PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to WAC 363-116-065: Number of Pilots, the Washington State Board of Pilotage Commissioners is charged with setting the number of pilots to be licensed in each pilotage district in the state that is best calculated to optimize the operation of safe, fully regulated, efficient, and competent pilotage service.

On January 8, 2019, Puget Sound Pilots requested that the Board review the number of pilots in the Puget Sound Pilotage District. The Board is gathering information and data that can be used to assist in setting the number of pilots in the Puget Sound Pilotage District.
