They also asked about a concrete walkway for those that are disabled or find it hard to walk on uneven ground. One asked about replacing the swing set. Trustee Gail Ellinger spoke about the township applying for a grant and would prioritize those wants and needs for the park. All agreed that fencing and the walkway is needed first for safer environment.


There being no further business to discuss Trustee Steve Wolfe motioned to adjourn and Trustee Gail Ellinger seconded the motion.




