

Dear Residents of Middleburg and Loudoun County -

The Loudoun County Board of Supervisors will be holding Public Hearings on April 24th (6pm) and April 27th (9am) on one of the most important topics they will be making a decision about: the [Loudoun 2040 Comprehensive Plan](#). The Town of Middleburg is supporting all interested persons to attend – and speak – at the Public Hearing about your views on the Loudoun 2040 Plan. We recognize that not everyone has the ability to drive to Leesburg (for the 24th) or Ashburn (for the 27th) – so the Town is inquiring whether there is interest from citizens who live in and around Middleburg to take a bus to the hearings. This would be provided free of charge to all interested parties.
