### IMPORTANT CHANGES

Dear Berkeley County Permit Holder,

West Virginia recently adopted the 2013 FDA Food Code with its last legislative session, and it will go into effect **July 1, 2019**. The following outlines your new responsibilities due to this change:

- You will need to have access to the 2013 Food Code online or have a hard copy (the hard copy is currently not available but can be accessed online and printed)
- You will need to have a certified manager accessible to your establishment. You **have one year** to come into compliance. The following are the only ones accepted:
  - Learn2Serve Food Protection Manager Certification Program 360training.com
  - AboveTraining/StateFoodSafety.com Certified Food Protection Manager (CFPM) Exam
  - Food Protection Manager Certification Program -International Certified Food Safety Manager
  - ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification Program
  - Prometric Inc. Food Protection Manager Certification Program
- You will need to supply documentation of this certified training at time of permit renewal next June of 2020. This along with your attendance at our annual food school will be required in order for you to receive your operating permit.
- Become familiar with the new code. Critical and Non-critical violations no longer exist. They have been replaced with priority, priority foundation, and core.
