

An ordinance appropriating certain moneys
 Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of *the City of*
 Garnett, Kansas.

- Sec. 1. That the sum of Six Hundred and Sixty One ⁵⁵/₁₀₀ Dollars,
 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the
 the city Treasurer for the purpose of paying the bills allowed
 against said fund at a regular meeting of said board of Commission-
 ers held on the 6th day of October, 1913, a list of which may be found
 on page 109 of the journal of the proceedings of said board.
- Sec. 2. That the sum of Seven Hundred and Eight ²/₁₀₀ Dollars,
 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the water fund works
 fund of the city Treasurer for the purpose of paying the bills
 allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said board held
 on the 6th day of October, 1913, a list of which may be found on
 page 110 of the journal of the proceedings of said board.
- Sec. 3. That the sum of One ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,
 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Sewer District Number
 One fund of the city Treasurer for the purpose of paying the bills
 allowed against said fund at a regular meeting of said board held on
 the 6th day of October, 1913, a list of which may be found on page
110 of the journal of the proceedings of said board.
- Sec. 4. That the sum of Two ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,
 be and the same is hereby appropriated out of Sewer District Number 2
 of the City Treasurer for the purpose of paying the bills allowed
 against said fund at a regular meeting of said board held on the 6th
 day of October, 1913, a list of which may be found on page 110 of
 the journal of the proceedings of said board.
- Sec. 5. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to draw
 warrants on the city Treasurer to pay the bills allowed in sections, one
 two, three, and four of this ordinance.
- Sec. 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its
 passage by the board of Commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
