It is hard to see if white 20 *points* at blue 25 after the made three-point shot or if he *shoots* him with his finger gun.

If it was a *point*, we have an automatic technical foul for taunting. If it is a *finger gun shot*, we have an automatic flagrant technical foul. The ejection would also be supplemental.

It can be argued that *pointing a finger* at the defender is most certainly a *finger gun*. We need to be aware of these types of actions. Even if they catch us off guard initially, we can still assess the penalties a few seconds after it has been processed. Even if T misses this and a partner sees it, we need to come and get it. These types of actions have been deemed unacceptable by the PIAA board of directors.
