From Pastor Bill's Study

strong and courageous

Greetings to all,

In my daily Bible reading I am in the book of Joshua and I am pondering the all of the news that is bombarding my senses. The newspapers, television, radio; all of the social media and everyday talking points are about two topics. First being the Corona Virus, and about the Democratic nominations.

I know we should never discuss politics and church, but we are called to be aware about what is going on in the world we live in. We can also add to the mix what is going to happen to the United Methodist church in the future. In all of this I believe politics are ruling the decisions that are going to be made.

Since I am writing this article I will give you my unlearned hypotenuse about all that is going in the world of today and the politics involved.

On the topic of the Corona virus I do believe it is a serious threat but no more than the Flu virus that hits every winter. The victims who suffer the most are the very young and those with compromised immune systems. Those who are elderly, organ transplants, HIV positive, or undergoing any form of chemo treatments are at the highest risk factors. A Notice on our Website and Facebook: Dear Bethany United Methodist of Milton & Family & Friends,

We wanted to come to you quickly with important information concerning Coronavirus (COVID-19) and the temporary measures we're taking as a church family. We are choosing to remain calm, trust God, but also take the situation very seriously to help support the efforts of our state and community. As always, no matter what we face, we have a God who is bigger. We will continue to trust Him in the days ahead.

On Thursday, March 12, Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf provided an update on the state's COVID-19 (coronavirus) mitigation efforts, which included guidance to help slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Included in his report is the "strong encouragement of the suspension of large gatherings, events, and conferences of 50 individuals or more."

Therefore, after much prayer, and in accordance with the biblical directive of honoring our governing authorities and out of concern for the health and safety of our local communities, Bethany UMC will be suspending for two weeks all Sunday gatherings and weekly Bibles studies (Tuesday & Thursday) starting this Sunday, March 22, 2020. This practice of social distancing is meant to limit the spread of the virus and other seasonal illnesses in accordance with The Center for Disease Control (CDC).

Please know that this decision is not made out of fear, but instead out of obedience to God's Word and out of concern for all the people who call Bethany UMC home as well as the communities in which we live.

Note from Bishop Parks on March 17, 2020:

Dear Laity and Clergy of the Susquehanna Conference,

As your bishop, along with the leadership of the Annual Conference, I implore our Susquehanna Conference churches to suspend all gatherings for worship and other activities for at least the next two weeks. This is a very hard decision, especially because we are in the midst of Lent, one of the most sacred seasons of the church year. However, during the time of suspension we can be more intentional and be focused on the Lenten disciplines of solitude, reflection, and repentance. This season can help us deepen our spiritual connection to Holy Week and ultimately Easter when we celebrate new life.

The Leadership Team invited three different architectural/engineering firms (Hemmler & Camayd, Mid-Penn Engineering, and Noelker and Hull) to tour our damaged church and meet with the team. Of the three, we felt that Hemmler & Camayd and Noelker and Hull possessed the skills and experience to lead us through the rebuilding process. Therefore, we asked these two firms to submit formal proposals to the Leadership Team for their services.

Hopefully we are seeing the light at the end of the tunnel in relation to the insurance investigation. Those conducting the investigation have assured Pastor Bill they will be completed with their tasks by the end of March. After they are finished we will finally be able to finish the clean up and start the rebuilding process. Other than finishing the removal of the debris, the main priority will be to protect the interior of the building from the weather.

We received notice from Judy Campbell's executor that Bethany is a beneficiary of her estate. Although we mourn the loss, we are appreciative that Judy felt the call to share her remaining assets with her church.


