

Sacred Heart School Service Credit Opportunities 2019-2020

Passive Fund raisers

- **Box Tops and Labels for Education**
 - **Chairman will get 15 credits each semester for entering code numbers.**
 - Students submit each week and then are entered by Chairman.
 - In November and May we receive checks that are used to buy items for teachers and students for classrooms. Average checks are up to \$500.00

Four weeks prior to each event, a message via Reminder will be forwarded that the Sign Up website will be open for the event. Each event will have a limited number need for specific time slots. A parent can only sign up for two shifts per event. REMINDER all parents; relatives and/or friends must have a current background check on file at the school office in order to volunteer.

14 Sept 2019- Rummage Sale.

- **Chairman will receive 15 Service Credits and Co-Chairman will receive 10 credits**
- Our Fall Rummage Sale is under the pavilion and averages about \$1,200 profit for the PTC.
- Setting up on Friday 6 Sept 2020, 12 noon to 6pm in which each hour worked you will receive 1 service credit.
- Running the rummage, 7 Sept 2020, sale 630am -1pm in which each hour worked you will receive 1 service credit.
- For tear down from 1200pm to 1pm will receive 2 credits during that time.

Sept 2019-Jan 2020 Catholic Life Raffle Tickets

- Catholic Life Raffle Tickets sales will begin in Sept. Families are responsible for selling 40 tickets (worth \$200) but can request more from our office. Please keep in mind that proceeds from these tickets are 100% profit for our school. Also, the top selling boy and girl in Kindergarten through 5th grade will be King, and Queen of our Valentine Court. The top selling boy and girl from 3K and 4K will Jr. King and Queen. The next top selling students in 3K through 5th will be Prince, Princess, Duke and Duchess. part of the Valentine Court!
- Last year the school sales totaled \$38,000!!!

8 Oct 2019 – Goober Games

- **Chairman will receive 15 Service Credits**
- We have averaged making about \$1,000 each of the last two years for the PTC. The list of what items we need for each family will be loaded on Sign Up 20 September 2019.
- Also on Sign Up we will have 2 hr shifts needed from 12 Noon to 8pm.
- Double credits will be given for those on the last shift to move items back to the school.

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11-12 October 2019- Coke a Cola Booth

- Last year, we made \$3,800. We have 2 hour shifts starting on Friday 12 Oct 11am – 12am and Saturday 8am-1am. Due to size of trailer, we will need only need three people on each shift. Due to insurance policy, no children are allowed in the trailer.
- Each hour worked you before 10pm will receive 1 service credit. Hours worked after 10pm will receive 2 credits per hour.

7 December 2019- Casino Night

- Our 6th Annual Casino Night will be held on 7 December at the Parish Hall. Each family will need to sell two tickets to this event and will receive 4 Service credits. Tickets are \$50 each and include a dinner and, \$1,000 in gaming chips. This will also be a BYOU event. We'll also have a silent auction and bucket drops on "baskets" which have been chosen by each class.
- Set up will be from 12 noon to 6 pm on 6 December 2019 which each hour worked you will receive 1 service credit.
- On 7 December from 4pm to 12am we will have two hour shifts to work silent auction, run students bucket drops; and chip runners. The last shift 10pm to 12am for clean- up will receive 2 Service Credits for each hour.
- Service credits for each \$25 dollars toward student baskets and/or silent auction item.
- This one of the highlights of the year to come out and have a good time!! Last year the school made a profit of over \$8,000.

23 Jan 2019- 31Jan 2020 Book Fair

- Over the past three years we have been very successful with our school book fair. We have been able to buy books for several class rooms as well as give each child their own special book at Christmas and then again during the book fair.
- Closer to the event, we send out the two hour works shifts to set up, work the book fair and pack up.

15 Feb 2020 Valentine Court Coronation

- As stated earlier, the 8 highest sellers from Catholic Life Raffle Tickets will become our new Valentine Court.
- The Coronation will take place in the Parish Hall from 4:30 to 5:30 and then all will attend the mass at 6:00pm.
- During the year, the Court will be required to attend at least three parades- The La Vernia Blue Bonnet Parade, Stockdale Watermelon parade and the Floresville Peanut Festival Parade. For each parade you will receive three credits.

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18 April 2020 Wine and Art

- This is the school's biggest fund raiser, in which we profited up \$33,000.
- **Chairman will receive 15 Service Credits**
- Tickets are \$50 each, which include a catered dinner, and free wine tasting. We also have sponsorships

 - Gold Level \$500
One reserved table for 8 at the Wine & Art Festival, 2 bottles of wine, individual gift for each place setting, recognition on program brochure, table top display & recognition on web site as Corporate Sponsor for one year
 - Silver Level \$250
Four tickets to the Wine & Art Festival & co-reserved table with other silver-level sponsor, 1 bottle of wine, recognition on program brochure, marketing materials
 - Bronze Level \$150
Two general admission tickets, recognition on program brochure, marketing materia
