# Soul and Spirit

*'Seed of God and of Man'*Bro. Lee Vayle – November 15, 1992

[Shall we] pray. Heavenly Father, we appreciate Your kindness to us, which is beyond imagination, beyond reasoning Lord, we cannot fathom it, we can by faith accept it, seeing we have been endowed with the proper soul and the life genes of God to receive that which is given to us, that as Bro. Branham said You are here in vindication and power and wonder, You are actually wooing a Bride to Yourself, and truly currying favor with her, which is indeed a most marvelous statement, in light of the fact that so much of the worship of people today is one of necessity brought about by a fear, one that does not truly understand the love of God, and the grace and goodness of God, which at this moment we must admit we are heir to, and humbly confess Lord that we are not fully appreciative and in tune with that which is in this hour. But knowing Lord, that this life here is given in the flesh that we might be tested and tried and sanctified in the life processes of the Word by the Holy Spirit, and yet going into the Millennium for further sanctification. We are not too alarmed, we just hope we have not fallen short in this particular segment of our journey, as we get ready for the next one. May we through this Word, the life of the Word, the faith that we have in this Word of vindications, put us in direct wonderful order to go into that next land Lord, and receive further edification, sanctification, growing up as we have not previously, nor could we, until that particular hour.

So we rest our faith and hope in You this morning Lord, not in our own faith, but in the faith of the Lord Jesus Christ, that one who Himself believed You Lord God, so perfectly and so marvelously, that we can rest upon His faith in You and that faith absolutely manifested in us. This we rest on this morning and thank You Father that we are not of those hopefully who want to put something to that which You have done, but we stand back in perfect rest, knowing that You have done it all, and we can depend on it. In Jesus' Name, we pray. Amen.

- 1. Now we're going to talk about the seed of God and the seed of Satan, or we'll talk about soul and spirit, which I suppose that is what it's all about or at least to a degree. Now last Sunday we were going into the question as to what kind of a soul, if any, Cain had, based upon the fact that his father, the beast, did not have a soul, though he did have a place for a soul. Now Bro. Branham said, "The beast, or the serpent did not have a soul, but he actually had a place for a soul." In other words, this would cause us to presuppose the serpent seed, the serpent himself, though having no soul, serpent seed, that is which is a duplication, or coming forth at that same life, would have some type of a soul. Because if there's a place for it, there would be something there in the Scripture, and in the fulfillment of Scripture, which of course is the individual, if you want to call him that, which he was, which was Cain, and whomsoever he fostered.
- 2. Now this of course posed the hard question, because it would appear that since Cain's father had no soul, and Eve could not even pass on life to him, (that is Cain,) except for equal physical genes and chromosomes if the chromosomes and genes were equal, and I would suspect that they were, in order to produce a child. And these would all form physical qualities and

characteristics only, so it would seem that there was no way Cain could have a soul. Yet it is very evident by Scripture that not one of the human race of one clump of clay. Now you understand what I am saying, not, as we know the human race, which of one lump of clay – that is not said in Scripture, as far as I know, that there is one of them that doesn't have a soul. But contrary wise, it appears axiomatic that every single being that came from Adam and Eve, and came from Eve and the beast – that's two lines here we're talking about, two genealogies, two types of beings – it is not said that any of them does not have a soul. But rather the Bible speaks of everyone having a soul, and that soul could live forever, or be destroyed in hell according to God's foreknowledge and election and predestination, and that – foreknowledge, election, predestination – would be according to the source of the soul. Do you understand what I'm saying? So that's what you're looking at. And that's a tough one.

- 3. Now, as we finished our discourse last Sunday, which was anything but a definitive answer, and I got to admit it, we had to face Bro. Branham's own problem with the question or questions that arose, or that arise, as we deal with soul and spirit, conscious and sub-conscious or unconscious mind. And all those relate a spirit realm, spirit realm, the invisible. Spirit realm propositions of our humanity that are more vague or mysterious than point-blank, and easily understood revelations, let us say, about justification, sanctification, baptism, and so on. So you're dealing with very intricate things here, that at this point we still have to deal with them, looking at them, and leave them as we find them, unless we can come to something tremendously definitive from Bro. Branham's message.
- 4. Now, you remember I filled you in on what Bro. Branham said concerning a very disconcerting pressure he was under, as he set forth in a vision of fishing. Now the vision of fishing was the middle one of a composite, where Bro. Branham was out fishing, as I mentioned, surrounded by a bunch of preachers, and they were encouraging Bro. Branham to show them how to fish, because there was a lot of fish out there. And there was little fish, and medium sized fish, and great big fish. And Bro. Branham being a fisherman, and an excellent one, he really knew how to fish.

So the day I was with him he didn't catch anything as he put his little... oh two bit kind of fishing material out there on the river, and he cut little pieces of branches with a fork on it, and he'd throw the line out there, and then he'd put the little – you know his little cheap fishing rod – I think it was even home-made in some cases, I don't think he had a pin on it though, you know, he had was something bought. He put a rock on it, and then watched to see if any of the lines bobbed. See if he got anything. Unfortunately he never caught anything that day, but we did have a good time talking, anyway.

5. Well anyway, Bro. Branham was an excellent fisherman. And he was going to tell the preachers how to fish. Now remember this is spiritual thing. And he tossed the line out, he said, "Now what you do, you toss the line way out there," and he said, "give it the teeniest jerk, and that will excite the little fishes, and the little fishes coming will excite the middle-sized fishe, and the middle-size fish will excite the great big ones, and remember you're fishing for the great big ones." That's what the story was all about.

Well, Bro. Branham got too excited by their screaming and jumping up and down proclaiming him as a great fisherman, because what you're looking at of course is his tremendous vindication.

And of course instead of giving the little quick jerk, you know to get the little fishes trailing, he inadvertently gave a mighty sweep, and he came out with the fish skin-tight over the lure, which is impossible. I think it's impossible. Any fisherman here? Gene, does that seem pretty impossible to you? Yeah, I think so. And it was a fiasco. And his lines were all around his feet, it was a real mess.

6. And the next thing he's got a little tiny baby shoe, and he's trying to put about, oh maybe the end of his finger thick, through a little tiny eyelet – you know what the eyelet of a baby's shoe is like, and I think they still have baby's shoes with eyes on them, for laces to strap them up, to give the kid good support. Most of them, I guess today, they're Velcro, and you know, slip on, and all that stuff. I still see them with those eyelets though.

And the angel said, "Now look what you did." See? And "I told you not to get your lines mixed up in troublous times like these." And Bro. Branham crying and mumbling and the angel said, "Here," he said, "you've got the wrong end. No wonder you can't make it fit." And so he took a little tiny end and he could come through.

7. And the moral of the story was you can't teach Pentecostal babies spiritual things, which you know, devolve into gifts – which are spiritual gifts, but true spiritual things of course happen to be the Word, which I myself break down to the fact, more or less, of doctrine.

But you see that's what they came to Bro. Branham and said, "Now Bro. Branham, instead of getting after our women here, our ladies, why don't you teach them spiritual things about spiritual gifts?"

And he said, having learned this lesson, he said, "How in the world can you teach them spiritual things like that – teach them algebra, when they don't even know their ABC's?"

Now, Bro. Branham himself admitted, and it could have been when the tape was being turned over, or it's just inadvertently missed, but I was there when he talked about it, and he said, "See what it was..." trying to explain to the preachers where the mind is, and the conscious and subconscious, and where the spirit lies and all of those things.

And so as you study with me, and you remember what various preachers are preaching, and have preached, you will find that this subject is a very, very dangerous subject. And you can get into a lot of hot water, by thinking that you can bring it to a point where you can really utilize it, or you begin to bring it into an area where you can one, two, three, four. That you really know all about it.

So we're going to work on it this morning again, bring up some more points, which perhaps were not brought up last week, and you can begin to see, I believe, from what we go into, that there is so much interchanging of words that lie in the same realm. And yet, because of those words, define certain areas within those realms that evidently, and no doubt God wants us to know, but you cannot bring it to just each word being perfectly set in its own little category and you cannot move from it, but you find an overlapping. All right.

8. Now, years ago because of what I mentioned here, the difficulty that Bro. Branham had, and he was rebuked, because he'd done this very thing that he should not have done, I mentioned

when I considered the two souls doctrine, and I considered it error, because they were trying to figure out things in this very subject, and it just doesn't work the way you think you're going to make it work, listening to Bro. Branham's sermons. And I realize that the opening of the Seals, we have the correction of the errors, and we have much we did not have before, but remember, Bro. Branham used the same thought that Scofield and other men have used, and that is though the mystery has been explained, there is still an element of the mystery so that you do not have it as perfect as you might think that you do have it.

9. Now back years ago, Bro. Branham – now I'll just make mention of this one quote that I did not bring with me, but it's back in about 1961 – Bro. Branham mentioned that God created the soul and the spirit, and the body was there waiting for it. Now you know that that statement wouldn't even begin to hold water from... oh say about 1963, the opening of the Seals, and perhaps even before then, because I haven't checked every single solitary thing through. You know that is not correct, that there's a created soul, and a created spirit waiting for that body, which would mean instantly there is a life in the womb, as he said on one place, separate from the other life. It would not hold strictly with the Scripture, because first thing you're going to have, you're going to have too many souls, and too many spirits and too many everything. You're going to have pyramiding of it. You see?

That's like when they say the old soul must die. Was Bro. Branham saying there was actually an old soul that had to die? Well the point is: how old is old? So they said, "What's the difference between Jesus and God?"

He said, "No difference, except one had a beginning."

10. So all right. The old soul then, if you're going to call it old, would be that which without a beginning. Do you want to get rid of your eternal gene? What is he talking about? So all right then, we might go into the Greek and the Hebrew. Well did Bro. Branham do it? Yes he did to a certain degree, but never came before you and me and did it. So, you have to be pretty careful as to what you're looking at.

So we notice, that what Bro. Branham said back in '61 concerning the creating of a soul and a spirit to receive that body, was absolutely changed essentially in the fact, and you know the quote positively, that Bro. Branham made it many times, and he said, "You can take the raunchiest, filthiest woman," she could even be a prostitute of great magnitude and filth, "and bring forth a baby and just before she brings forth that baby, no matter how raunchy, how miserable, how wicked, how mean, how this, how that," unless she's mental, "she seems to change as a sweetness comes into the room, because there's a spirit waiting there to receive the body." Is that right? That's what he said, different times. He didn't say a thing about the soul, did he?

11. So you can see that as we look at the questions here, and we look at what we are dealing with, you'll find that it's actually only after the opening of the Seals we get to anything that even purports to be a definitive, and you will see the strange thing is that much of this is in the last ten sermons that Bro. Branham preached, the last little while just before he expired, and particularly those out in California, which there were a few.

So we notice, that Bro. Branham's statement concerning soul and spirit being created was greatly changed, as to being more definitive after the Seals, though even before the Seals he used Larkin's statement on attributes that lie in the soul and the spirit, but changed that by putting the spirit on the outside of the soul, in order to explain anointed ones at the end time.

12. Now, this is identically what Bro. Branham used. I could have had it magnified large here, but it's the three-fold nature of man. He has 'body', which is 'soma', and with it down below he has 'carnal', that would be 'toma' and 'soma' – of course the word 'carnal' is not 'toma' but it's 'carnous'. Then he has the 'soul' or the 'psyche' in the second circle, and he has the 'spirit', which is 'numa', within the third, and within that spirit he places the Holy Spirit. And in there Bro. Branham used the very same things that Larkin did. In the body there are five gates: eye gate, nose gate, ear gate, mouth gate, and the feel gate. In other words, it mentions those five senses of feeling and smelling and hearing and so on.

And then of course Bro. Branham said there was another attribute, another sense, the sixth sense, which is by faith. And of course that is not necessarily a part of the body, but it actually would be distinctly against the body and distinctly against part of your being, whether you call it the mind, and the mind works with the spirit, so now you've got another element in there, that's why there's conscious, subconscious and unconscious and so on.

13. Now within the soul, he had imagination, conscience, memory, reason, and affections. Now within the spirit he had the faculties of faith, hope, reverence, prayer, worship, and spiritual insight, I guess – let me see, one, two, three, four – no he had the spiritual insight is what that all counts to, comes to, the spiritual spirit.

Now Bro. Branham actually taught that. But however when it came time to reveal the real definitive truth of the two vines, and the two seeds, you will notice that Bro. Branham, by absolute revelation of God, turned around and told us he'd made a mistake. That the spirit was not on the inside, it was the soul that was on the inside, and the spirit on the outside can contact the five senses, and the reasoning, which is not a part of the five senses, although the five senses contribute to it, and the reasoning is based upon it, takes place in the mind, in the spirit. Right? That's what he said. So all right, he had to change that. And when he did, he left the various attributes as they were, so that in the soul was faith, hope, reverence, prayer and worship, and within the spirit was imagination, conscience, memory, and so on.

- 14. Now, Bro. Branham did not belabor it. He did not claim originality, he merely went along with Larkin. And remember of course that Bro. Branham could not claim originality as though without him you had no doctrine, you had no spirit, you had no anything. That would be the most fallacious thing under high heaven. What Bro. Branham claimed and was true, under the Seven Seals, the errors were corrected, and what had been not given from the Word to the true revelation and meaning of it, because it was not time, he would bring it forth. That's why when they came and said, "Bro. Branham you could write another Bible." He said, "No, by no means." He said, "That's a trap you're trying to put me into. Because you cannot add to, and you cannot take from, it is in here!"
- 15. So we understand where we're coming from. Right. I'm sure we do. With that in mind, let's just jump over here to Luke 16, beginning at verse 19.

- (19) There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:
- (20) And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
- (21) And desiring to be fed with crumbs which fell from the rich man's table: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

Now this is the rich man, who turned down Jesus, from following him, and then he went – Jesus knew his weak spot, which was finances. The guy just loved money and everything that could do with money, and he just hogged everything to himself, and spent it on himself. And then he had so many crops, so he had to build more barns. And he said, "Soul take thy ease, eat, drink and be merry," because he said, "you've got much goods laid up the rest of your time."

16. One man said, "This man mistook his soul for his body." But that's not really true. Because you can use the word 'soul' as in the Bible that says, "Eight souls were saved in the ark." Simply designating people, that's all there is to it.

You can also designate your soul as an affection for food. In other words, "What thy soul lusteth after." ...?... the Bible. It says, "You sell what you've got here, because it's too far to go to Jerusalem, where you're going to worship, and you sell it, and take the money, then buy what thy soul lusteth for." Showing in other words, if you've got a particular taste that you want to indulge in, at the time of the sacrifice, you're well able to do it. And the taste lies within the mouth. Right? Yeah, the salivary glands, and the little taste buds, and all those things there.

17. So all right, we just trying to show you that many people jump at things, and they have no business jumping at them. And when they jump, you know they jump overboard, and if you happen to hit the swells and high water, one of the waves, you'll – pbbt – you just go down. Now Bro. Branham told us not to jump. He said, "Stay with the vessel, because the vessel has got the stabilizers on it, and thereby we crest every wave." And the stay with the vessel is stay with the Word.

All right. Now it says here that: [Luke 16:]

- (21) ...the dogs came and licked his sores.
- (22) And the beggar died, and was carried by angels (to) Abraham's bosom: the rich man died, and was buried;
- (23) And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and see(ing) Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom.
- (24) ...he cried and said, Father Abrahm, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his [finger] in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in flame.

Now notice the man had memory. Now what can go to hell? The soul can go to hell. Rght? Ha-hah, the Bible says so. "Destroy both body and soul in hell." Of course that looks to the lake

of fire and the final destruction. And Bro. Branham mentioned when your spirit leaves your body it goes back to God, just like Jesus did, his soul goes to Hades, and Bro. Branham said your soul goes – and Bro. Branham was in that place where he saw those women with cats eyes coming up in the spirit world, going "Oooh, oooh, oooh," And he said, "*The most horrible thing under heaven*." He said, "*It's like a never-never land, always falling and falling*," you see. If you think you got it tough here, you wait till you go there.

18. So all right, this man was in torment. So now he has memory, he has feeling, right? Also, he says, "Let him put his finger, and put it on my tongue. Because I'm tormented, it's too hot down here."

Now this could be a parable, but remember a parable talks about something. And so Bro. Branham is agreeing, because Larkin is taking material from – I don't know where he's from, I'm just pointing out that Larkin had a legitimate reason to say these things. Now:

(25) (He) said, Son, remember in thy lifetime (thou) receivedst good things,

He's got his memory, twice it's mentioned now. He's got recognition, because he recognizes. And you notice he's the real old McCoy that he was, and the beggar, Lazarus, is the same old real McCoy, and Abraham's the same old real McCoy. That's why Jesus said, "God is the God of the living, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, He's not the God of the dead." Right? So all right. And this was before the first resurrection, when Lazarus will come forth, and Abraham come forth, and Isaac, and David, and these great men of God. Okay.

#### 19. Now:

- (26) And beside this there is a great gulf fixed: so they which would pass from hence to you cannot; (and) neither can they pass from thence.
- (27) Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldest send him to my father's house:
- (28) (I've got) five brethren; that he may testify (to) them, lest they come (to) this place...

Now this man evidently had compassion. Yeah. He had brotherly kindness, he had brotherly love. And you'll notice that he repented. Oh yeah! You can't preach repentance unless you yourself repent. Now he didn't repent that he was a bird of an off color. He repented he got caught. It's like the guy said. He said, "I'm not scared to steal, I'm scared of getting caught." So when you're scared to steal, because you're afraid you might get caught, it proves like one fellow said, "You're not a thief because you steal, you steal because you're a thief." Oh these witty, witty things that people tell us. The ...?... you know. All right.

20. So, all these things were in him. So you can see that if the soul went down there... my understanding is absolutely that the soul has memory. Of course the spirit would have too. You would have reason. You would have conscience. Certainly have imagination, and affection.

So all right, what I'm looking at here is, and trying to show you, that Bro. Branham agreeing at that particular time and as he said he never was wrong on his doctrine. But he was wrong in certain facets or characteristics concerning the major doctrine of which he was not wrong, but in error that he himself was in that needed correction. For Bro. Branham himself as a prophet did not need correction that he was the Seals. Christ is the Seals! Remember Bro. Branham categorically said, "When Adam and Eve got into sin, He did not send anybody, even an archangel, down for His son and His daughter. He Himself came down, and so today, got His picture."

- 21. So all right, we're looking now after the opening of the seals, what Bro. Branham said supercedes or corrects anything and everything that was before it. And even at that we're not going to learn an awful lot. I just guarantee you. You'll be better off listening, of course, because you'll look at some things and see some things, then you'll be smart enough to leave it alone. Now some people simply can't stop picking. As they keep picking at a sore, it just gets bigger and bigger and bigger, and you start putting this in your mind, you just get further and further away from the truth. Because remember there's a certain Scripture in there we got to look at a little later on.
- 22. Now then, after the Seals particularly, now particularly after the Seals, Bro. Branham began to associate the soul with eternal endowments! Meaning that the soul entirely, as a complete unit, whatever the soul is, or at least in part, if there's something inside the soul, is actually eternal! It never had a beginning! It was not created, as he taught in 1961. True. There's all there is to it. It is actually, was and is a part of God. This lines perfectly with Gen 2:7, "He breathed into his nostrils the breath of life..." which was the Holy Ghost. Period! And it says, "He became a living soul." It also says in the vernacular, the original, as far as I know, "He breathed in the breath of lives, and man became a living soul." In other words, at that time, he was fully fit to propagate as a son of God, and God's Own sons. Now that's going to make everybody sit up and take notice, because you see, they all got the idea the soul pops in at a certain time, or you don't have this, or you don't have that, you're not born with it well, fiddle-dee-dee, and fall-dee-rall, I'm not interested in those guys one little bit.
- 23. Okay, let us therefore read some quotes. [Works Is Faith Expressed, 11/26/65]
- [62] No circumstances will be considered when faith finds its bedding ground.

In other words, you can't look to circumstances. You're going to look positively apart from every single thing that you think you know, under the microscope, without the microscope, or anything else. But you can relate to the human bodies of reproduction.

[62] When a germ gene from a man finds the egg in the woman, and both of them fertile, something's going to happen. Hallelujah. The doctor can say, "You'll not have a baby. I can prove that genes in your body dead, her eggs will never be fertile." But let that fertile egg...

In other words, the woman doesn't have life; we know that, the man has the life. But that egg cannot be rotten, it has to have fresh, distinct properties within it for the living sperm to touch it. In other words, it's already been produced by a life, a process within the woman that came from

the man, and it's lying right there with everything it needs to unite with the sperm, and it's absolutely just as important as the sperm is. No egg? You're in trouble. No sperm? You're in trouble.

## 24. All right, now:

- [62] But let that fertile egg, (Now watch his language, it's beautiful,) let that germ twist into that egg one time, watch what happens; that little boy or that little girl comes on the scene. Why? Faith has found its bedding ground. Works goes to work, (watch) cell on top of cell, and here comes the little fellow. Amen. God, have mercy on us.
- [63] O God, to be rugged Christians like we should be. If we're men and women, we could take God at His Word. You can't do it until it's revealed to you.

Now he's taking you here, we don't read the whole context of it, he's taking this little example here into the spiritual, taking the physical.

- 25. Now watch, <u>Modern Events Made Clear</u>. [Modern Events Are Made Clear By Prophecy, 12/06/65]
- [48] But the real, ordained of God, that real gene, that real germ, a real soul of God that was in God before the foundation of the world... Remember, you that's really got the Spirit of God in you tonight, you were here in Christ, before He was the Fullness of the Word. He was the Fullness of the Godhead bodily. God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself. Do you believe that? Look, He was in Christ. Then if you were in God, a gene, a word, an attribute from the beginning, then you walked with Him here on earth; you talked with Him on earth, you suffered with Him on earth; you died with Him at Calvary; (he even mentions suffering, paying the price for your own sins in another place,) and you rose with Him again; and now you're sitting in heavenly places in Christ Jesus, communing with Him, in the Word, as It feeds your soul, that, "Man shall live by every Word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

That's a far cry from what was said in 1961. See? And you say, "Well Bro. Branham was wrong on his doctrine." You're absolutely wrong. He was right in his doctrine, body, soul, spirit, he knew that. But he couldn't place it entirely until God showed him. Didn't know the substance whereof, though it was in the Bible, and we took you back to Genesis to show you – and Bro. Branham gave us the key, he knew it! That was the Holy Spirit God breathed into that man. And set those life processes going. We may talk about that a little more in a little while.

## 26. [Things That Are To Be, 12/05/65]

[40] Now the next thing you receive was the baptism of the Holy Ghost and Fire. Now, God, when this millennium is over, God's going to give the world a baptism of fire. It's going to blow the whole thing up. The heavens and earth will be on fire. Peter said so. And the thing will have a baptism of fire,

- renovation of the whole thing, and then there'll be a new heavens and a new earth. That's where righteousness will dwell.
- [41] That's where... We become from mortal beings, from time beings to eternal beings when the Word of God lit our soul and we became sons and daughters with the attribute, and gene of God in us...
- 27. Now notice in there it will sound like he's saying, "You become then, you become then." He's not saying. He said, "You become sons and daughters, the gene of God in us." He doesn't say this brings the gene of God in you, he said the gene of God is in you, and you're sons and daughters. And when the Holy Ghost falls upon you, and he's talking about the baptism of fire, which is the renovation, which really is a deliverance. You see what the fire what does the fire do? It puts it in a position to go back to the original! Do you follow me? So the baptism with the Holy Ghost puts us in position to go back to the original sons of God...not having a Word body, by the baptism we're just as good as having a Word body, because now we can walk in the light. You say, "You mean just as good?" Sure! Because when we fall into sin a thousand times a day, backslide a thousand times, He stands there as our great intercessor, the One who brought us in to keep us in.

See, you've got to put the whole thing together and just don't jump around like a bunch of chickens on a hot brick. If you take your doctrine without understanding the true lines of doctrine, you can mess up. And you will mess up, just put it that way. Now if you're a son and daughter of God, you won't.

- 28. Now: [Things That Are To Be, 12/05/65]
- [88] And make that an altar, 'cause the altar's setting full of people. (Like he's talking about, you know, an altar's up here, they can't get to it. Now he said, "What are you going to make an altar?") Make that altar there in the chair where you're sitting, make your heart that altar. May the world move off from every brother, and sister in here. And may that little Germ of Life, that Gene of God we just talked about, that attribute that came down from God and has been manifested here (How? The discernment, the vindication,) to honor and glorify God... God, move the world from them.

That's your perfect faith. See? I've talked to a brother the other day, and he said, "Lee, you know," he said, "I've picked up that book <u>Perfect Faith</u>, it's underlined here and there and every place else," and he said, "man, I didn't understand it." You know why I believe he didn't understand it? Good brother. Because he was thinking in terms of Bro. Branham telling us that was our ministry. That was Bro. Branham telling us that his perfect vindication gave him the perfect revelation vindicated, then when you're a part of it, you have perfect faith! Because faith is a revelation. Then what comes out of it is going to come according to Word.

Like the other day I was just thinking, "Oh boy, oh boy," talking to God, "now Lord if some little thing here," and say... And I thought, "Oh shut-up stupid, it's in the Word!" Still got too much Pentecostal hogwash in us. Too much go to the refrigerator door, "Oh the lights off, something's going to have.....?..." Oh for Pete's sake, put a new bulb in or get the switch

fixed. Pshee. You going to make God a refrigerator light? Like the old "Oh when I get the goose bumps, I know it's God." And now He's God of the goose bumps, so I've heard everything. Yeah, yep, yep, yep.

- 29. Okay, Modern Event. [Modern Events Are Made Clear By Prophecy, 12/06/65]
- [23] And so we find out that God does that in every age. God does His own choosing by His own predestinated choosing, chooses His prophets and things for the age.
- [24] Fixes his nature, the man's nature... is to meet the challenge of that day. God creates that man and sends him. And in His own mind, as I preached on last night, we are a germ of the gene of God.

In other words, we're the life right behind anything that's going to appear. You know, we had it from God. That's right. If you don't have what came from God is life, whatever does appear, it's vain! See, that's why everything is destroyed and burnt up, completely annihilated outside of the two virgins, wise and foolish! God can't waste – do you mean to tell me that God will destroy a part of Himself? Come on. As in Adam all died, even so in Christ – it says, "In identical manner." What does it mean identical manner? We didn't have a choice in our falling away, and we don't have a choice in our falling up! Do what you want with it, I can read my Bible. I have no problem.

[24] Fixes his nature, (and so on.) ...I preached last night.... He knew that man would be there in that age before there was a molecule, or a light...

That's your Rhema Logos again. What was back in there – period! – can never change, never violated, will always manifest exactly what was there. Why? Because He's omniscience and omnipotence and nature of love. Can you beat that? Why, my goodness me. You could never – as a father you just couldn't want anything better.

- 30. Future Home. [Future Home Of The Bride, 08/02/64]
- [84] Look, those hands that designed this for His Beloved the Bride: (New Jerusalem, see?) designed in tender love for His Bride. Remember that the Holy Ghost descended on Jesus, which Jesus was a part of the earth. Why? The germ of God, the Life of God was designed in the womb of a woman (Is that right?), which was on earth. All right. And then the Life of God came in, so He was the beginning of the creation of God. See?

See what judged? What was in His mind, coming down, down? Right there. Came right to human flesh. Showed it by every pattern. Like Bro. Branham said, God was in the prophets in a measure, right. Then He came what? He was the fullness of the Word, God Himself came in, what? To a prophet. What's He done now? Put the life in a Bride. Typed in David and his five hundred wives. And so on.

[84] All right. Then the Life of God came in, so (we saw that.) See? And then the Blood of God, (See? And then that Blood of God,) that was there by that germ,

which was shed at Calvary, dropped back upon the earth. What for? To redeem the earth. Now, it's been justified; it's been sanctified, called and claimed; and now it's to receive its baptism of fire, and to be cleansed for Jesus and His Bride.

- 31. Now remember, he's talking about this transition in nature, all coming through Jesus Christ, everything typing back and forth in perfection, like he said the three cleansing. He said one was by water, blood, fire. We're the same way, water breaks, blood comes, fire, life. See? Now I've got something here I'll read you too.
- [84] ...it's been sanctified, claimed; (and so on) receive its baptism of fire, be cleansed for Jesus and His Bride. And you are these other parts that's drawn out of this earth--the earth. You are part of the earth, your body. Your soul is a part of God...

Well is it or not? See that's the whole thing right there! See? And on that depends whether you are able to be reborn. Which means redeemed by the Blood and sealed! And with that life now to help, you can grow into a true, mature son of Almighty God, the life in the Word, the life in you, the life in God is all one, and one day even your body is going to come back out of the ground redeemed. See?

#### Now:

- [84] You are a part of the earth, your body. Your soul is part of God, an attribute of God, displayed here on earth in a body. (No body, no display. No man to till the soil, no soil tilled. No body, no reproduction.) The body's to be redeemed. Now the soul's redeemed, because it was in sin. (Sin what? Separate from God. It was in disobedience. Now remember it was not a soul of disobedience, no, no, no. Nope.) So God came down by process of justification, sanctification, baptism of the Holy Ghost, and redeemed your soul. And you, being part of the earth, it's redeemed by it. You're in the process now, it's going on.
- 32. Here's what Bro. Branham said, He Swore By Himself, [12/12/54] many years ago.
- [24] He said, "Now, wait a minute.

Now he's talking about a little conversation Jesus is carrying on to the people.

[24] "Now, wait a minute. You will be forgiven for that, because you're speaking against Me.

That's when they blasphemed, and said, "You're the serpent seed. You're not of God." They said, "We're of God, we were not born of fornication." Fornication is before your marriage, before you have relationship with your own husband, you'd be the virgin at that time, you gave yourself to somebody else. "We're not born of fornication." They knew what they were talking about, serpent seed. Now they called him that, because they said, "Is this not the Son of David?" when he healed the man. They said, "No, this is the other fellow." [End of side one of tape one.]

- 33. Okay, he says here,
- [24] "You'll be forgiven for that, because you're speaking against Me.
- [25] But when the Holy Ghost is come, don't you say such a remark as that. For remember, the Holy Ghost will warn you in your heart. There's no way for you to do it now, because the Blood cell that I'm wrapped in isn't broken yet. But one day a spear will open My side, and the blood Cell will be exposed then. And out will come My Life, and enter into the Father, and will return back in the form of Deity and power. Then the Blood cell will be there, and the Holy Ghost will deal with every human heart everywhere. Then if you willfully reject the truth when it's presented to you, there is never forgiveness in this world or the world to come."
- 34. And of course Bro. Branham took that for the end time more than any other time in the seven church ages, which the earth we've gone through. Things That Are To Be: [12/05/65]
- [71] "Well, my, I'm Pentecostal; I belong..." (And he's going to say Full Gospel Businessmen, something like that, I think.)
- [72] If you don't line with that Word, there's something wrong. See? Then you see, your real father isn't God, because that real start in your soul, before there was even a spirit, it was your soul. If that soul didn't come from God, then it wasn't a germ of God to begin with. You're deceived. You're in a patch of weeds and bearing the world's record of the weeds, coming forth acting like the world, loving the world, because the love of God is not in you.

Now how is the love of God get in you? By the baptism with the Holy Ghost. Now what's the conduit of the Holy Ghost? You say, "My body." Hold it, it's the Word! See, that's why Israel, as the time of Jesus, that bunch, could not receive him at all, because there was no place for the conduit! Now you see why we're looking at Rhema Logos, and sticking right with the truth as Bro. Branham made it interchangeable? We don't go for this high lowdown stuff.

# 35. Things That Are To Be:

[82] Look in your looking glass tonight and see, "Which way am I headed. Is Jesus preparing a place for me, a body? That body is perfect; that body walks orderly; if it's a son or daughter before God. And I'm in birth pains here to be born into that body there. If I still love the world, it shows that I'm not-- (you know, the germ of God.) I have no body there.

Why? Because – hey, it takes… let's just see it right here. In 1 Corinthians 15, it gives you the whole truth, which I really should reserve to another time, but I'm not going to do it. In verse 35.

(35) But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come?

- (36) ...fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:
- (37) And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but (of) bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or some other:
- (38) But God gives it a body as it pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

Then it says fish has one, fowl has one, this has one, that has one, angels have spirit bodies, we are going to have resurrection human...well, I've got to stop there, because it's not going to be human flesh, but it is flesh and bone.

- 36. You know, I just read the article the other day now I want to show you how stupid the Trinitarians are, and how little they know the Word, they know anything, they just know nothing. This guy is criticizing another guy, because he says the body of Jesus is immaterial, it's spiritual. And he said, "How can you say that it's human," and he said, "it's flesh and blood," that's a lie! Jesus said, "Handle me and see, a spirit hath not flesh and bone!" There isn't any blood there! You might as well be a Mormon, a Mohammedan, having sex in the Millennium and in New Jerusalem. Forget it! Bunch of pigs! They haven't even got enough to come out of their wallow; they never ever came out to go back to it. Well if I'm tough, I might as well die for being tough. If they get us, they get us. Close us down, they close us down. Let's get it closed down for a good thing. See? You're deceived. You're in the patch of weeds bearing the world record. See, in other words, you're a weed. Tare trying to act like a wheat.
- 37. [82] Look in your looking glass tonight (Things That Are To Be,) and see, "Which way am I headed. Is Jesus preparing a place for me, a body? (See? That's what we read.) I'm in birth pains... (Now, he said,) I'm just a church member. (Now he said if you love the world, that love of God's not in you, that Word and all. I'm just a church member.) I wasn't a germ of God. I am not--He is not my Father."

Now what is he talking about? Life can only come on like life. Life coming can only come on like life. See? Can't come any other way. The life of God cannot come on anything but the life of God. Just like a life of a true male can only come on the life of a true female. In other words, she's got that life there, she's got the seed, he's got the life that it takes to bring spark that, to make it come forth, give it a body, and if you haven't got the original, you're never going to have a glorified body, one like His.

- 38. <u>The Messiah</u>, spoken in Shreveport. This quite some time back, but it's all right. [The Messiah, 01/17/61]
- [32] Did you ever think of this? Let me just ask you something.
- [33] Look at me a minute. This is my hand; that's my finger; this is my ear; this is my nose; who's me? That's not me. That's something belongs to me. See? This is my hand, but who is me who owns the hand? (This is very good.) This is just a house I'm living in. Well, there's got to be something that's called "me." "Me" has got to be somewhere, because this is mine. You see it? "Me" is somebody,

because I own something. I have a hand. It's mine. Well, who's "me" that that belongs to? That's your spirit. (See?) Well, it depends on what kind of a spirit.

Sure. See? What did you come from? Spirit of beast or the Spirit of God? See? What are you animal? Now we're all animal, we're all mammalian. Maybe we'll talk about that too. Bro. Branham did. See?

[33] Who you yield your members to, that's whose servant you are.

Well that's true. What's in you? You are servant to what is in you, in other words, you will act like you, you will want what is you. I'm not talking about sinless perfection, don't ever get that idea, as though like the Nazarenes and some of the Methodists. Now Wesley never believed that junk, I never found one thing Wesley said that agreed with it. It's the people that came out of Wesley, that holiness bunch. And they try to let on that they were perfectly sanctified, they never sinned. And the very fact of the matter is that they would say that, proved they did sin. Because John called them liars. He that says he doesn't sin is a liar. You'd immediately get rid of the fact that Jesus intercesses, you don't need an intercessor. Then that reduces Jesus to only a spirit, no body. You see where you go to? You become completely insane when you start taking away.

- 39. [We Would See Jesus, 02/08/61]
- [70] Do you believe? "Sirs, we would see Jesus." Now, you just have faith.
- [71] Now, here's a man. I've never seen him in my life. He's perhaps a little older than I am. We're strangers to each other; and I don't know you, you don't know me. But if God can tell me something. Now, be real quiet. Don't move around. You're spirits. See, each one of you is a spirit.

Now, is he saying you're spirit and no soul? No, he's telling you that you are more spirit than body. You are soul which is spirit, you are spirit which is spirit, and you are body which is not spirit, but the body would not get there, except there was a spirit that had the power to take certain things and act like a creator to mold forth the progeny. And make sure that you're existing, your mortality keeps on. And you know mortality keeps on till immortality comes? That means there'll be marrying, and giving in marriage, and having children? Boom – it's all over. All... no more left, no more seed.

40. Now, what is seed coming from? Seed comes from sperm, comes from intercourse. What will the homos do it? Everybody's getting AIDS. Can you keep bearing children with AIDS? Day will come when you can't. How long can AIDS take it? Well, four generations maximum. Four generations maximum. What's a generation? Oh about what? Today they're cohabiting and living sexually and bringing forth children, the girl's thirteen years old and them boys fifteen. Fifty-two years we'll say, it's all gone, kaput, before then God should annihilate it. AIDS started what, ten years ago? Longer than that. Started before then, they just put the name to it. Twenty years, twenty to go? Year 2000 coming right up.

You got a man that's – he's backing off a bit, but he still says AIDS men can go in the army – homos, not AIDS, but the homosexuals. So you know what you're going to have? You'll find your best men quit the army, they'll have to. They can't go to rooms where these guys are

looking them up and down. And these feminine guys coming in. I'm not a gay basher. I can tell you one thing, I'm here to tell you that there isn't one of them going to make the ...?... unless they repent and get rid of those filthy things they're doing. I don't care if you join a church and have women join the church and say, "We're women preachers," and this, ...?... I'm like the pope this morning, he condemned the Anglican church. Keep to it, popey old boy, you're wrong, but you're right on that one. Oh God will give him credit for being right where he's right. He'll be judged – he won't have to be judged for that one.

Okay, where are we going down here? Yeah, who is this?

- [71] *I'm the spirit.* (...?... being spirit. Now he said to the man,) *You're here for somebody else.*
- 41. Okay, The Comforter. [10/01/61]
- [47] You do not see me; you see my body. You don't see me. I don't see you, because I only see your body. This is my hand, but who is me...? This is my body, who is me? It's a spirit. (What's he saying? It's life.)
- 42. Okay: [The Messiah, 01/17/61]
- [32] And now, we say in the man, the man... Before we leave that subject... The man, what is he? Got a hand like God, got eyes like God, got ears like God, got a body like God. He was fashioned after God. He was given an earth and a dominion. He was made god over the earth to rule the earth, the lesser god. God rules the universe, everything. But the man was given the earth, to rule the earth. He was a Messiahette. That's what he is tonight if he gets back to God. He is a Messiahette, a little Messiah. "Messiah" means "anointed one," and you're anointed, aren't you? That's exactly right: you're a Messiahette.

In other words, in the image, down the line, you're in the image as to what you can bear from God, not having had that position, but your own position. Every man with his own gift, his own measure of faith, his own everything. All right.

[32] We call it that just for the Word's sake till we get a little further in the Scripture to it.

In other words he said, "You're identified all the way with Him." All right, we have read these things.

- 43. Now, we notice that this was greatly changed as to being more definitive after the Seals. So we have read this and you can see that it's absolutely more definitive. Then now again we say that this proves Gen 2:7, along with Gen 1:26,27. So here we have here, in 1:26,27, a creation and a forming.
  - (26) And God said, (Let's) make man in our (own) image, after our likeness:

(27) So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

And the reason that little part, there's an interpolation where it says:

(26) ... and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea.

Because it "Let us make man," that would be singular, "in our image," and then "let them have dominion," and He created them so.

- 44. Now in Genesis 2, after all the beast of the fields and everything were in order, there was no man to till the ground, so:
  - (7) ...the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.

Or the Holy Ghost Itself made this man through the breath of lives, which is the fact of associating him with the earth and all the animal kingdom, everything that the living God had within Him as Zoe, that you could prove there is a God, absolutely by creation. Man is now a fundamental part with the animal kingdom, and everything else, in order to procreate and to fill the earth. Then God takes from him the woman, because it said there's no helpmeet, there isn't one like him, and there has to be one like him in order to reproduce him.

45. Now listen, what is he like? He has the life of God, making him a true son of God, which God has now brought this man to a place with the woman, whereby they can produce many sons unto God! And many daughters, because that takes procreation. And so therefore the life, that is really what we're looking at, is soul life, which is gene life, which means it's a gene of God! Then if it's a gene of God, it's got chromosomes of God! Now we're speaking spiritually! Which in other words is this: if you are truly a gene, with the chromosomes of God, you will literally produce God in the area, in the way, and the measure is yours to produce what God has demanded of His children! Based upon Himself.

Now remember, you and I, we just pass everything on haphazard. But don't think for one minute that God's haphazard. He's not even – you think how brilliant God is, and as Bro. Branham said, "The virgin birth is nothing compared to a genuine birth like you and me." See? And then he said, "God made it together, your great-great-great-great grandfather, take it all the way back!" Not just one hundred years, but take it back two thousand years, take it back further than that. Take it all the way back. Were you in Adam? Were you a son of God way back there, a gene? See? So that's the life that came on down.

- 46. All right, we are looking at body, soul and spirit. Now this is the definitive! And we know it's the definitive by reason of 1 Th 5:23.
  - (23) And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

So there you are tripartite individual. And it doesn't say you've got two spirits and two souls. If you did I would think you'd have two bodies! But at this point you certainly do not! Because you do have a body waiting for you, but you don't have it in you! You see, the soul life should have produced, and did produce, in the fact of it's eternality and being a part of God, according to 2 Corinthians 5, that Bro. Branham said, "That building eternal." He said, "Eternal means never had a beginning."

47. So all right. You are more complete in God than you ever believed, and this really stretches your mind! You bet it does. But you better take it as it says. Absolutely.

Notice, Christ was just like us. He was a body, it went to the grave. He had a soul, it went to Hades. He had a spirit, it went back to God. But remember, when we're talking about soul, body and spirit, we're also talking about other definitions, you know, other things we can say. And you know what they are? Number one: life. Number two: seed. Under life, we find life is in the blood. Under seed, we find seed is in the loins. That's right. Can't deny it.

But you can't separate them except to say that the seed was in the male, and the life actually carried – the life that was carried in the bloodstream – produced the seed in the proper organs. Naturally, your kidneys have a function, it's got certain cells. Your heart has a function, it's got certain cells. And kidney tissue should not look exactly like heart tissue, as far as I know. Otherwise how can these guys, you know, who make biopsies and so on, and they look for different parts of the body, and they say, "Well now, this came from this part and this from this part." And it's all the same life; it's the life that's in the body, suffusing the body by means of the bloodstream. So all right, there's primary sex organs in both the people! But only the male carries with him the ability to produce that life so it is carried on.

- 48. All right. Now we go to Heb 7:9-10.
  - (9) ...as I may so say, Levi also, who received tithes, payed tithes in Abraham.
  - (10) (When) he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met

All right, where did Abraham get his life? Hopefully, certainly not from the serpent. He got it from Adam. Where did Adam get his life? God breathed into him the Holy Ghost, and he became a living soul. Or as we say, more literally, breathed in the breath of lives, the propagation thereof.

49. Now consider seed. The first mention of seed is concerning the seed of the beast. Now, the seed of the beast is for physical manifestation. So it is life plus! You're talking about a carrier. See, that's why they use the seed for the word 'sperm'. Like Genesis is a seed chapter, which is beginnings. There has to be something that contains the life! For the life has within it all the dimensions spiritually to come forth in the physical! See? Even to the fact you got blue eyes instead of brown eyes and so on.

So the first mention of seed is concerning the seed of the beast for a physical manifestation. Now the beast does not have a soul seed, merely a seed, which indicates the perpetuation of the original life of whatever is in the male by his mate. So the perpetuation is by the mate,

whatever's in the male. And Eve was in the male. That's why God has a bigger calculator than even you thought. Because now what is in your wife to bring forth the right child, God has got to take it on His great big computer infinite mind, and match up with the whole process! That's why Bro. Branham said a virgin birth is just small change alongside of the birth you and I have.

- 50. The second mention of seed is concerning Eve who does not of herself have seed. Now let's go to Genesis and take a look at seed. Because seed is seed! I don't care if wheat seed, bird seed, you mention it, seed's seed. So we're going to talk about that, we're going to read it. Gen 1:11,12.
  - (11) And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, (uh-huh,) the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed is in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.
  - (12) And the earth brought forth grass, and herb yielding seed after his kind, (uh-huh, there you are.)

But it had tree life and bird life, and this life and that life that was coated, which shows that the hen came before the egg. And if she'd have an egg without the male, no more chickens. So there you are. See?

Now remember, the seeds were in the earth. But when it came to the beast, the beasts were not in the earth, except the chemicals, the chemistry you might say, that was there to coat the beast, the spirits, even as we were coated, but you notice, the beast only had spirits, and the Bible said they go downward. Man has a spirit and "the candle of the Lord searching the inward parts of the belly." [Prov 20:27] The spirit goes upward, even goes back to God who gave it, permitted of God, allowed of God, but not of God. Because I can't find one place where the Holy Ghost, if you've got the Holy Ghost, ever leaves your soul. Uh-uh. I don't see anything for that anywhere. Because that's your seal, you're going to get your body back. You, the germ of God, sealed in. Identified.

- 51. Now notice, all of this is for perpetuation of life after its kind. Like pollination, even in the little seeds, little flowers out there. Gen 1:21-22.
  - (21) And God created great whales, and every living creature that moveth, which the waters brought forth abundantly, after their kind, every winged fowl (of) his kind: and God saw it was good.
  - (22) And God blessed them, saying, Be fruitful, and multiply, (let) the waters in the seas, and let (the) fowls multiply in the earth.

See there you are. What is going to do it? Seed.

(24) And God said, Let the earth bring forth the living creature after his kind, (and) cattle, and creeping things, and beast (on) the earth after his kind: it was so.

(25) And God made the beast of the earth after his kind, (notice after his kind, the) cattle after their kind, every (creeping thing after their kind, their kind, their kind, their kind. What kind? The original life. How does it come forth? Through seed. That's why they called it insemination. Germination. See?)

# 52. Okay, Gen 1:26,27.

- (26) ...(Let's) make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and the fowl of the air, and (so on and so on. See? Now they're related to the earth.)
- (27) (And) God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

Then over here again, [Gen] 2:5.

- (5) ...and there was (no) man to till the ground. (So what happened?)
- (7) ...the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, breathed into his nostrils the breath of (lives); man became a living soul.

There you see it right there. Now notice, verse 6 though. It said:

- (6) ...there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground.
- 53. In other words, the spirit man was supposed to control things, and evidently this mist, which would go away later on, man would be responsible, you see, for the earth and his tenure upon earth, by guarding and caring for the earth, because man has destroyed the earth, God's going to destroy him. Now how much more destruction can we take on this earth? That's why Bro. Branham said, "God didn't bring these plagues and things on man in judgment really. What happened in the days of Noah, they brought it on themselves, the atomic bomb."

Now if there's any real truth about the ozone layer, and I suppose there is, I don't know. One says this, and one says that, and phooey, I get tired of all the junk they're saying. Maybe some of you know, because you study it carefully. But listen, the thing is this: if that ozone layer really is going, and the sun really begins to burn the hide off of people, it isn't God's curse upon man's sin, it is man sowing and reaping! And that's a lesson everybody in this church ought to know! It's time to begin to sow in righteousness and begin to reap it! God, I'm a million miles behind at what I should be, and so are you sitting here. Absolutely, it's a rotten situation; we are not aware and awake! See? No. And it's not the big things, it's the little things.

## 54. Okay, Gen 3:20.

(20) And Adam called his wife's name Eve; because she (is) the mother of all living.

In other words, the mother is to produce, or bear, but not procreate of herself. She cannot do it. And the man can't do it either, but she's given him to reproduce himself. And I know right away you say, "Chauvinistic male pig." Listen women, that has nothing to do with you or me, this is a fact of nature, the life is in the man – period! – and she is there to reproduce!

Now, you got these lesbians all coming together, and you got these homos all coming together, and they want to bring up children! Well I'd like to see a male bring forth in another male, or a female with a female; it cannot be done! Now, if you want to mess with it and you want to take the sperm and the egg and fuss around and do certain things, you can do it, but you'll reap all hell and you'll think hell is pleasant to what can break upon this earth. Why? Because that wasn't given into your hands! The sex act was! Which is a righteous act! It's even an act of pleasure if you do the thing right. That's what – oh ...?... don't have to blush about it. Sarah said it, "Shall me and my husband have pleasure again?" What's she talking about? Looking out the window? [Laughter] Oh for Pete's sake. Grow up. If you can't grow up, I got no hope for you. And you don't have any hope for yourself, let's face it.

- 55. Let's go to Psalm 37, we're going to see something which is germane to the subject here, we're keeping with it, don't worry. Ps 37:26-20. But I told you this is going to lead us right back where we were. So don't get your hopes up. But let's begin to see how this thing is diffused and how it moves around, so that all you better do is believe the Word of Almighty God, you're body, soul and spirit, and you can be entirely sanctified to God in the three of them, making you a complete unit unto Almighty God, and has "Sanctify them by Thy Word, Thy Word is truth." Or "By thy truth, and thy Word is truth." John 17. What is it? Oh let's go back to John, so hold your finger there and go to John 17. I know what I'm talking about; sometimes I kind of doubt it. Now:
  - (17) Sanctify them through thy truth: (that's it,) thy word is truth.

Waters of separation found in Ephesians 5, at the presentation of the Bride to Christ, which is God made incarnate.

56. All right, Ps 37:26.

- (26) He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed is blessed.
- (27) Depart from evil, and do good; and dwell for evermore.
- (28) For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.

Right? The seed of the wicked shall be cut off. Where do you go now? Somebody tell me. I'll tell you. 1 John 3, right? You were going to tell me that weren't you? I knew you were, because by now you should certainly know it, or we're going to dismiss you, put you back into kindergarten, if we even let you inside the doors. You'd have to go back to pre-kindergarten, wouldn't you? On that one. Okay, 6th verse:

(6) Whosoever abideth in him sinneth not: whosoever sinneth hath not seen him, neither know(eth) him.

- 57. What is sin? Unbelief. Even going so far as to ascribe the works of the Holy Ghost to the devil. Misunderstanding God's nature entirely, not getting in any type of rhythm, but being just like the serpent.
  - (7) Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. (What is that righteousness? We'll learn about it.)
  - (8) He that commits sin in of the devil; (In other words, does an act of unbelief and calls it good.) for the devil sins from the beginning.

What was the beginning sin? He fell by reason of pride, he wanted to exalt himself above God, when he already had the privilege of worshipping God and leading in the worship. He said, "I'm going to take over!" And that's what the churches have done. A lot of preachers in this Message are no different either. If you don't know that by now, you're still wet behind the ears.

- (9) Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he (issued forth from) God. (Being born is to issue forth! It's not the act of procreation, it's the act of the mature child coming forth. Begetting is a different term.)
- (10) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God...

#### Now it said:

- (7) Little children, let no man decieve you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.
- (10) In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: (the seed of God, the seed of Satan,) whoseover doeth not righteousness is not of God... (go down to verse 12, the rest is interpolation.)
- (12) Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, (or wicked,) and his brother's righteous.

Worshipping contrary to the revealed Word of Almighty God puts you into the position of going to hell, which you will go to, period. And the White Throne is already taken place according to Bro. Branham, the fire is going to fall shortly, which is the same fire at the White Throne one thousand years down the line, but it's now going to fall at the end of the Millennium, before the Millennium, to purify the earth and give us a sanctified place for the time being. Right, a hundred percent right.

59. Also, let's go to back to Psalms. We go to Psalm 1:

- (1) Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, (he's got a lousy rotten preacher, he's got the serpent stand there.) nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. (Pharisees!)
- (2) But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (What is that? Revealed Word. Jesus said, "If you had known Moses, you would have known Me.")
- (3) ...he shall be like (the) tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in season; (All right, what's his fruit now? Seed! And in there lies the life. Bringing forth all these children.) whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
- (4) The ungodly are not so: are like the chaff which the wind drives away. (The fan is in His hand, thoroughly purges forth, gather the wheat in the garner, burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.)
- (5) Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment,

No, they're going to blown away like chaff! We're going to stand, be able to stand! You say, "Ha ha ha, you, you," No, no, no, no, no, hold it, hold it. I didn't do it in the first place. Can't accuse me, I'm a son of God. You birds did it. You and Satan. Yeah, we'll talk about that. Well it tells you in Mt 10:28: "Fear not him that destroys body, but can destroy both body and soul in hell." And the Word of God distinctly says that hell was made for the devil and his angels! They're spirits, not even souls, we'll talk about that. If we do.

- (6) For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous:
- 60. Foreknows! Don't tell me He doesn't. He said they're going to stand! He said the seed will be this; the seed will be that, this is it! You mean to tell me, "Well God just suddenly took the props away, and when He did, and left them to their own, they fell right away, and from that time on nothing is the same, because you see the man has got so far away from God, he's a complete reprobate, and nothing can be done except, except, except..." Except, shut your big fat mouth. Quit trying to put something to it. You'll learn more and more what Bro. Branham said and what he really meant before it's over. You'll find you can't put one thing to it. Jesus himself said in the Word of God, "Can a man add one cubit to his stature by taking thought?" Ha! Try and do it. Bro. Branham even talks about thought control. Making a glass shatter by just looking at it, making a thing move. Associating that with devil power. He woke up with the real one. Oh you'd be surprised what the prophet teaches, if you give yourself a chance.
- 61. Let's go to Romans 9, if that doesn't prove what I'm talking about in Psalm 1, then I'm quoting you wrong. I ain't quoting you wrong. I'm quoting the truth. It says here, look what Israel had:
  - (4) ...(they had) the adoption, (placing of sons, they had) the glory, (they had) the covenants, (they had) the giving of the law, the

- service of God, and the promises; (They were the only ones that had the true assessment of God.)
- (5) Whose are the fathers, as concerning Christ (in the flesh) came, who is over all, God blessed for ever.
- (6) Not as though the word of God (were) taken none effect. For they are not all Israel, which are (called) Israel:
- (7) Neither, because are (they) the seed of Abraham, are they (the) children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called. (That was the type for the prototype. Sealer! See? You got to go plumb back to where you were. You didn't have representation back there, you don't have it now.)
- (8) That is, They which are the children of the flesh, (they) are not the children of God: but the children of the promise are counted for seed.

There you are. The promise is replenish the earth, multiply, take control! That promise is not to Satan and to his crew, it was not made to Cain! Not only was the earth cursed, because of that diabolical act, but when Cain did what he did, he himself was cursed! And the Bible speaks of cursed children! You show me one child of God was cursed. Tempted! Tried! Boiled in oil, maybe! Died a thousand deaths, but comes up in a resurrection, immortal with Christ. Oh yes, standing almost on the right hand, standing with Him. Standing by faith on the right hand, even now. Sitting on the throne by now.

## 62. All right now listen,

(9) For this is the word of promise, At this time will I come, and Sarah shall have a son.

Abraham had a child by Hagar, forget it. That genuine life that was in that seed, that egg that would be in Sarah, that life was not in Hagar. No way, shape and form. He said it had to come by Sarah. And it said,

- (10) ...not only this; but when Rebecca also conceived by one, even our father Isaac;
- (11) (...the children not (being) yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, (In other words the purpose is foreknowlege, election is calling,) not of works, but of him that calleth;)
- (12) It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger.
- (13) (And) it is written, Jacob have I loved, (and) Esau have I hated.

- 63. Now just for one moment, let's pretend it says, "Esau have I loved less." One is wise virgin, one is foolish virgin. Bro. Branham never took it that way. He took it the other way. Evil.
  - (14) What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? God forbid. (Said, "Man, you're just blowing your mouth off.")
  - (15) For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. (Now listen, this is God's talk, God talking.)
  - (16) So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but God that sheweth mercy.
  - (17) For the scripture saith unto Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised thee up, that I might shew my power in thee, that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.
  - (18) Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth.
  - (19) Thou wilt then (say), Why doth he yet find fault? For who hath resisted his will?
  - (20) Nay but, O man, who art (you) that repliest against God? Shall the thing formed say to him that formed it, Why hast thou made me thus? (See? Now let's find why.)
  - (21) Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, another (to) dishonour? (Now here's the purpose.)
  - (22) What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: (Now they fitted themselves. But down here this is different.)
  - (23) That he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory, (Now he prepared these, these prepared themselves. That's why everybody can be judged.)
- 64. Now look at the cut and dry answer that Paul brings back, "Nay but, O man, who are you?" And the only one that ever replied in the beginning now Adam and Eve, they chickened. They made excuses. But when it came to Cain, he outright lied! He didn't make excuses. That's why Jesus said, "Your father was a murderer and a liar in the beginning." The devil never killed anybody. Show me where he did. He has to use a tool, spirits just don't do that. They got to have something to work with. See? Have a body.

Okay, now remember, seed has life in itself. And the life is in the blood. We're talking about life processes, bringing forth this body, and these things which God has commanded. What we are saying is this: the life of the flesh and blood creature, now I've got that in parentheses. The life of what? Flesh and blood creature, produces a seed in order to propagate that very life that's in him. The life in the blood goes into a seed which can separate from the male body, and produce another life with an egg that is available from the combined, and from the combined material produce another like source. Generation to generation.

65. Now remember, when it comes to Jesus, he shall not see his generation. He's cut off, he doesn't see his seed. But what is it? A generation shall be counted to him for a seed, and generation is the born of God in six thousand years, which are seed! Right, that's Scripture. I've preached that here before, you just forgot it. I've taken my concordance, look it up; it's in the Psalms there. I can show you. Get my concordance, which you won't bother right now.

All right. Each child that is born is a seed, and if it is a male it produces seed, as we saw in Heb 7:9-10, Levi in the loins of his grandfather, coming down, down, down. You can't separate seed and life, but all seed life is not the same source as we saw in the Bible, and therefore all seed are not of God, as being part of God! But will be indirectly, on the grounds of creation, and by being created are accountable to God. That's why there's nobody apart from civil law and from God's law.

66. Now, what we saw the other day was in the Book of Matthew 13, and we read it in 36-43. And this of course is the interpretation of the sower that sowed, and the criminals came by at night and sowed a bunch of weeds. When it was declared wheat and tares, they said, "Let's rip them up." He said, "No, you leave it to the harvest." Now:

- (36) Then the multitude, went into the house: his disciples came...

  Declare unto us (in other words, exegesisize or tell us completely and perfectly the meaning) of the tares of the field. (And:)
- (37) He answered and said, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;
- (38) And the field is the world; (and) the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one;
- (39) The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Now this is the exact meaning. Now this is not a parable explaining a parable! You understand what I'm saying? This is two and two make four and three and three make six! And there's no guesswork! Do you follow me? Well you better, because hey, you can't fool around with this. [End of side two of tape one.] Now:

(41) The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kindgom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; (that's His messengers are going to do that.)

- (42) And shall cast them (in) a furnace of fire: (and there'll) be wailing and gnashing of teeth.
- (43) Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

He's telling you this leads to the New Jerusalem. And everyone that's going to be there in the new heavens and the new earth. And he tells you there's two sowings! Now you know a spirit does not have sperm! And the devil cannot create! No way. Neither can he interbreed without a body! But the convenient one there was the beast, who was subtle, who could talk, who could reason, who could argue, who was so close to a human being, beautiful, handsome, magnificent, a giant – certainly off color – and the seed could mingle. That male beast seed could mingle with the female egg. In other words, the life in his sperm could contact the female ovum and bring forth a monster.

- 67. Now notice what it says concerning this in Matthew 3, it's the same thing. John the Baptist is speaking. He's out in the wilderness, and he says,
  - (2) ... Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
  - (3) For this is he that was spoken by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. (In other words, he explain it so he can get his job done.)
  - (4) And John had his (garment) of camel's hair, and leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey. (If they're not full of microbes, they're good to eat.)
  - (5) Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and the region (around) Jordan.
  - (6) (They) were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins. (Sort of repentance, see?)
  - (7) (And) when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come, (oh boy,) he said, O generation of vipers, (oh you serpent seed, yeah,) who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?
  - (8) Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:
  - (9) And think not to say within yourselves...

Now you see, if they thought this, there's no place to repent! There's no place for the Word!

(9) (And don't you dare say...) We have Abraham to our father:

Now that's what they said to Jesus. "We got Abraham." John didn't do one thing for them, except to lead a few to the light, and the rest to condemnation, and that's always been the way of

a prophet! Why? Because Jesus Christ was a prophet, and that's what he did. How many, how many really got to the truth in his day? Hardly anybody. And since then, hardly anybody.

- (9) ...I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. (Now you're looking down to the Gentiles of course.)
- (10) And now also the axe is laid (to) the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth forth (not) good fruit is hewn down, and cast (in) the fire. (What's he talking about? Seed! What they're producing! What's your tree? Your geneolgy? Where you're coming from? Bad seed, good seed.)
- (11) I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: (now watch,) he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and fire: (Now watch.)
- (12) Whose fan is in his hand, thoroughly purge his floor, gather his wheat (in) the garner; burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

68. Now what's he talking about? We get the Holy Ghost at the end time, God Himself comes down with His decision making power, His judgments, 2 Th 1:7-10, and what happens then? Fire! Burns up the chaff.

Now what's he telling you? He's telling you the wheat comes out of a carrier! It's one lump! And there's now literally one sperm, one egg, in the entire human race there's no difference, except that life that comes by that one individual sperm to mate with that actual egg that came down from God by way of Adam, that has that little gene in it from God, that soul. That's your difference right there.

At the end time... listen, I've often said, hey, I came from Canada. I didn't live in Saskatchewan – which is really the wheat bin of the universe. I used to think Alberta was, because I lived there, which I was proven wrong. But when I was a kid, we used to have these thrashing machines. Now you have these combines, so it doesn't mean a thing. As soon as it goes through, the wheat's separated, and the chaff, and the fine, fine dust of the stalk, you know, the stem is on the ground all dry. But back home they had these big old chug-a-lug machines you know, steam driven, and the men come in with huge racks piled high with the sheaves, and they'd chuck them in, and the wheat would go into the bin, and the little bin would be maybe six feet by about six feet, maybe twelve feet by about seven feet, not very high, and you'd see a straw [Bro. Vayle whistles] just mountains. That's it. That's it. Few little wheat in the garner, eight souls in the ark, all the rest are fodder. Bro. Branham said they're cannon fodder, atomic bomb fodder.

69. All right, now. Look it. Said you can't separate seed and life, but all seed life is not the same source, as we saw in the Bible, all seed are not of God, only some, but one lump! Now that really throws people. That makes you heir to every despicable thing under God's high heaven, until you

can be a vindicated prophet like David, you can be a vindicated king like David, you can stand there with every blessing of God upon you, 499 wives, or the full just about five hundred, and look out the window, a beautiful dame, she's undressed, and she's prettier than anything you ever saw, and you get her to commit adultery with you, you get her pregnant, you kill her husband.

"I don't think I like that."

Look in the mirror boy, look in the mirror girl. You ain't so hot. Isn't only Jesus who said, "Look," he said, "let him cast the first stone that has no sin." The Bible also said, "He that's guilty in one point of the law is guilty of all." And the one point of the law is "Thou shalt believe and love Thy God."

You say, "It doesn't say believe in there."

Sure it does, because "You'll have no other gods before me." Yep. Can't believe God and have that in your life kid. No way, you're an unbeliever.

70. Okay. This is what we talking about, we're talking about this. Hebrews 2, and what's it tell us? Verse 11.

(11) For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren.

Through the sanctifying work of the Blood of Christ, and of the Holy Ghost, which is Spirit, we read over here, how he said, "My life will depart from me, from this blood cell. And come back to the life of God, which it came from. And we'll come back." And that's what Jesus said. "I will come back, He will come back, we will come back." Oh yes, that's what he said. And when you get the Holy Ghost, that's your token, you're sealed in forever.

All right, listen. Now: [Hebrews 2:]

- (10) For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. (That's the Head of the Bride, the Head of the redeemed.)
- (11) For both he that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: (one source. Now,) for which cause...

71. Not that they're sanctified now, that's great. But they're of one source! In other words, how can Christ deny us, how can God deny us, how can a man say, "That's not my son, though he's disreputable, he's disgraceful, he's a clod, he's a clump, he's worse than that, can't even call him a beast, he's so rotten." Son's a son. "I'm going to die, cut him out of my will." Ah shut-up. You are just begging the question, acting like an idiot, a son is a son. "I'll disown him." Shut-up again. We'll just take your DNA and RNA and prove that you are a lying, stupid idiot. Same with God; look at the genes, what's there? Where'd they come from? Had to come from God spiritual, or there's no such thing as you and me going to spirit body, already being a Word body, spiritual, sanctified through the Blood, sealed in by the Holy Ghost.

Now, it is simple to see that the two lives, Adam and serpent, could actually mingle by reason of Eve. She brought forth a hybrid life and serpent seed. In Cain we see a serpent seed, a serpent life, but not a true Adamic, or beast body, but so close except for giant size. Why do I say that? Well, Cain was exceptionally close to the human race. Yet actually only fifty percent a human body, and a hundred percent beast life. That has to be the way it is. Because Eve doesn't have life, just got an egg. But she has a material, and it's the same material the beast has, because every beast of the field has those same chemicals in it; they come from the ground too. Every bird, every insect, everything. It's just what the life does with the chemistry.

72. Now, Cain's wife was the daughter of Adam and Eve. Yet with the bodies of Cain's children being only one quarter serpent flesh, they are still serpent life and seed. You understand that? That's true. Now what do you get with inbreeding? Crossbreeding? You get what – let's say to make matters so we don't get into too big a question here concerning certain things, we say let's say for one minute that a... take Bro. Branham. His grandmother was pure Cherokee, right? Okay, the daughter was one-half. William Branham was one-quarter. The children be one-eighth. From that point on there's no Indian left, as far as you think you can trace it and all.

You see, what I'm trying to show you here is that what has happened, taking Mendel's law of genetics, which we can look at, the serpent seed multiplied terribly fast, and when the sons of God saw the daughters of men, and begin joining up with them, the genes were predominant, as they always are dominant from the negative and the stronger breed. That today at this hour, how much do we have that is serpent, and how much do we have that is non-serpent in this one lump of clay? See, as we say here, the Adamic race multiplied as did the serpent race, and finally they intermarried, and with the common lump of clay, the mates, the males, you know, that carried the life, both seed, Adamic and serpent, and where are we at the end time when we're discussing this business of the one lump and the community life that's in that lump, two communities, one heaven, one hell, so to speak, one Kingdom of God, one kingdom of Satan.

## 73. Okay, let's find out. Jude:

- (1) Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:
- (2) Mercy unto you, and peace and love, be multiplied.
- (3) Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once (for all) delivered unto the saints.
- (4) For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old (of) this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. (In other words, they deny actually the understanding of Emmanuel, God with us, God incarnate.)

- (5) I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not.
- (6) And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, he hath reserved (to) everlasting chains under darkness unto judgment of the great day.
- (7) Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, (now you know that's cohabitation in the wrong way,) are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire. (Notice eternal fire?)
- (8) Likewise also these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.
- (9) Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke thee.
- (10) But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.
- (11) Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, (Now notice they mention Cain first, because that's where they come from.) greedily after the error of Balaam (Now that's your religious fellow that's false anointed, where the spirit's on the outside and can make contact. But doesn't get down to the inside of the soul.) for reward, and perished in the gainsayings of Core.

74. That's a seed of Abraham, but not a child. Or he'd be a child of God. He's a religious guy, right there in the ranks. And he's a lot like Balaam, but he hasn't got as much goods on the ball as Balaam had.

- (12) These are spots in your feasts of (love), when they feast with you, feeding themsleves without fear: clouds they are without water, (in other words they take the Lord's Supper, and it doesn't mean a thing,) carried about of winds; (that's you know, the winds of gossip and doctrine,) trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; (that's your lake of fire.)
- (13) Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; (that's all they produce, a bunch of air, bubbles,) wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever. (That's like comets shooting around, big flare, big show.)

- (14) And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints,
- (15) To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them all (of) their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him.
- 75. What does it tell you there? It tells you in the days of Noah, Noah being a prophet, God was on the scene, and by the vindication of God, he condemned the whole generation, condemned the whole world, "I condemn this generation!"

"I indict this generation." See?

- (17) But, beloved, remember the words were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ;
- (18) How that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. (Notice that.)
- (19) These they (be) who separate themselves, sensual, not (having) the Spirit.

What do they do? They stayed with the truth long enough to walk off with cardinal doctrines, as though they knew something, and that's where the Gnostics came from! See? The whole world now believes in a female god, even the cartoon. I don't know if you saw the – I can't remember the cartoon enough; I should have cut it out so you could see it. You know. But they're making it a woman. They're right back to Diana, the god of the Ephesians. Who said she carried the seed. Well you talk about a bunch of nuts.

(20) But (you), beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

What's holy faith? Vindicatedly revealed truth. See? Because they're talking about what the apostle said.

- (20) ...praying in the Holy Ghost,
- (21) Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
- (22) And (on) some have compassion, making a difference:
- (23) And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Now he doesn't say here, "You jump on those guys and condemn them all," though that's what they're falling into, but he said there could be people that have been fooled, which will come away from that later on. So you don't give up the ship.

- (24) Now unto him (that's) able to keep you from falling, and present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy,
- (25) ...the only wise God our Saviour, glory and majesty... power, (and honour.)

Now note in there that verse 19:

(19) These be they who separate themselves, sensual, (that means natural, natural,) not (having) the Spirit.

And again, verse 10:

(10) ...what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in (these) things they corrupt themselves. (See that's the process of reasoning that started with Eve.)

76. Now, let's go further. Hope you're not getting bored and too tired. We'll get you out of here before daybreak, ...?... another day. 2 Peter [2:]

(1) But there were false prophets among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

Now the teacher follows the prophet. It's prophets, wise men, scribes. And under the scribe class are definitely the five-fold ministry. Then from that there's the pew members, so to speak — well there's the deacons can rise, and the elders who are apt to teach, and they know some things — but from then on there are people who just stay with the Word and quote it or write it, and they don't try to explain it, but they all believe it. If they didn't believe it, why have they quote it? See? But they stay with it.

(2) ...many follow their pernicious ways;

That's – it gets to where there's no... See, what's their pernicious ways? The blood is going to cover them! Why doesn't the blood cover them? Because they're off the Word, Jn 3:16,17,18. You can't isolate Jn 3:16, and just say, "Hey, hey, hey." The next thing you say it, "Well you're in sin?"

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"Yes, I'm a sinner."

"Well you believe His blood was shed?"

"Yes, I believe that."

"You say, ...?..."

"Yes."

"Well shake my hand, you're saved."
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Hogwash. That's Billy Graham stuff. That's what they call, proof text salvation. Not good for a hill of beans. See there's no blood! Why?

(2) ...by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of.

Evil speaking is to not bring the correct Word to the correct man. Which was Christ Jesus. Because they're one!

(3) And through covetousness... make merchandise of you:

That's what the Book of Revelations said, the souls of men, they bartered for the souls of men. And right down the line. And let me see... verse 12,

(12) But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, (now that's Romans 9 again.) speak evil of the things that they understand not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption;

Which means they cannot comprehend. They're ignorant. You see? Why? Because they didn't listen to the prophets! See, John came.

77. Now let's go to Luke 1. I've said this many times, but I want to say it again so you're going to get it, and not fool with it. It says here concerning John the Baptist, verse 15,

- (15) ...he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb.
- (16) And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God.
- (17) And he shall go before (the Lord God) in the spirit and power of (Elijah, that's absolutely a prophet,) to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, (even) the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

Now what's he saying there? The word 'disobedient' does not mean there's a command issued and they're disobedient, it means they don't understand. Even those that don't understand the Word, to the truth, given by the One who gave it. And this makes the people ready. John had to be there to explain the Word that was necessary, the light pointing to The Light! And so did William Branham! So did Moses! So did every prophet!

Oh God, they read the books, say, "Well, I don't see a thing of vindication over here in Isaiah, I don't see a thing over here of vindication in Joel, you just..."

Well then why do you read your Bible? You just proved you don't believe it, you're just a sucker for something that God knows, you're just a sucker for the devil. And you talk about him giving you a lousy deal. He's shown you a deal where you don't even have a brain. "Well what makes you think I got this far? I'm a good citizen, I'm this..." I don't care what you are. You're brute beast, at the end time.

78. Hey, it says right there, I told you Mendel's law. You get those traits in there, and you watch how they zoom up. Look it, back in the days of the Pharaoh's and those people, they had – no the Incas – they had hairless dogs and purple dogs. So they started breeding them. They got a hairless dog and they got a purple dog! Right today in America! They just took the genes there, made them predominant.

Now where are the predominant genes? They are right in the serpent seed race, because it says so! Eight souls make the ark! First of all the Word of God separates, and it's separating, it directs the path of the righteous! Because it's a lamp unto the feet. "Thy Word O Lord is a lamp unto my pathway." [Ps 119:105] It's a lamp and a light. You won't go astray. Hide it in your heart. Keeps you from corruption. Bring it down through your mind to your heart, at the end time, transfigures you, which means you absolutely change! You get your glorified bodies.

Remember, the spoken Word of this hour living in you makes you immortal! The Voice of God that raised the dead, "Come hither," or "forth," raises the dead! "They without us cannot be made perfect." [Heb 11:40]

79. All right, brute beasts, unstable souls, and so on. Perish in their own corruption. And notice at the end what it said. These people that stand there, and they act as though they're Christians, like Cain worshipping, the devil worshipping, yet attracting attention to himself, throwing the Word of God on himself, thinking he can interpret it, because that's what Cain did, he wrongly divided. Now, it says here to these people: [2 Peter 2:]

(20) For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, again (are) entangled...

That is not a Christian! That's a serpent seed, natural brute beast. He comes so far, he can baptize in water, he can have what looks like a repentance, but he will not come the way of the Word, because that's what this is all about, wrong teaching! Twisting what the revealed Word of vindicated prophet says! He turns it, the truth into a lie, and it brings forth people, wolves in sheep clothing!

Now understand what I'm talking about! Whole congregations, wonderful people! Now listen, their latter end is worse than the first. Why? Because they think they got reality and it's not! It's the same rotten dirty old devil, sealing them right in. Cinching them, pulling them in where there's no escape. See?

## 80. Now listen,

(21) For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered (to) them.

Now what is the way of righteousness? It's the proper dividing of the Word! Thereby worshipping within that context. Now listen:

(22) But it happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog (not the sheep. The dog! This is not a parable, nor analogy, this is the truth. The beast has) (re)turned to his vomit; the sow (to the wallow).

You say, "But these people are so nice, they got miracles, they got this." Well listen, hey, hey, hey. I hope to God nobody – and the sound of my voice in this church or on any tape that goes out to various parts – that you cannot understand that, and you cannot bank on it, because this is the one Word that divides a majority from a minority. One lump of flesh. But the gene of the soul does not lie in every single one.

Now, so here we are where we were last Sunday. Yeah. Who but Bro. Branham could be definite? And he found out he could not teach it. "For the secret things belong unto the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed unto us belong unto us and our children for a thousand generations that we may do all the commandments of the Lord." [Dt 29:29] See?

- 81. But before we close, we'll not close for awhile, so don't get your hopes up. We're going to go back to Genesis 3, and we'll try to wind this up and show you, that you can just leave it the way it's been treated, until we can find something very definitive Bro. Branham said, and go right back to the Scripture. In Gen 3:1,
  - (1) Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said (to) the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?
- 82. All right, now let's go over here to Ezekiel 28. You know of course what we're going to read. And in verse 12,
  - (12) Son of man, take up (the) lamentation (against) the king of Tyrus, say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD;

Now, you'll notice that Tyrus here is evidently the one that Satan is using, the same as he used the beast, because remember Satan cannot procreate. He cannot make himself what he isn't. He is definitely a spirit being. Now we understand that. Now:

- (12) ... Thus saith the Lord GOD; (this is to Satan.) Thou sealest up the sum, of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.
- (13) Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; (Now the king of Tyrus wasn't there. The guy behind him, that's impersonating him, and Satan impersonating himself in that man.) every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius... (Now notice how close this is to the ephod that the high priest had upon his breast. All these emeralds, and these beautiful things there.) the carbuncle, and gold: (and) workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

So what does this guy do? This guy that led in the worship, this Satan in whom was perfect till iniquity was found, he goes right to the Garden of Eden and plays high priest! Yeah! Comes right between Eve, representing the church, and God! To deliver the word. There it is right there. [Points to the picture of the Pillar of Fire] Representing the truth as the stones flash. You see? The urim and thummin.

- (14) Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; (One of the truly great archangels, right up there with Michael, in whom Christ was at that time.) I have set thee so: thou was upon the holy mountain of God; (he sure was,) thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.
- (15) Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day thou was created, till iniquity was found in thee.
- 83. In other words, he knew to do better and didn't do it, he did his own thing. So if you know to do better and don't do it, and you do evil, iniquity's the same thing. You do wrong, instead of doing right. When you know to do right, you won't do it. Now Eve knew better. See, that was the whole trouble. And Adam knew better.
  - (16) By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence...

Now that was Tyre, you see, that was happening in that great city under that king there. And now he said.

- (16) ...I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. (Always an association. And Tyre went down.)
- (17) Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, (and) thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: (and) I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.
- (18) Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquites, by the iniquity of thy traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, (and) it shall devour thee, (Notice the fire from the midst? Shows you right here Satan is literally destroying himself, like Bro. Branham said, the world destroying itself.) and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. (Malachi 4.)
- (19) (And) they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: (and) thou shalt be a terror, and never shalt thou be any more. (In other words, in the closing day, Satan has his last big fling, and he's taken care of there.)

Okay, there is the beast in the Garden of Eden, and the beast is literally Satan. And he takes over an animal, because he cannot take over a human being, of which there's only two. So he insinuates himself as the high priest, the mouthpiece for Almighty God, and he's going to interpret the Word.

84. Okay, now, we go to Revelation 19. Now look, the Book of Revelation is plumb full of the word 'beast'. I am not going to fool with it. I mean, I'm not going to take Scripture after Scripture... if you want to read the Book of Revelation 13, which you know, it tells you all about the beast, and chapter 14, I think it is, and right down the line, but I like this one here, because this does us the most good. Beginning at 19, and this is when the Bride comes back with Jesus, upon the white horses, in flames of fire taking vengeance upon the earth at that time.

- (19) And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered to make war (upon) him that sat (upon) the horse, and his army. (That's Jesus and His Bride, God incarnate.)
- (20) And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he (had) deceived them that received the mark of the beast, (you see what I'm talking about? A false prophet with lying signs and wonders and he changes the whole Word of God, and becomes a high priest to the people.) and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into (the) lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- (21) And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth: (That's the Word of God, and there you are.)

85. So what are we looking at? We are looking at the fact that Satan led in worship! But he rose to the place where he said, "I'll make myself God, in fact, I will receive worship," and he tried to get Christ to sell out in the 4th chapter in the Book of Matthew! Christ does not sell out! But when the Bride is gone, the church sells out! See? All right, they turn to worship.

So what we're looking at is Alpha and Omega! The beast in Genesis, the beast in Revelation. And remember, he comes right before [Rev] 22:10, which is the Tree of Life. And he is right there when the Son of man ministry appears. In 2 Thessalonians 2, the son of perdition is there, because there's twins. You cannot have Lk 17:30 without 2 Thessalonians, because one is the Son of man, one is the son of perdition. And the son of perdition is absolutely the ilk of – what's this guy? – Balaam, and Korah, and those other men. They're all hinging their lives upon the ministries.

86. Now, but there's something in-between we can look at, between Alpha and Omega. And between Alpha and Omega, there's the Book of Daniel. In the Book of Daniel the 4th chapter, as I have it written down here, [verses] 13-16.

- (13) I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven; (Now that's Nebuchadnezzar, dream.)
- (14) He cried aloud, and said, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches, shake off his leaves, scatter his fruit: let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches:
- (15) Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; let it be wet with dew of heaven, and let his portion be with the beasts in the grass of the earth:
- (16) Let his heart be changed from (a) man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him.

87. Notice how perfect. Here is the man that's the head of gold. Here's the king of Babylon, Nebuchadnezzar, that God looks down upon as the cap, the peak of the pyramid, for all the rest of the ages of this earth, until the stone made without hands comes down and kills every single bit of it.

Now this king Nebuchadnezzar is the four-runner of all the four kingdoms! Even Rome, which does not get exterminated, because notice it's cut down to where it's a stub in the ground! The wound of the beast, but didn't die. It revived under the Holy Roman Empire! And notice that this head was given the heart of a beast! Now where's the beast? It's in Rome. Where are you going to get the beast again? It's going to be the headship of the Gentile church. While the Gentile church is capped with the Holy Spirit, as it is now, the church of the world is capped with the devil's spirit, as it is now, waiting only for the incarnation! Everything is in order!

88. Notice, when Mr. Reagan, (bless his bones, if a blessing is in order, or whatever,) where did he go to get rid of Communism? Knew he could have done it himself, but he went to Rome. Now Rome may not have the armies at this time to say, "Shut-up and sit down or I'll kill you!" But all he's got to do is talk, and he influence the nations that will listen. He certainly blessed Desert Storm – what was it? – a hundred and nineteen nations represented? No, that's the Catholic church, got a hundred and nineteen ambassadors everywhere, I think ninety-nine nations were there, represented. Around that line. So he was well represented.

Now the little question comes in. The pope says, "And I don't think what's going on in Yugoslavia is right, I think I should condemn genocide." What does he do about? Does he get with the patriarch of the Greek Catholics and tell those Serbs, "Look, we know the Muslims came in here. And we know they took your land. And we understand that you want to get your land back."

So they stand by, yet today, and let those Muslims, the rest of them, they're being decimated, and it's strictly a chapter of genocide, the world knows it, but they wouldn't talk about it for a long time. Remember I told you, I suspected it had to be genocide, based upon religion. It absolutely is, as far as I can see, because right now the big prelates and the big dignitaries of the

church, they say, "Look, this is our land. These are our cathedrals. You came here and messed up. Out."

89. I wonder how come the world isn't so frenzied about helping the Jews? How come America stepped in and say, "Now you stop the killing of those people, you've gone far enough." Was it six day war, seven day war, who knows, who cares, what is it? Six or seven. Who knows? Six? Six. Okay, six is the number of man. Should have had seven, had number of God. So therefore America said, and I just found this out recently, America said, "Ha, you stop it."

Now I'm not angry that America stopped the killing of the Arabs. I'm just asking the question. Why? Was it since America became a Catholic nation, had a Catholic president, and the Catholics hate the Jews? Come on, let's be honest. And the Protestants do too. Seed of the mother, same thing. ...?... children of the children, the daughters.

So what we're looking at, all ready today the spirit of the antichrist is extant and he's doing everything he can until the incarnation. And what he's doing now will build to his incarnation.

- 90. All right, let's go to then the 4th chapter, 28-33. [Daniel]
  - (28) (At the same time) this came upon the king Nebuchadnezzar.
  - (29) At the end of twelve months he walked in the palace of the kingdom of Babylon.
  - (30) (And) the king (spoke), and said, Is not this great Babylon, (have) I (not) built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour (and) majesty? (And doesn't the church say, "I am no widow, I've got it made"? Isn't she Nicolaitin?)
  - (31) While the word was in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven, saying, O king Nebuchadnezzer, to thee is spoken; The kingdom is departed from thee.
  - (32) And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field: (and) they shall make thee to eat grass as (an) oxen, and seven times shall pass over thee, (there it is again,) thou (shall) know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will. (That's at the end of the seven.)
  - (33) (And) the same hour the thing (was) fulfilled upon
    Nebuchadnezzar: driven from men, did eat grass as oxen, his body
    was wet with the dew of heaven, his hair (grew out) like eagles'
    feathers, his nails like birds' claws.
  - (34) And at the end (time, he) lifted up (his) eyes, (his) understanding returned

What I'm trying to show you there, is this same thing happens at the very end. There will not be an accredited, a claim of Almighty God, until He comes with the Bride, and sets them right down there at the lake of fire, and at that time, every tongue shall confess and every knee shall bow. And every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father. They won't do it right today, brother/sister, can't do it.

91. So, you can see what we're at here, the head of the Babylonian Empire that became the Roman Empire, and today is the Holy Roman Empire, through seven church ages, what we're seeing.

Now again, I say, according to Mendel's law of genetics, the dominant taints we believe that the predominant taints of the race today are purely animal in the sense of the original serpent, and likewise in control of Satan, subtle, wise, absolutely unrighteous, absolutely wicked, senseless in their killings like Cain...

- 92. What about that young boy in Dayton? Twenty years old, now they want to say there's something wrong with him mentally. I would suggest there's more than something wrong mentally. He's in this beauty parlor where this Hispanic lady, I think she is, is getting a little treatment from the beautician. He grabs her purse, she doesn't even know it, looks in her car, takes out money, gets the cab to her home to rob it. Then when he gets through robbing it, he even gives some kid that's awake there a glass of water. Takes out the TV, other things. Then he said, "My fingerprints in the kitchen," he said, "I'll burn the place down." Four or five kids sleeping. He said, "Well I thought they'd smell the smoke." Here's this murderer, twenty years of age. Now they're going to try to get him off, sure, and two other kids.
- 93. What is going on today? They're screaming about education. The very place of education in the schools today, is teaching them every diabolical thing to confirm the fact they are children of hell! And the church started the whole thing by not preaching the truth. You wonder why I can't stand preachers and teachers? I've one of each. I taught, and I quit teaching for one reason: the parents left it upon me to not only be the teacher, to be the preacher, to be the spiritual advisor, the physical advisor, the mental advisor, while they sat back and pick their nose and commit adultery. I tell you, they'd go to hell, and they are going to hell, before I ever went back teaching. Person literally wasting his time.

Oh there's room for good teachers, yeah, I've no doubt at all. Where are you going to find them? How long can they take the guff? How long can they stand up against the principals? And I mean the men and I mean the tenets. How can they do it? The only thing you can do is teach rottenness and filth. They're trying to stop the spread of AIDS, and they're doing everything they can to promote it. What they're doing, they're taking... with the criminals, whose intent is to kill, they're taking the sword out of the left hand and giving him tommy gun in the right hand. That's what they're doing. Natural brute beasts! Thoroughly controlled by instinct! That's why every parent must teach its children, male and female, that the body is instinctual, but you must be very careful where your instincts go, keep them under control, because natural brute beasts.

94. Well that's a little bit of time... [End of side one of tape two.] ...part of a beast, that's what's here today. So with all serpent seed. To talk about soul or souls, I cannot. Because souls also mean individuals, as in Gal 6:5, "Every soul must bear his own burden." Eight souls were saved

in the ark. Also Peter mentions the world of the ungodly and the godly, there's two different worlds.

So let it just be, let us just relinquish the subject, let go of it, with this thought: it is sower and the seed. That's what you're looking at. Soul, spirit, this, that, resolve it in one thing: seed. Two plants. One lump of flesh. Takes God to know which is which. And you only know you're a child of God, and you've got a true soul.

Now since we know that everybody's categorized under soul, and "the soul that sinneth, it shall die," [Ez 18:4] and that could mean just separation, or it could mean the second death; it does speak of the second death, we know that. Souls are mentioned there. Souls in the lake of fire, burnt up. God can't destroy a part of Himself.

95. So, could we say that this man has the hybrid soul? Was it a soul that God created? Let me say this one thing, all I know is that two life streams came together and produced this particular creature who did not have a soul from Almighty God. And if he's been given a soul of God, let's put it this way, distinctly, it certainly is a hybrid soul, because animals don't have souls. This one's got a soul, what is it? I just say forget it. And remember one thing, the truth lies in seed. You go to your Old Testament, it's full of the Word 'soul'; go to your New, it's not there. You go to your Old Testament, it's full of the word 'seed', there's a whole page, I don't know how many hundreds of quotes on it. Souls, and right up and down the line you'll see it. But when it comes to the New Testament, you go to Galatians, and it strictly tells you one thing, either you're the seed of God or you are not. And if you're that remnant, I mean you're that bolt of cloth, "As in Adam all died, in Christ all made alive," and you are that set pattern, you will be the firstborn, identified with Christ, you were positively in Him for the first resurrection, and you will believe the Word of the hour! Yeah.

And that's all you will go by, and every bit of your worship is dependent upon an absolute hundred percent correct revelation of division of the Word of Almighty God, because that's where Cain got a hundred percent off-beat, he took the Word back to God, said, "Look, it says right in here, I can offer this kind of offering."

He said, "You have rightly offered, but incorrectly divided, therefore has thou not sinned?" What is sin? An absolute unbelief in the true revelation of Almighty God. Just won't believe.

96. So understand this morning, what am I? I'm either the seed of God, or I'm not the seed of God. That's my understanding, what I look at. Matthew 15. You thought you were finished, didn't you? It's all right, I'm finished... I said this before, but I really mean it, that I had to preach this today, or I wouldn't even be here. That's why no tapes went out last week, they'll go out this week, to try to get the people to understand a little more where I'm coming from, I cannot answer the question definitively, let people try it, that's their business. Mt 15:7.

- (7) Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,
- (8) This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, honoureth me with their lips; their heart...

Doesn't say soul, doesn't say mind, it says heart. What's the antichrist got at the end time? Heart of the beast. What did Jesus call these birds right here in John 8? Serpent seed.

- (8) ... their hearts far from me.
- (9) But in vain do (they) worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

But hold it, based upon original Word. Why? Because Satan didn't say there's no God. He didn't say this. He said, "Yea, has He said it? Just a minute now. I know He said it, but I'll tell you the real truth, I'm the high priest, I'll give it to you." He gave it to them all right. Gave them death.

- (10) ...he called the multitude, and said, Hear, and understand:
- (11) Not that which goeth into the mouth defiles a man; but that which comes out of the mouth, this defiles a man.

What's he talking about? These religious people that are worshipping! Praying and worshipping, you defile yourself! That's the Book of Proverbs tell you, "A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his lips, and with the increase thereof."

97. You speak your words, from your heart, comes out, in your ears, down again, comes out larger, like the fish story. Man said, "Man I caught a" – he caught an eight inch trout. When he told his friends after he ate the trout, "Man," he said, "what a day, what a day!" He said, "I got a trout," he said, "it was fourteen inches long." Well he just got six inches on top of it. The next day, it sounded so good, he said, "Hey man, I want to tell you," he said, "got a trout eighteen inches long." What happened? He told it! It sounded great! Came down, it was bigger the next time! Finally had a two-foot trout. Now hold it, that's not quite – he had to be fishing in a lake to get a lake trout, right? I don't think you can get two – the Dolly Varden's out there, they're not two-feet are those ...?..., no they're not two feet. I never saw one anyway. I've seen some good size, but never two feet. Never big... But you see, the guy, he'll lie.

Now these people are religious people, understand, please interpret your Bible from the viewpoint, and the viewpoint are serpent seed worshippers, a mixed multitude! And what's he hitting them on? He's hitting them on worship! Right? Come on. Relationship to God. I don't mean to yell at you, but you see, hey look, that's my nature. Maybe I'll start taking some pills to quiet me down, Prozac, Anzac. What's Anzac? That's Australian? Hmm, hmm, I just kidding. That's where I'll go and settle down or something.

## 98. Now:

- (12) Then his disciples, (came)... Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard (these) sayings? (Oh my, hmm, hmm.)
- (13) (And) he answered and said, Every plant, which my heavenly Father hath not planted, shall be rooted up.

How? The revealed judging Word! The Judge doesn't stand there exercising some great power! He exercises the Word! Right? Right. Yeah, you getting somewhere this morning? So it's worth you sitting here in this hot place, perspiring. Think at all the work I'm doing.

- (14) Let them alone: they be blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind lead the blind, (they) both fall (in a) ditch. (What does that tell you? He that diggeth a ditch will fall into it.)
- (15) (And) Peter said, Declare us this parable.

Oh he said, "Oh Lord, Peter. Haven't you known me this long and don't you know the crowd? Don't you know what I'm all about, what John the Baptist said, what I'm saying? Can't you ever get to the place where you understand, this is not a parable, this is the truth!" We are not talking about seed of God and serpent seed as examples, we are talking about reality! The judgments of God are sure! Not as though you can fool with them. Oh I think we're getting along very well.

- 99. Let's go to John 8. We're going to see the same thing again. Just bear with me, we're going to get there, don't worry. I'm getting as bad as I used to be, and getting weaker all the time, and stronger all the time. Ho, ho, ho, what a little contradiction in sayings. But not spiritual. Jn 8:37.
  - (37) I know (you're) Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you.

Okay, then whatever soul this serpent seed has, there is one thing unique, it has no place for the Word. Nope, no place for the Word. Just ain't going to fit. Then what is the uniqueness about the seed of God's soul? A place for the Word. Now it all lines up, doesn't it? You say, "What if the serpent hasn't got a soul?" We just take for granted, he's got a life, there's no place for it. Because you see, you and I deal with soul life. The beast deals with spirit life.

Now let you understand this completely, it is not said any place in Scripture I know, or any hint by any author, or by Bro. Branham, that Satan has a soul. He is spirit. And remember this: hell was made for the devil and his angels, and they're all spirit. But it says right here, your soul and body in the lake of fire. And that body is a resurrected body, but not like ours, because every seed has its own body. It has a body commensurate to the lake of fire for the suffering which will be there. That's what Bro. Branham taught us; we know it to be the truth.

- 100. (38) I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father. (Oh man they got mad.)
  - (39) They answered and said, Abraham is our father. ("We know how he was and what he did." And) Jesus (said), If ye were Abraham's children, (you'd) do the works of Abraham. (Evidently you're not doing them.)
  - (40) (For) now ye seek to kill me, a man that told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.

He's bringing them right to the supernatural! "I'm vindicated! Don't you understand that I'm speaking as God to you people, because I'm vindicated by God?"

Oh no, they won't believe that, no, no, the devil does these things, you know. Do you realize that these Jews believed that? And if they didn't, they said it anyway? Come on, they believed it, don't worry, and they said it. See?

"You seek to kill me. I told you the truth." Abraham didn't do that. Now Sarah lied, but then she got over it in a hurry.

(41) Ye do the deeds of your father. (That's Cain. They) said to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God.

See, because they could trace their genealogy back there, all the way to Abraham was a sure cinch they were all the way back to God. Because Adam was a son of God. Says right in the genealogy Book of Luke, you can't change it, that's what it is. No, they sure misread that one. One lump, see?

(42) Jesus said, If God were your Father, (you'd) love me:

Isn't that what John said in...? Huh? Sure. He said, "You wouldn't try to kill me, you'd love me." Why? Because Word responds to Word.

101. When you heard this Message, didn't you love it? Man, it set me free. I was looking for something all my life, something that fit in between the cracks, everything had a crack. And I said, "I like this over here, I like this over here, and I like this here. I think the Baptists have a good point, even Seventh Day Adventists have a pretty good point, although I don't know really too much about it, but there's some little tiny thing in there, tiny, tiny thing, sure wasn't what they build the whole thing on, Jehovah Witness have a little bit over here, Presbyterians, and even Pentecostals." And I'd say, "Now just a minute." And I suddenly woke up, if I were to preach what I call a community doctrine, that should really suit everybody for its sheer exhilarating power of impressive wisdom and knowledge from God, the manifested voice behind it, all of these things, and even without that, just take what he taught, I'd say, "I'm going to tell you something. If I had to go to church and preach, I would take what Bro. Branham said, because it just seems to fill in all the cracks. This is what I'm looking for."

Now sometimes it's hard to see those cracks filled in. But I'm satisfied with it, I like it, this is what I like. If I didn't like it, I'd be someplace else. Now sometimes I don't like some of the treatment I get, you know, which is all part of the training. And old Cain, he got mad, because he was rebuked about how his worship got. I would not be rebuked, I'm very happy to know I can worship right. And I don't have to go to the books, some Pentecostal ...?..., and so you got to run around the house three times, you got to scream four or five times, turn a hand summersault, and everything else. You know I don't have to do that. No.

102.So he said,

(42) ... If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me.

- (Now there that's 1 John 3 again, the two seeds! You understand? Absolutely.)
- (43) Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word. (There was no way. Now if there's no place in there, and you can't understand it, no way. Now watch:)
- (44) Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father (you'll) do.

Now, what was the lust of the father? To take preeminence at any cost. Satan did it, Cain did it, every church that's of Satan does it. That's why you're going to have a slaughter at the end time, like you never believed possible. There will not be one foolish virgin left, as I understand it, some of us may not get out of here in the Rapture, we could even be destroyed. Let's face it, more and more pressure coming down. And anybody that dares to voice a conscience and even be sympathetic, they just get him. Why? Because they cannot stand being come against.

103.Now, if Mr. Luther had of just said to the old pope back there, whoever he was, the old pope John, whatever, old Leo. Yeah Leo, back there. He said, "I'm going to tell you sir, I've come to the place that I appreciate the freedom you gave me to study, I appreciate what I've had as a man, but I want to leave the ministry. I feel I want to get married, I feel I want to be away from the church, as it's understood today, and I feel I'd like to say some things privately, but I'm going to leave you alone." There'd have been no trouble. But he stood up, and was counted. And he came right against Rome, and that meant death. And when you come against Satan, that means death, because that's exactly what the lie is, it is death, and Satan is the angel of death, if there ever was one. Now I know there's another angel of death, but this is the guy that brings it.

Now he said,

(44) ...He was a murderer from the beginning, (Satan never murdered anybody, it was Cain that did it.) and abode not in the truth, (neither Satan nor his son Cain,) because there is no truth in him. (Now see there you are, if the Word wasn't there in the beginning, a representation, you'll never get it now. Okay?) When he speaketh a lie, he speak(s) of his own: for he is a liar, and the father.

And what did Bro. Branham say a lie was? The truth misrepresented. Satan does not have a word, he must pervert and all the things that God said. And there you are.

104. Now we are going to close. Okay? You happy? So it's okay if you're not happy. I'm happy. I'll be happy for you. Okay, listen, Malachi 4:

(1) For, behold, the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, all that do wickedly,

Now who are the wicked? Those who worship apart from the revealed Word of God, which takes in about literally ninety-nine percent of the entire human population. Because even as one man said, "There are no atheists in fox holes." And there'll soon be no atheists, period.

- (1) ...(they) that do wickedly, shall be stubble: (what's stubble? What's left over. What was once a growth! Not anymore, it's gone.) (For) the day cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, (leaving) neither root nor branch.
- (2) But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and (you'll) go forth, and grow up as calves of the stalls.
- (3) And shall tread down the wicked; (they'll) be ashes under the soles of your feet (now what's the ashes? The chaff and the stubble.) in the day that I shall do this, saith the LORD of hosts.
- (4) Remember the law of Moses my servant, (when) I commanded him in Horeb...

That's the Bible the second time given. The Word second time given, and today, Paul's Message, the One that brought it to Paul is here revealing it.

(5) Behold, I will send Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

What great and dreadful day of the Lord? When the fires going to fall right here and the judgment burning them up, us glorified, we glorified.

- (5) ...before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:
- (6) And (this Elijah, that was John, turned) the hearts of the fathers to the children, (our Elijah,) the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. (Who are our fathers? Goes right back to Paul, who went right back to all the prophets, who went right back to God.)

105.So there we are brother/sister, don't worry about the soul, try to make a big difference, whether it's male or female, this or that and the other thing. Leave that to the fellows that are bigger than Bro. Branham. Evidently he couldn't do it. Evidently he could do it if he went to God, what was the use? He ended up by one – what did he end up with? Seed. Seed, seed, seed. Right? That's all you have to think about.

You say, "Well, Bro. Vayle, I'm a sister in the Lord." You're a seed. "Well hey, I'm a brother..." You're a seed. Take your pick. Weed, seed; they rhyme, don't they? That's one couplet I don't want anything to have, I would sooner have seed, seed, seed. And remember the first part of 'seed' is s-e-e. The seed sees what the weed never sees. And they walk in the light as He is in the light, and they have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ constantly cleansing.

Let's rise and be dismissed. You've been a good, lovely bunch of people, I appreciate you, love you, and feel sorry for you, but I can't feel that sorry, because I had to do a job, I hope I've done it.

Heavenly Father, we come to You now, after a long dissertation, just looking at these things Lord, who are the children of God, what is it all about? And we're right back to what we always thought Bro. Branham and knew him to have taught, the seed chapter of Genesis ends in the harvest chapter of the New Jerusalem, there He is, the Father, and the only begotten Son, the Lamb. One in the Pillar of Fire above the throne, and the Lamb on the throne, and the Bride all around the throne, the light going around the universe, no need of sun and moon and all those things, Tree of Life in the midst, and those others outside bringing their glory in.

And we see these are the seed, these are the children. Whatever else anybody didn't have, that's nothing to do with us. Even as Jesus talking one day said concerning John, "What if this man should," you know, "live until I come?" Didn't say he was going to. People got fussing, he said, "What's it to you?"

What's it to any of us what's out there? What's to us is what's in the Word, what we're feeding on, what You brought is vindication, whether we're seed or not. And Lord, we know today, when it boils right down, we've only got one evidence, and that's believing the Word. Everything else is shattered, everything else is gone, everything else Lord that You breathed upon as a mighty rushing wind this day, is been chaff, yep, dry stalk, fit for the burning, can't stand in the judgment, but already Lord the tree's planted by the water, especially Ezekiel's river, we believe that, judgment has come, and we're still standing. And one day, by Your grace, we'll all be gone to the earth, from this congregation, and come back in the resurrection, or some will be standing here, others gone, waiting for the resurrection, and then be changed, standing, still standing, trees planted by the River of Life. Trees planted by God, by the River of Life. No interlopers, no hybrids, just pure children of God, with the body commensurate and a life that looks further and further.

So unto Thee we offer our praise and our gratitude, that we do worship You in spirit and in truth, and we are those who are doing it, and Lord we are the blameless sons of God, the Bride, that didn't do it in the first place, not because we say so, it be because You say so, and our faith lies in that vindication only You could do. Even as we might say in this hour of many gods and many concepts, let God be God. And we've seen the One Who is God, manifested. Help us in our infirmity and our wandering minds, and these things that would entice us and try to enchant us, to leave them alone, it's not necessary. Who and what we are in You we've seen today, we might rely upon it, and go forward in peace, pressing the ...?... living godly in Christ Jesus, knowing that we are that seed, by faith we are that seed.

Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God be all power, honor and glory through Jesus Christ our blessed Savior. Amen.

'Take the Name of Jesus with you.'
