Nature and revelation alike testify of God's love. Our Father in heaven is the source of life, of wisdom and of joy. Look at the wonderful and beautiful things of nature. Think of their marvelous adaption to the needs and happiness, not only to man, but of all living creatures including the sunshine and the rains, which gladden and refresh the earth. The hills and seas and plains, all speak to us of the Creator's love. It is God Who supplies the daily needs of all His creatures.

In the beautiful words of the Psalmist, "The eyes of all who wait upon Thee; And Thou givest them their meat in due season. Thou openest Thine hand, and satisfies the desire of every living thing." (Psalm 145:15-16)

God made man and woman perfectly holy and happy; and the fair earth, as it came from the Creator's hand, bore no blight of decay or shadow of the curse. It is transgression of God's law – the law of love – that has brought woe and death. Yet even amid the suffering that results from sin, God's love is revealed. It is written that God cursed the ground for man's sake. (*Genesis 3:17*) The thorn and the thistle – the difficulties and trials that make his life one of toil and care – were appointed for his good as a part of the training needed in God's plan for his/her uplifting from the ruin and degradation that sin has wrought. The world, though fallen, is not all sorrow and misery. In nature itself there are messages of hope and comfort. There are flowers upon the thistles, and the thorns are covered with roses.

"God is Love" is written upon every opening bud, upon every spire of springing grass. The lovely birds making the air vocal with their happy songs; the buds delicately tinted in their perfection perfuming the air; the lofty trees of the forest with their rich foliage of living green – all testify to the tender, Fatherly care of our God and to His desire to make His children happy.

The Word of God reveals His character. He Himself has declared His infinite love and pity. When Moses prayed, "Show me Thy glory" the Lord answered, "I will make all My goodness pass before thee." (Exodus 33:18-19) This is His glory. The Lord passed before Moses and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, long-suffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin." (Exodus 34:6-7) He is ... "Slow to anger, and of great kindness" (Jonah 4:2) ... "Because He delighteth in mercy." (Micah 7:18)

God has bound our hearts to Him by unnumbered tokens in heaven and in earth. Through the things of nature, and the deepest and most tender earthly ties that human hearts can know, He has sought to reveal Himself to us. Yet these but imperfectly represent His love. Though all these evidences have been given, the enemy of good has blinded the minds of men and women so that they looked upon God with fear; they thought of Him as severe and unforgiving. The liar, satan, led men and women to conceive of God as a being whose chief attribute is stern justice. One Who is a severe judge, a harsh exacting creditor. The liar has pictured the Creator as a being Who is watching with a jealous eye to discern the errors and mistakes of men and women, that He may visit judgments upon them. It was to remove this dark shadow, by revealing to the world the infinite love of God that Jesus came to live among men and women.

The Son of God came from heaven to make manifest the father. "No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, He hath declared Him." (John 1:18) "Neither knowest any man the Father, save the Son, and to he whomsoever the Son will reveal Him." (Matthew 11:27) When one of the disciples made the request, "Show us the Father," Jesus answered, "Have I beam so long time with you and yet that there was the hath seen the Pather; and how seyest thou then, show us the father?" (John 14:8-9)

In describing His earthly mission Jesus said, "The Lard hath analited life to preach the Geospel to the poor; He hath soul life to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the aptives, and recevering of sight to the blind, to set al liberty than that are broked." (Luke 4:18) This was His work. He went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by satan. There were whole villages where there was not a mean of sickness in any house, for He has passed through them and healed all their sick. His work gave evidence of His divine anointing. Love, mercy and compassion were revealed in every act of His life; His heart went out in tender sympathy to the children of men. He took man's nature, that He might reach man's wants. The poorest and humblest were not afraid to approach Him. Even little children were attracted to Him. They leved to climb upon His knees and gaze into His pensive face, benignant with love. Jesus did not suppress one word of truth, but He uttered it always in love. He exercised the greatest tact and thoughtful kind attention in His relationships with the people. He was never rude, never needlessly spoke a severe word, and never gave needless pain to the sensitive soul. He did not censure human weakness. He spoke the truth, but always in love. He denounced hypocrisy, unbelief, and iniquity; but tears were in His voice as He uttered His scathing rebukes. He wept over Jerusalem, the city He loved, which refused to receive Him, the Way, the Truth, and the Life. They had rejected Him, the Savior, but He regarded them with pitying tenderness. His life was one of self-denial and thoughtful care for others. Every soul was precious in His eyes. While He ever bore Himself with divine dignity, He bowed with the tenderest regard to every member of the family of God.In all men and women He saw fallen souls whom it was His mission to save.

Such is the character of Christ as revealed in His life. This is the character of God. It is from the Father's heart that the streams of divine compassion, manifest in Christ and flow out to the children of men. Jesus, the tender, pitying Savior was manifest in the flesh. (*1Timothy 3:16*)

It was to redeem us that Jesus lived and suffered and died. He became "A Man of sorrows" that we might be made partakers of everlasting joy. God permitted his beloved Son, full of grace and truth, to come from a world of indescribable glory, to a world marred and blightened with sin, darkened with the shadow of death and the curse. He permitted Him to leave the bosom of His love and the adoration of the angels to suffer shame, insult, humiliation, hatred, and death. "The chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5) Behold Him in the wilderness in Gethsemane, upon the cross! The spotless Son of God took upon Himself the burden of sin. He had been One with God, felt His soul the awful separation that sin makes between God and man. These words wrung from His lips in anguish as He cried out, "My @od, My @od, why bast Thom forseling Mar?" (Matthew 27:46) It was the burden of sin, the sense of its terrible enormity, of its separation of soul from God – it was this that broke the heart of the Son of God.

But this great sacrifice was not made in order to create in the Father's heart a love for man, not to make Him willing to save. NO! NO! "God so loved the world that he gave His only-begotten Son." (John 3:16) The Father loves us, not because of the great population, but He provided the propitiation because He loves us. Christ was the medium through which He could pour out His infinite love upon the fallen world. "God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself." (2 Corinthians 5:14) God suffered with His Son. In the agony of Gethsemane, the death of Calvary, the heart of infinite love paid the price of our redemption.

Jesus said, "Therefore doth My Father love Ma, because I lay down My Ma, that I might take it again." (John 10:17) That is, "My Father hath so loved you that He even loves Me more for giving My life to redeem you. In becoming your substitute and surety, by surrendering My life, by taking your liabilities, your transgressions, I am endeared to My Father; for by My sacrifice, God can be just, and yet the justifier of him who believeth in Jesus."

None but the Son of God could accomplish our redemption; for only He Who was in the bosom of the Father could declare Him. Only He Who knew the height and depth of the love of God could make it manifest. Nothing less than the infinite sacrifice made by Christ in behalf of fallen man could express the Father's love to the lost humanity.

"God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son ..." (John 3:16) He gave Him not only to live among men, to bear their sins, and die their sacrifice; He gave Him to the fallen race. Christ was to identify Himself with the interests and needs of humanity. He Who was One with God has linked Himself with children of men by ties that are never to be broken. Jesus is ... "Not ashamed to call them brethren." (Hebrews 2:11) He is our Sacrifice, our Advocate, our Brother, bearing our human form before the Father's throne. And through eternal ages one with the race He has redeemed – the Son of Man. And in all of this that man might be uplifted from the ruin and degradation of sin that He might reflect the love of God and share the joy of holiness.

The price paid for our redemption, the infinite sacrifice of our heavenly Father in giving His Son to die for us, should give us exalted conceptions of what we may become through Christ. As the inspired Apostle John beheld the height, the depth and the breadth of the Father's love toward the perishing race, he was filled with adoration and reverence; and, failing to find suitable language in which to express the greatness and tenderness of this love, he called upon the world to behold it. "Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God." (1 John 3:1) What a value this places on man!! Through transgressions the sons of Man become subjects of satan. Through faith in the atoning sacrifice of Christ, the sons of Adam may become the sons of God. By assuming human nature, Christ elevates humanity. Fallen men are placed where, through the connection with Christ, they may indeed become worthy of the name, "sons of God".

Such love is without a parallel. Children of the heavenly King! Precious promise! The theme for the most profound meditation! The matchless love of God for a world that did not love Him! The thought has a subduing power upon the soul and brings the mind into captivity to the will of God. The more we study the divine character in the light of the Cross, the more

Boundaries and Your Children By M.D.

My fellow Overcomers, greetings to all in the name of Jesus. Those of you who have been with us for awhile may recognize my appeal to us parents that are incarcerated. It's still our responsibility to parent our children while we are incarcerated in the ways of the Lord. Following up on all the other articles that I've shared with you has brought me to this one.

God at His deepest level is a lover (1 John 4:8). He is relationally orientated and driven. He desires connection with us from womb to tomb. "I have loved you with an everlasting love." (Jeremiah 31:3) God's loving nature is active. Love multiplies itself.

God is also the aggressive Creator; He wants to fill up His universe with beings who care for Him – and for each other. The family is the social unit God invented to fill up the world with representatives of His loving character. It's a place for nurturing our children until they are mature enough to go out of the family as adults and to multiply His image in other surroundings.

God, the good Parent, wants to help us (His children) grow up. He wants to see us "... become mature', attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ." (Ephesians 4:13) Part of this maturing process is helping us know how to take responsibility for our lives. It's the same with our own flesh and blood kids and second only to learning how to bond, forming strong attachments. The most important thing parents can give children is a sense of responsibility – knowing what they are responsible for and what they aren't, knowing how to say no, and how to accept no. Responsibility is a gift of enormous value. Our children will either fear or learn to hate boundaries. Boundary development in children is the work of learning responsibility. As we teach them the merits and limits of responsibility, we teach them autonomy – we prepare them to take on the tasks of adulthood.

The Scriptures have much to say about the role of boundary setting in child rearing. We call it discipline. Hebrew and Greek words for discipline translate to teaching. Fathers are to raise children "... in the training and instruction of the Lord," (Ephesians 6:4) ... "stern disciple awaits him who leaves the path." (Proverbs 15:10)

A good child rearing involves both preventative training and practice, and correctional consequences. For example, you set a 10:00 P.M. bedtime for your 14 year old. "It's there so you'll get enough sleep for school" you tell her. You've just disciplined positively. Then your teen stays up until midnight, so the next day you say, "Because you stayed up all night, you lose your phone for today." Now you've disciplined negatively. "Why are both the carrot and the whip necessary in good boundary development" you may ask? Well, it's because God uses practice – trial and error – to help us grow up. We learn maturity by getting information, applying it poorly, making mistakes, learning from our mistakes and doing better the next time.

Practice is necessary in all areas of our life; in learning anything from riding a bike to operating a vehicle. We need practice in learning a deep love relationship with God and in learning to study the Bible. I recommend the new inductive study method. It's awesome! It's just as true for our spiritual and emotional growth. "But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil." (Hebrews 5:14) Practice is important in learning boundaries and responsibility. Our mistakes are our teachers. I could go on and on to the importance of boundaries. I implore you to look to the Scriptures yourselves and see the boundary needs of your children so that they may know when to say yes, how to say no and take control of their lives so that they don't repeat the mistakes of us incarcerated parents. Take responsibility NOW, and reap the rewards in your children as they grow up as Overcenters for Strist "on the outside" themselves. God bless you and your children.

Foot's Bible Study Rotes

1 Samuel 10:1-12:25

Israel's true King was God, but the nation demanded another. Imagine wanting a human being instead of God as your guide and leader! Throughout history, men and women have rejected God, and they continue to do it today. Are you rejecting God by pushing Him aside and acknowledging someone or something else as your 'king' or top priority? Learn from these stories of Israel's kings and don't push God aside! (10:19)

When injustice or sin makes you angry, ask God how you can channel that anger in constructive ways to help bring about a positive change. (11:6)

No person is ever exempt from God's laws; no human action is outside His jurisdiction. God is the true King of every area of life. We must recognize His Kingship and pattern our relationships, work life, and home life according to His principles. (12:12-15)

John 6:43-71

The Holy Spirit gives spiritual life. Without the work of the Holy Spirit, we cannot even see our need for new life. All spiritual renewal begins and ends with God. He reveals truth to us, lives within us, and then enables us to respond to that truth. (6:63-65)

Though there are many philosophies and self-styles authorities, Jesus alone has the words of eternal life. People look everywhere for eternal life and miss Christ, the only source, stay with Him, especially when you are confused and feel alone. (6:67-68)

Psalms 107:1-108:13

No matter how extreme our calamity, God is able to help us. He is loving and kind to those who are distressed. (107:1)

Those who have never truly suffered may not appreciate God as much as those who have matured under hardship. Those who have seen God work in times of distress have a deeper insight into his loving-kindness. If you have experienced trials, you have potential for great praise. (107:32)

With God's help we can claim more than mere survival, we can claim victory! Look for ways God can use your distress as an opportunity to show His mighty power. (**108:13**)

Have you ever tried to argue in a whisper? It is equally hard to argue with someone who insists on answering gently. On the other hand, a rising voice and harsh words almost always trigger an angry response. To turn away wrath and seek peace, choose gentle words. (15:1)

She is my rock, never has she ever given up on me, even when I've given up on myself.
