## Arizona Federation of Republican Women BIENNIAL CONVENTION MINUTES Phoenix-Mesa Hilton Resort October 27-28, 2017

#### **GENERAL SESSION-FRIDAY, OCT 27, 2017**

Call to Order: President Loraine Pellegrino called the 2017 Biennial Convention to order at 9:00 AM.

<u>Opening Ceremonies:</u> Invocation was given by Chaplain Gayle Salter of Arrowhead Republican Women. We honored our nation with a Presentation of Colors by the PATRIOT COLOR GUARD, American Legion Earl E. Mitchell Post 29 followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Americanism Chair Priscilla Poese of Ahwatukee Republican Women. The National Anthem was performed by Song of the Pines Chorus from Prescott.

<u>Welcome</u>: RNC Chairman kicked off the convention with video remarks to the body expressing appreciation for all that Republican Women do and how important the coming 2018 elections will be. Presiding Officer President Loraine Pellegrino then made welcome remarks to the body and introduced the officers at the head table.

1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Donna Tanzi introduced AzFRW member, the Honorable Michele Reagan, Arizona Secretary of State who gave a welcoming remarks. Following Secretary Reagan, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Tanzi indicated that second kick off speaker, Arizona Attorney General Mark Brnovich was delayed and would be joining us later.

<u>First Report of the Credentials Committee</u>: Credentials Chair Susan Marcell, Thunder Mtn RW reported 137 Delegates and 2 Alternates on the first report. **Motion:** The Credentials Chair moved adoption of the first credentials report. **Motion Adopted,** Quorum was established.

Adoption of the Convention Rules: Convention Rules Chair Jane Strain of Thunder Mtn RW referenced that all Delegates had been provided a written copy of the 2017 Convention Rules. Motion: Rules Chair Strain moved adoption of the rules in print as provided to the Delegates. Secondary Motion: Motion to delete the wording entirely in the "Programs" section of the Rules. Amendment to the Second Motion was made to delete only the "2/3" portion. Both secondary motions were defeated. Original Motion to accept the rules as printed was adopted.

<u>Adoption of the Convention Program</u>: Convention Program Chair Lezlee Alexander, Arrowhead RW read the Program Changes. **Motion**: She then moved adoption of the 2017 Convention Program as corrected. **Adopted**.

**2015 Convention Minutes:** 2015 Conventions Minutes Chair Nancy Kay Arnold, Lincoln RW addressed the body to advise that the 2015 Convention Minutes committee consisting of herself, Jill Slavin and Janet Powell had timely reviewed the 2015 Minutes and made their recommendations. She noted this was important as convention minutes go from convention to convention so are quiet for two years. She reported the 2015 Minutes were correct as amended.

<u>Appointment of the 2017 Convention Minutes Committee</u>: Without objection, the Chair appointed the following members to serve as the 2017 Minutes Committee:

<u>AzFRW's National Public Relations Award:</u> While awaiting the Second Credentials Report, the Chair showed a power point presentation of the Public Relations submission that was sent to NFRW which garnered AzFRW a national award in Philadelphia. She shared that AzFRW, once again, had won many national awards at the NFRW Convention including, the prestigious Diamond Level Award.

<u>Second Report of the Credentials Committee:</u> Credentials Chair Susan Marcell presented the Second Credentials Report which was resolved to be a total of 148 Delegates and 3 Alternates. **Motion:** Chairman Marcell then moved adoption of same. **Adopted.** 

**Report of the Nominating Committee:** Nominating Committee Chair Mary Morse thanked her committee and announced the nominees for the 2018-2019 Officers:

President Pellegrino thanked Chairman Morse and also thanked the Election Tellers Committee should any offices go to ballot. Elections Co-Chairs were Jeni White, Chandler RW and the Honorable Helen Purcell, Central RW of Phoenix and Laura Piscopo, Ahwatukee RW.

<u>Nominations from the Floor:</u> Prior to opening the floor for nominations, Presiding Officer Pellegrino briefly reviewed the procedures and reminded anyone running they should have sent her a written notice to serve if elected. She passed the gavel to 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Donna Tanzi.

**Election of President**: 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Tanzi then polled the body for any nominations from the floor for the office of President. There being none, nominations were closed. Pursuant to the AzFRW Bylaws and Roberts Rules of Order, the Chair declared that nominee Loraine Pellegrino was unanimously elected by acclamation as President for the 2018-2019 term. 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President Tanzi returned the gavel to President Pellegrino.

<u>Election of 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President:</u> President Pellegrino polled the body for any nominations from the floor for the office of 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President. Kathleen Winn was nominated. There were no further nominations and nominations were closed. Speeches were given and the Chair advised that elections for the office of 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President would take place the next day. She advised both candidates to please visit the Region Caucuses scheduled for that afternoon so the Delegates could meet with them.

**Elected:** Polling of each office continued. There being no nominees from the floor, nominations for each office were closed and the following were all elected by unanimous consent for the 2018-2019 term of office:

**Report of the Bylaws Committee:** Bylaws Chairman Jan Hermsmeyer presented the proposed amendments to the bylaws advising that all had received a copy in the Convention Program and they were also on the screen. Individually, she presented each amendment and moved adoption of same. The following were:

#5-Article VII, Section 1 (note there was a typo on VI vs VII heading but the content of the amendment was correct as Article VII)

The remainder of Bylaws Committee Report was paused to keep the body on schedule for the Awards Luncheon. Prior to recess, the Chair reminded everyone they needed to attend their Region Caucuses later in the afternoon to hear the candidates and discuss their Nominating Committee Representative.

The General Session was recessed until 9am on Saturday, Oct 28<sup>th</sup>.

#### **GENERAL SESSION**-SATURDAY, OCT 28, 2017

Session was reconvened at 9:00 am by President Loraine Pellegrino.

<u>Opening:</u> Invocation was given by Chaplain Gayle Salter, Pledge of Allegiance was led by Americanism Chair Priscilla Poese. Sgt at Arms and Paradise President Judy Lawrence led everyone in singing our National Anthem.

**Welcome:** The Chair welcomed everyone and again introduced the officers at the head table.

<u>Final Report of the Credentials Committee:</u> Chairman Susan Marcell presented the final tally at 157 Delegates, 4 Alternates and 28 Guests for a grand total of 189. **Motion:** On behalf of the Credentials Committee, she moved adoption of the Final Credentials Tally. **Adopted.** 

**Election of the AzFRW 2018-2019 Nominating Committee:** The Chair polled each Region to see if there were nominees for the position of Nominating Committee Representative. There were no nominees from the floor for any of the Regions and the Chair declared the following were elected by acclamation of their Regions:

<u>Election for 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President:</u> The Chair advised the body to stand at ease while the Sgt at Arms would dismiss the delegates by Regions to go vote. She also said that if desired, Regions could quietly caucus before being dismissed to vote. During this time, we heard from additional candidates and guests:

**Election of Region V Nominating Committee Representative:** The Chair advised the body that she had been made aware that Debra McVey was ineligible to run for Nominating Committee Representative as she had served the previous term. The Chair declared her election invalid and asked Region V to caucus and provide another name. The name of Linda Nichols was nominated. The Chair asked if there were any other nominees for the office from within Region V. There were none, nominations were closed and Linda Nichols was duly elected by acclamation as the Region V Nominating Committee Representative.

Election Teller Jeni White advised a last call for anyone who had not yet voted.

**Report of the Resolutions Committee:** Resolutions Chair Rae Chornenky advised all Delegates had been provided with a printed copy of the proposed Resolutions in their Convention Programs.

**Motion:** Resolutions Chair read the Resolved section for Resolution #1 and moved adoption. Presiding Officer Pellegrino put the question. **Resolution #1 Adopted.** 

**Motion:** Resolutions Chair read the Resolved section for Resolution #2 and moved adoption. Presiding Officer Pellegrino put the question. **Resolution #2 Adopted.** 

**Motion:** Resolutions Chair read the Resolved section for Resolution #3 and moved adoption. Presiding Officer Pellegrino put the question. **Resolution #3 Adopted.** 

**Motion:** Resolutions Chair read the Resolved section for Resolution #4 and moved adoption. Presiding Officer Pellegrino passed the gavel to 1<sup>st</sup> VP Tanzi who put the question. **Resolution #4 Adopted** with standing ovation. Chairman's gavel returned to President Pellegrino who thanked the body.

While awaiting the Tellers elections result report, Chairman Pellegrino asked 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Cindy Casaus to present her Membership Awards. The following cumulative two year award certificates were presented for:

Cyndi Love will be our next 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President. **Motion:** Motion to destroy the ballots was made and seconded. Chairman Pellegrino called the question. **Motion adopted.** 

There being no further business to come before the body President Pellegrino again thanked everyone and without objection adjourned the meeting sine die.
