



Net: \$2,079.15

Year-to-Date (as of 3/31/23)

Pledges/Offerings: \$10,597.00
Other Income: \$46,665.44*
Expenses: \$58,720.80
Net: -\$1,458.36

*March included the annual payment from National Grid for their steeple usage. Other income includes funds from the cell towers in the steeple, facility rentals (churches, baker, AA, etc.), weekly contributions from Dodge Park worship services, and other miscellaneous income sources.

**When net is negative, this means we need to use savings and/or endowment funds to cover expenses.


Fellowship
