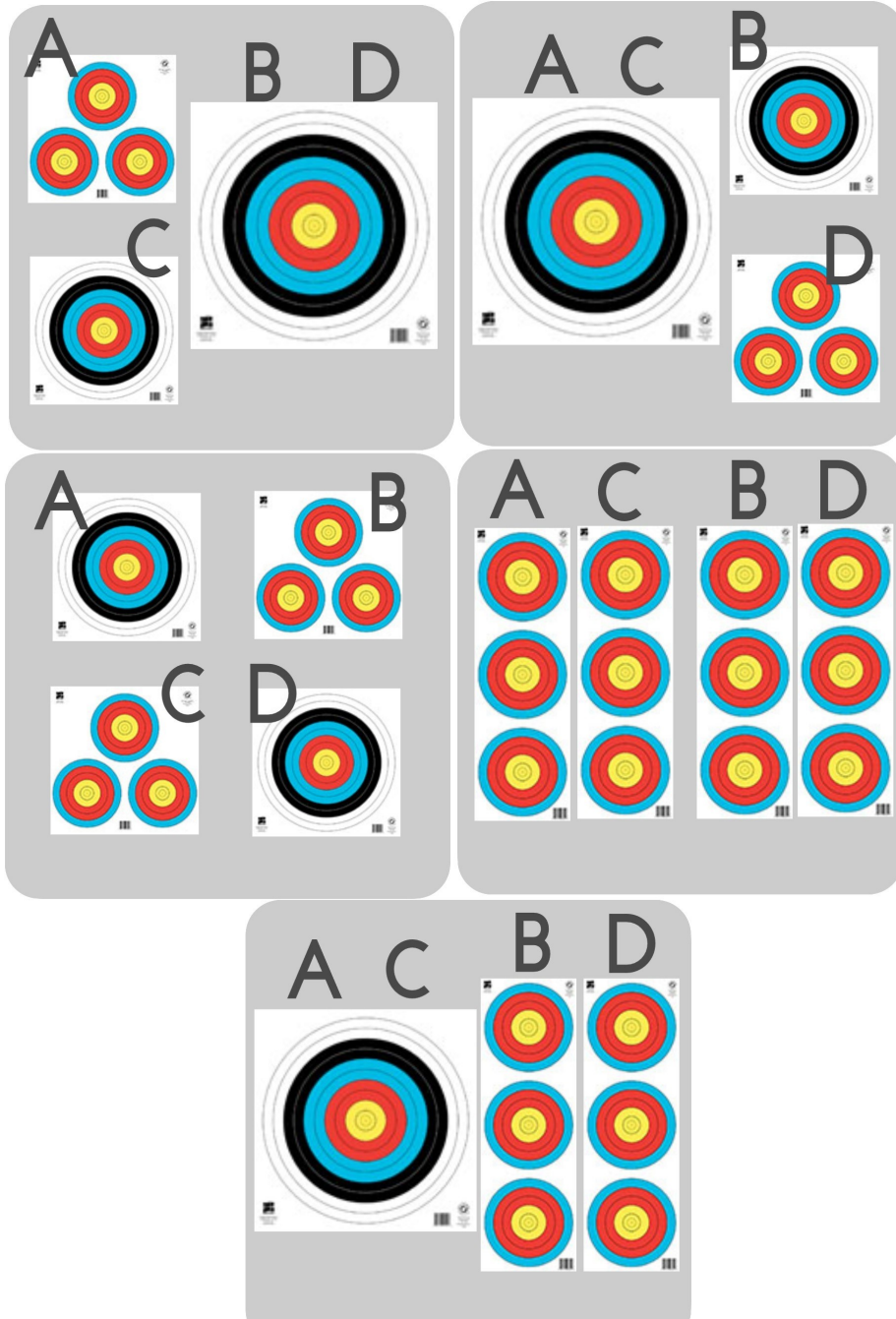
11.1.7. Arrows of any type may be used provided they comply with the common meaning

of the word "arrow" as used in target archery, and do not cause undue damage to target faces or butts.

11.1.7.1. An arrow consists of a shaft with a tip (point), nocks, fletching and, if desired, cresting. The maximum diameter of arrow shafts shall not exceed 9.3mm (arrow wraps shall not be considered as part of this limitation as long they do not extend further than 22cm toward the point of the arrow when measured from the throat -nock hole where the string sits - of the nock to the end of the wrap); the tips (points) for these arrows may have a maximum diameter of 9.4mm. All arrows of every athlete shall be marked with the athlete's name or initials on the shaft. All arrows used in any end shall be identical and shall carry the same pattern and colour(s) of fletching, nocks and cresting, if any. Tracer nocks (electrically/electronically lighted arrow nocks) are not allowed.

Desert Sky Archers is excited to host this years USA Archery Arizona State JOAD Indoor Championship. It is always exciting to see our young archers compete for the Gold Medal.

Please make sure you feed and water your young archer. Their nutrition is of utmost importance during the competition to ensure they perform at their highest level.

Make sure their equipment is ready for the tournament. Check all the nuts and bolts, arrows, string, etc. Make sure they have the appropriate number of arrows in their quiver. Hint, it is more than 3.

Make sure you arrive in plenty of time to get their equipment inspected, check in, hang their target face and socialize. They are going to have anxiety, do not add to it by running late.

MOST IMPORTANT:

Public service announcement. Your archer is 100% responsible for the accuracy of their scorecard. It does not matter if they were writing or inputting the scores on the tablet, calling arrows or assisting. Your archer is responsible for it being correct. This is a State Championship, make sure they know how to score and their responsibilities at the bale.

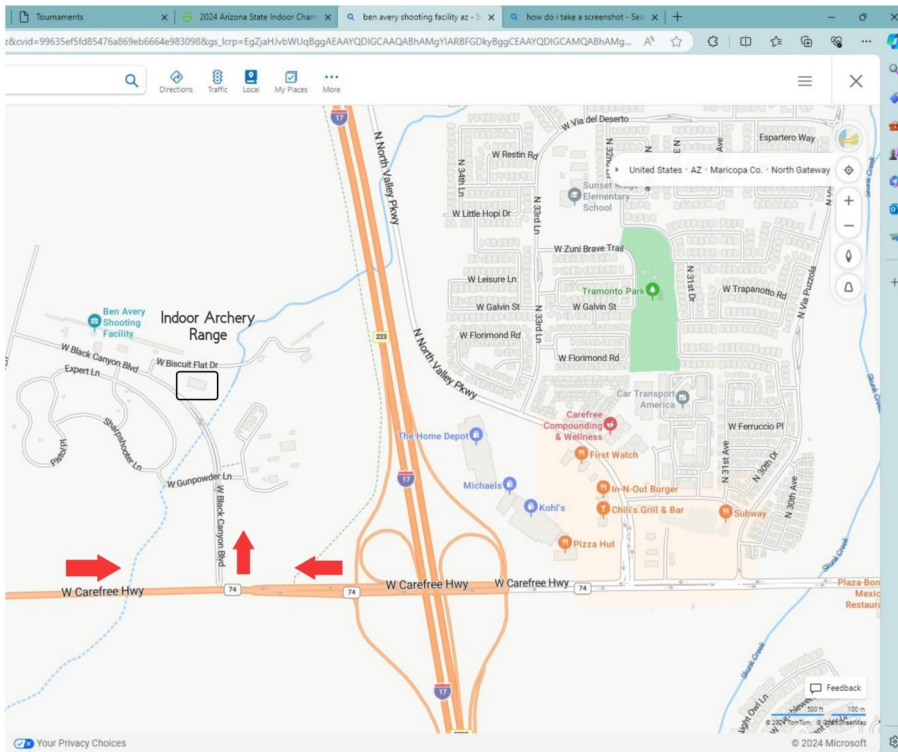
How do I get there?

The Ben Avery entrance you need is NOT the one at the stop light. The entrance you need is the one closest to I-17. It is on the North side of the road about 1/8 mile west of I-17. There is a big sign.

From I-17, Heading west from I-17 take the first right onto the Ben Avery Shooting Facility Property and follow the road as it curves left. After the road is heading west, take the first right and another immediate right. You will see the bldg. on the right. Beige metal building.

From Lake Pleasant Parkway, Heading east form Lake Pleasant Parkway, go straight through the traffic light. You will come to the main entrance on your left. Nice brick sign. Enter. Go straight until the road itself curves left. After the road is heading west, take the first right and another immediate right. You will see the bldg. on the right. Beige metal building.

Be prepared for a lot of road closures this weekend. ADOT, MCDOT and the City of Phoenix are all doing road repair and expansions over the weekend. See [AZ511](#) for current road conditions the Friday

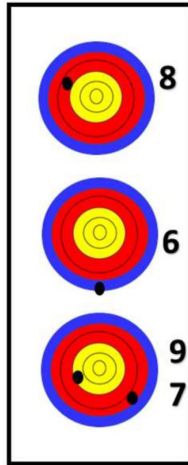

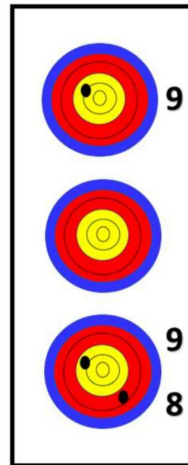
World Archery 3 Spot Scoring

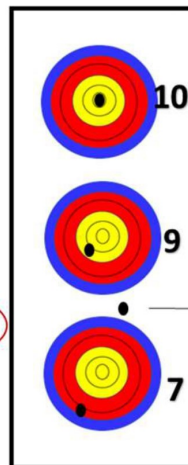

WA RULE 14.1.6.

For indoor events when triple faces are used, arrows may be shot in any order, but if more than one arrow is shot into the same scoring area, both (or all) arrows count as part of that end, but only the lowest value arrow shall score. The other arrow, or arrows, in the same spot shall be scored as a miss, or as misses. Any arrow missing the outermost blue 6-zone shall be scored as a miss.



This is a state championship. Archers are expected to know how and participate in the scoring process at the bale.
