"Each should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work" (2 Corinthians 9:7-9).

Dear Friends in Christ,

Years ago, I received a call from a company called *Epic Fundraising*. After a brief introduction, the caller asked, "So, how do you do your fundraising?"

I thought for a moment and said, "Well, I wouldn't say we actually do *fundraising*. The approach I like to take is that Jesus, God himself, came to earth and lived with us, ministered to us, laughed with us, cried with us, and died for us. Because of his life, death, and resurrection, our sins are forgiven, and we receive the promise of eternal life. This is what motivates our giving, or what you call fundraising."

I continued, "My position on fundraising is that God commands us to give back a tenth of everything we have, and we get to keep the other nine. God gets one, we keep nine. We give one-tenth back to God, and we receive the grace of Christ, and eternal life. That's what I've preached, and I don't wish to use the word *successful*, but it seems to have worked pretty well over the years."

The phone was silent for a moment, and the person finally responded, "Oh! Well, thanks for your time!"

I've only been at Mars U.P. since February, so I don't know how you view Stewardship, or what is sometimes called *The Sermon on the Amount*. I don't know how many Stewardship sermons are given, if at all. (By the way, did you know that Jesus spoke about money more often than he spoke about love? If I was to talk about money as often as Jesus did, you would hear *thirteen sermons* each year!)

I have had a few discussions with some of you about your giving, and I've heard the reports about receipts increasing in September (is God not active in your life during the summer?). But I really don't know how MUP in general approaches the topic.

But this is what I DO know: Congregations that approach financial stewardship from a biblical perspective do not view the money Christians give to their church merely as a way to pay the bills. Instead, these congregations see financial contributions as a way to help people *grow spiritually in their relationship with God* by supporting their church's mission and ministry with a percentage of their incomes.

Bible-based, Christ-centered, *joyful* giving is based upon the biblical philosophy of the need of the giver to give for his or her own *spiritual development*, rather than what the church needs to receive. Instead of treating people as members of a club or non-profit organization who pay dues, church members are treated as *followers of Jesus Christ* who want to *give unselfishly as an act of discipleship*.

In November, I will offer three sermons:

- November 4: The humanity and the divinity of Christ;
- November 11: The work of Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit;
- November 18: *Responding* to the person and work of Christ.

The sermons won't be about our budget, our leaders, what's going on in the denomination, or even "stepping up" (whatever that means!). They are about Christ, and that's what Stewardship is – our response to the person, divinity, work, and grace of Christ.

This year, I would like each of us to prayerfully consider to three questions:

- 1. Who is Jesus Christ, and how has my life been changed because of his life, death, and resurrection?
- 2. Up to this point, how have I responded financially (yes, financially!) to Christ's work in my life?
- 3. What percentage of my income is God calling me to give to Mars U.P. Church in 2019?

(By the way, if you're wondering about a good starting point, the base percentage regarding giving is 10%, off the top. That's the Scripture-based minimum. And if you're already tithing, maybe God is calling you to give more.)

Again, Stewardship is not a referendum on the budget, or expressing an opinion about Mars, her past or her future, our leaders, our denomination, or me. Also, as I told the guy from *Epic Fundraising*, Stewardship is NOT about *fundraising*. Stewardship is our personal, *physical response to God on the Cross*.

God commands us to do lots of things — one of those commands is to give back to him a tenth of everything we have. I encourage you to pray about your *financial response* to the birth, life, death, and resurrection of Jesus for 2019. And please be in worship to hear what God has told me to tell you about this aspect of your life in Christ.

It is my hope and dream that everyone, enabled by the Holy Spirit, will become a cheerful giver, and God's grace may abound in you.


