

Quick Play Pitcher Grade Conversion Chart

NPNG Player Cards contain pitching ratings on each pitcher's card. Those grades are found in the top half of the card, between dark black lines. On the far left of the lines containing the pitcher's ratings, you'll see "vs R:", "vs L:" and "vs C:". All NPNG pitchers are rated for their performance separately against right-handed batters and left-handed batters. If you don't wish to take advantage of NPNG pitcher vs hitter matchups concerning lefty – righty situations, you can use JUST the "vs C:" rating. This rating is a Combined rating for the pitcher and you use this rating **INSTEAD OF** the "vs R:" and "vs L:" ratings.

No matter whether you are using the full "vs R:" and "vs L:" option OR if you are using just the "vs C:" option, you still use this chart if you want to use the NPNG Quick Play Option.

BEFORE a pitcher enters any game, you simply convert the grades found on the NPNG Player Cards and convert those ratings into the Quick Play rating. Not only do you do this for both of your starting pitchers but of course you do the same conversion for any relief pitcher as he enters a ball game.

Here's the Conversion Chart:

Quick Play Options

For those who want to play games more quickly with National Pastime Next Generation (NPNG), NPNG now offers a Quick Play Option. Quick Play involves a simple conversion between the standard pitching grades and the Quick Play pitching grades. You should continue to use a separate rating for "vs R" and "vs L" but you also have the option to just use "vs C".

No changes have been made to the Player Cards. However, you'll need to print a new set of boards - NPNG Quick Play boards. These boards are very similar to the standard NPNG boards but include the Quick Play options. The majority of the changes in the Quick Play boards occur in the Play Result Numbers (PRNs) **7**, **8**, **9**, **10** and **10c**. There are also some changes at PRNs **12** and **31**. These boards are available at: <u>www.ntlpt.com</u>

The rules and method of play between standard NPNG and NPNG Quick Play are the same except in the following areas:

Pitching Grades

Using the Quick Play Options, you can still have the batter vs pitcher, lefty vs righty options. However, Quick Play offers a shortcut thru this part of the game. The shortcut involves referring to one additional chart before bringing on the pitcher to the mound the first time. This feature is the single biggest difference between NPNG Quick Play and standard NPNG. But this feature DOES cut down on the time to play a game and the calculations you do in the standard NPNG game.

Standard NPNG uses pitching grades +32 thru -26. NPNG Quick Play uses pitching grades A thru G. The one extra step you must take to use NPNG Quick Play is to convert the standard pitching grades to Quick Play pitching grades. This is a very simple conversion using the NPNG Quick Play Pitcher Conversion Chart. It is also available at the web site listed above.

Example: You are playing 1974 Houston against 1974 Cincinnati. J.R. Richard is on the mound for Houston. You refer to his Player Card and find the following grades: vs R (+12), vs L (-1) and vs C: (+7).

If you wish to take advantage of the NPNG batter vs pitcher, lefty vs righty options, you'll need to convert J.R.'s vs R and vs L grades. You can ignore the vs C grade. To convert his "vs R" grade, simply take his **+12** grade to the Quick Play Pitcher Grade Conversion Chart; go down the chart to the line that says "**+9 thru +21**" and move right to get the Quick Play Grade. Richard is a "**B**" against right-handed hitters in Quick Play. Now to get his vs L grade, take the **-1** down the chart to the line "**-2 thru +1**" and go right. Richard's Quick Play grade against left-handed batters is a "**D**". (**D** is about average for the

league.) You'll need to this, not only for the other starter, but for the relievers entering the game for the first time. If you do not wish to use the NPNG lefty vs righty feature, simply convert the "vs C:" rating.

So now, J.R. Richard will be a: vs R B K4 W2 (also HP-, WP3, Bk3, PHR-P1) vs L D K2 W3

How Pitcher Grades Work in Quick Play

Looking at the new Quick Play Bases Empty board, Play Result Number 8 you'll see:

8	CDEFG	SINGLE to left center
	AB	Line drive out; PO-SS * PO-P

Each batter in NPNG Standard or Quick Play is started off at the plate with a dice roll; then referring to the batter's Main Section of his card. If you find an "H", you re-roll and read the Hit Table with the second roll. None of this is changed in Quick Play. (For further discussion of this, please refer to the NPNG Standard "How to Play" booklet.

For our example, let's say Dan Driessen is up for Cincinnati and on our first dice roll; we throw a "55". We go to Driessen's card, refer to the Main Section of the card, and see that next to "55" in a Play Result Number of "8". We take the "8" to the Quick Play Bases Empty board and we see what is shown above from the board.

The board is telling us that when Driessen faces an "A" or "B" pitcher, he lines out to the shortstop with less than two out or pops out to the pitcher with two outs "*". When Driessen faces a "C", "D", "E", "F" or "G" pitcher, he **SINGLEs** to left center. It's that simple.

What about pitcher strikeout, control and other ratings?

You will still want to use all of them when playing to take advantage of them. Each pitcher still has a grade, strikeout (K1 thru K9) and control (Z4 thru W4) rating vs R, vs L and vs C. You'll still want to use the HP, WP and Bk ratings when they come up on the boards – just as you would with NPNG Standard. Possible exceptions next ...

Pitcher PHR / Park Factors

Some gamers wish to skip checking for Doubles and Home Runs being adjusted by the Pitcher's PHR and Park Factors. In NPNG Quick Play, of course I leave it up to you on whether you wish to affect doubles and homeruns based on the pitcher's HR's given up and the park the game is being played in. The Base Number column has been left in on the Quick Play boards in case you wish to continue to use these features. Your doubles and homers count could be off somewhat because neither of these ratings

will balance out to zero for each batter. NPNG strongly urges you to continue to use the Pitcher PHR and Park Factors since they have both been factored into each Player Card.

SSTAM and RSTAM

This is still an optional stamina feature (for starting and relieving) that can work with the Quick Play features. After reaching the maximum batters faced you could go back to the standard rules, adjusted the standard rating as described in the standard rules and then convert the adjusted rating by the Pitcher Grades Conversion Chart. That seems like a lot of jumping through hoops. You could just add one grade when reaching the SSTAM or RSTAM and then one grade at the beginning of each inning thereafter. Remember, NPNG does not suggest using SSTAM and RSTAM but provided it for those who wanted a pitcher stamina system.

Hit Numbers from the Hit Table

Play Result Numbers from the Player Card Hit Table have the same rules in NPNG Standard and Quick Play with one exception; on Play Result Numbers **7** and **8** ALWAYS use the top line of the play on the Quick Play boards. In other words, 7s and 8s from the Player's Hit Table are still ALWAYS singles. Saying this another way, on ALL PRNs **7** and **8** from a Player Card **Hit Table**, assume a Pitcher Grade of "G" – always a hit.

Additional Explanations

On the Quick Play boards, PRN 12, it now reads:

Out at first; PO-1B (W4 - Base on balls) (G Pitcher - SINGLE to left center)

On this play, first check the pitcher for a control rating of "W4" against this batter. If the pitcher has a control rating of "W4", the play is a "Base on balls". Now check to see if the pitcher is a grade "G" against this batter. If he is, the play goes as a "SINGLE to left center" otherwise it's an unassisted ground out to the first baseman. Please read these "play overrides" in the order they are listed. In this case, the W4 is checked first BEFORE the grade G.

Suggestions

To really make your games move quickly, have the following either on your score sheet or somewhere handy in front of you, pitcher's arm (lefty or righty), batter's side (right, left or both), pitcher's complete grade, strikeout and control either "vs R" and "vs L" OR if you use the combined rating "vs C", the grade, strikeout and control rating for "vs C". Also keep handy the pitcher's HP, WP and Bk ratings and PHR rating if you choose to use that option. Keep the Park Factor handy and lastly, keep each player's fielding rating close (including OF assists). Each batter's speed will also be a factor at times.
