 Elmer J. Hallitt age 86, of Elkton, died Tuesday morning, February 14, at his home.

He was born February 4, 1926 at the home of his parents the late Sprague and Minnie (Rennert) Hallitt in Meade Twp. Elmer lived in Elkton almost all of his life. In January of 1961 he married Irene Engelhardt in Battle Creek. She preceded him in death in 1995.

Elmer started working at Active Industries in 1949, and was call to serve his country his country in the army during the Korean War.
