The sprawling, grassy Stibb's Field, with its picturesque pond and pines, will serve as the backdrop to this late-summer event, which will showcase high quality, unique products made by artisans from throughout Connecticut and beyond. Food truck fare, musical entertainment, picnic tables and fun lawn games will encourage visitors to relax and enjoy a pleasant afternoon perusing all that our great vendors will have to offer. The net proceeds from this event will benefit many local charities in our community.

This will be the second year since we rebranded the long-running Southbury Fall Fine Arts Festival and reintroduced it as CT Art & Eats. The event now features a more diverse set of vendors, including food trucks, and a beautiful location that allows for a more optimized layout. Over 1000 people walked through the event in 2018. Extensive print and social media advertising will continue as we work to surpass that number.

The early applicant fee is \$125 when the application is received by May 1, 2019. After May 1, 2019 the fee is \$150. The deadline for receipt of applications is August 1, 2019.

Rules and Regulations

Fees: Payment for space must be made in full at the time of application, made payable to the Southbury Women's Club. In the event an application is not accepted by the Southbury Women's Club (SWC), the space fee will be returned to the applicant in full. Checks with insufficient funds will be subject to a \$20 return check fee and your space will not be held until the check and the service charge are paid.

Insurance: ALL accepted vendors must provide a Certificate of Insurance naming the town of Southbury and Event Host (Southbury Women's Club) as additional insured by August 31, 2019. Vendors must provide a certificate of insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 naming BOTH of the following as additional insured:

- Town of Southbury
- Southbury Women's Club, P.O. Box 195, Southbury, CT 06488

Vendors failing to provide the required Certificate of Insurance by August 31, 2019, will not be permitted to participate in CT Arts & Eats and the vendor fee will not be refunded.

Food Sales and Sampling: Food trucks are responsible for obtaining a Temporary Food Service License from the Pomperaug District of Public Health. The Temporary Food Service License Application is available online at: www.pddh.org/downloads. This application must be submitted to Pomperaug District of Public Health by August 1, 2019.

The Food Service License Application is subject to review and approval by the Pomperaug District of Public Health. The health inspector may contact you for additional information if deemed necessary to issue your license. It is the vendor's responsibility to comply with health-safety provisions including an on-site health inspection on the day of the event. Failure to pass the health inspection may result in operating at a limited capacity or not at all. Failure to pass this inspection does not qualify the vendor for a refund.

Inclement Weather: This event will be held rain or shine. Southbury Women's Club reserves the right to cancel the event in the case of an extreme weather emergency situation. In the event of cancellation, fees are non-refundable.

Food Truck Setup: Food trucks will be directed onto Stibb's field in the order that they arrive. Although unlikely, vehicles of any kind may not be permitted onto the field in the event of unfavorable ground conditions. This decision will be made by the State of CT and Southbury Women's Club will abide by that decision and food trucks will be placed adjacent to the field.

Time Commitment: All food trucks must be set up one hour prior to the event's opening time to the public, which is 10 am. Setup begins at 7 am. Exhibitors arriving late will not be allowed to set up, lose the space and forfeit the space fee. All exhibitors will remain set up until 4 pm, the closing time of the event. The grounds must be vacated by 5:30 pm.

Use of Space: The applicant understands that this document is not a contract for space, but a component of the application for said space. The applicant shall not be entitled to space during the event unless the applicant receives notice of such by SWC. Upon receipt of such notice from SWC, the applicant will become an exhibitor at the event.

Cancellation Policy: In the event an applicant has been accepted as an exhibitor in the event but then wishes to cancel, the following will apply: Cancellation must be expressed in writing or via email. If a cancellation is made more than thirty days prior to the event, the exhibitor will receive back the space fee less a 25% processing fee. Cancellations made thirty days or less prior to the event will result in the forfeiture of the exhibitor's space fee.

Liability: The applicant/exhibitor hereby agrees that he/she will hold harmless from liability the Southbury Women's Club, the Town of Southbury, and the state of Connecticut or any member or representative of said organizations acting within their capacity as a member or representative, for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to the exhibitor or any employee or assistant accompanying the exhibitor, or property of the exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.

The exhibitor, upon signing his/her application for exhibit space, hereby expressly releases the aforementioned organizations from any and all claims for such loss, damage or injury; and agrees to abide by the Rules and Regulations as set forth above.

Photography: No photography of any displays at the event is permitted without consent of the vendor.

Acknowledgement: The applicant hereby requests permission to participate in CT Arts & Eats on September 7, 2019 as an exhibitor. The applicant recognizes that the Southbury Women's Club is the governing body for the event and agrees to abide by all regulations, rules and decisions, whether written or otherwise, up to and through the day of the event, made by SWC as they relate to the event. Such decisions may include the requirement that the applicant/exhibitor leave the premises of the event for violations of any sort.
