Multiple organizations may be selected.

To be considered as a recipient of the 2021 Tri-Association Conference Silent Auction proceeds, please submit a two-page written application that includes:

- The applying organization's official name, mailing address, and 501-3c or other charitable organization status
- Charitable organization's benefit to the community at a local, regional, state, national and/or international levels
- Charitable organization's past achievements and how they benefited the community
- Narrative of how the funds will be used, including description of the organization's current and future work (local and international, current stages of projects, etc.) These should focus on the organization's water, wastewater and/or stormwater work.
- The charitable organization's availability to assist with the silent auction including assistance on the days of the auction, to solicit donations, and to contribute items.
- Contact information for the organization's representative including name, email, and phone number.
