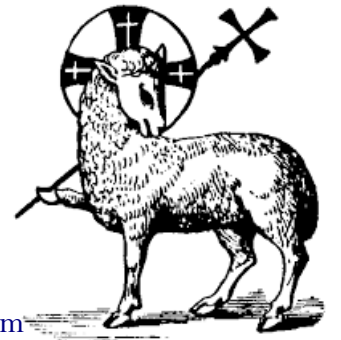

.OUR PARISH STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE CAMPAIGN HAS BEGUN

Our Parish Stewardship of Treasure Campaign has begun. Its purpose is to provide for our parish's ordinary income used to address the financial needs of our parish supporting all of its work and ministries. This campaign is different from the Annual Catholic Appeal in the spring which supports the needs of the broader Archdiocese. All proceeds of this campaign will remain in our Parish. These funds specifically support parish ministries, sacramental preparation, church and building maintenance and our staff and priest's needs. An introductory letter will be mailed out to you early next week. Your generous response is so very important this year when parish finances have been strained due to COVID restrictions on so many of our regular faith activities and limited Mass attendance.

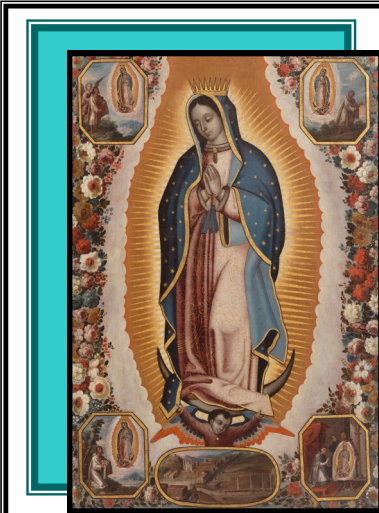
A STEWARDSHIP PRAYER

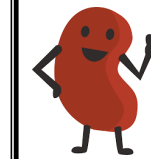
LIVE STREAMING NEEDS YOUR HELP!
