Good morning!

Traveling...again, the toughest call we make in my opinion.

I was asked to possibly give some clips of traveling when a player takes a three-point shot. We have for whatever reason, allowed players to 'walk into' a three-point shot. It has become commonplace to allow what you will see in clips today.

There are two videos with travels where players 'walk into' the shot – in other words, lift the pivot foot and put it back down. Each of these is a player who catches the ball with one foot on the floor, hence that is his/her pivot foot, step onto the other foot, then brings the pivot foot up and back on the floor before taking the shot.

I am just throwing these out there for discussion as they are now virtually 'accepted' moves in our game. These are almost never called at the college level and players at our level see them doing it.
