## Holiday Solid Waste & Recycle Collection Schedule (Not applicable for Greatwood)

Solid Waste and Recycling collection for Republic service areas will not occur on Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's holidays. For all areas, except Greatwood, if the collection day falls on one of the three specified holidays, residents will receive service the following day. All other holidays will maintain the regular collection schedule.

#### **Bulk Cardboard Recycling**

Residents utilizing Republic Services are provided bulk cardboard recycling on an on-call basis. This service is only for quantities of cardboard that are too large to fit in the recycle cart. Boxes should be flattened and all Styrofoam and packing materials must be removed. ## **Electronic Recycling**

Residents utilizing Republic Services are provided electronics recycling on an on-call basis, as part of the household hazardous waste program. This service is for electronics such as TVs, computers, monitors, and similar electronic waste. #### **Christmas Trees**

Residents utilizing <u>Republic Services</u> can place Christmas trees out for collection on regular weekly green waste collection days.

Greatwood residents utilizing <u>Best Trash</u> can place Christmas trees out for collection on either of their regular weekly garbage collection days.

Ornaments, tinsel and lights must be removed for collection regardless of service provider. Christmas trees should not be disposed of in City parks.

# **Textile Recycling**

Textile recycling is provided once a week on your regularly scheduled recycle day. This program targets textiles going into landfills, not items being donated to charities, churches, non-profits, and other organizations. The City encourages residents to donate lightly used items to charitable organizations. Residents should place items in an orange Simple Recycling bag and leave at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled recycle day.

#### **Cooking Oil and Grease**

Used cooking oil and cooking grease can be dropped off at the Recycling Center located at Public Works, 111 Gillingham Lane. Residents can dispose of up to 10 gallons of liquid cooking oil per day at no charge. The facility is open Monday-Friday 8a-5p with the exception of the following holidays, November 28-29, 2019, December 24-25, 2019 and January 1, 2020, during which time the facility will be closed.
