then the industry has spoken. One just has to visit any food store to see with your own eyes the explosion of organic and natural


products, often in their own dedicated section.

What are the health benefits of each ingredient?

- Beeswax helps make this DIY hair pomade less greasy. If you find that you need more hold as you prepare, simply add one more tablespoon of beeswax to the mixture. - According to Pubmed, coconut oil is better at preventing protein loss than both mineral and sunflower oils when applied either before or after the hair was washed. In reality, coconut oil comes out on top in all of the studies and reduced protein loss in hair that was undamaged, bleached, chemically treated orUV exposed. On the other hand, both the mineral and sunflower oils did not have this effect and were not found to be effective at reducing protein loss from hair. It is thought that coconut oil's chemical structure is behind its superior ability to protect hair. Coconut oil, not only conditions hair, it also helps repair it and is an excellent agent to fight dandruff. One of the astounding things about coconut oil is that it will be soft and pliable in your hands, but will harden back up on your hair. - Bentonite clay is a gritty powder made from naturally occurring volcanic ash. Bentonite clay contains sodium, potassium, and calcium – minerals that are essential for hair growth. But, additionally, it also removes dead skin cells from your scalp and cleanses hair follicles that, in turn, boost hair growth. Bentonite clay also makes for an excellent hair rinse that adds intense shine to your hair.
- Argan oil is mostly used as a moisturizer for skin and hair because it is full of fatty acids, mainly oleic acid and linoleic acid. DIY Natural Homemade Hair Pomade

Ingredients

- 2 Tablespoons beeswax pastilles
- 3 Tablespoons coconut oil
- 2 teaspoons bentonite clay
- 10 drops argan(essential) oil

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Instructions

- Begin making your homemade pomade by melting the beeswax in a double boiler. (You can improvise and use a glass Pyrex mixing bowl in a pot of boiling water).
- Add coconut oil and stir until melted.
- Turn off the boiler and add bentonite clay.
- Stir in argan essential oil.
- Pour into a container. (You can use a small mason jar, but any container works fine.)
