Your Hometown Church Faithful to Tradition Loving in Fellowship Reaching for Tomorrow

Lately I have been encountering a lot of individuals who self-identify as spiritual, or even as Christians, with no discernable connection to any Christian church. Now when someone tells me they are a Christian, or that they believe in Jesus Christ, I take them at their word; but I can't help but feel saddened by what I know is missing from their lives. That is, the fellowship of Christ's church. I truly believe that one of the most important ways we experience and encounter Christ is through relationships with Christ's people, and that is harder to do outside of the church context. Here are just a few reasons why I believe it is important for people to gather as the church:

The church provides us with opportunities to encourage one another in life. We need reminded and encouraged from time to time to continue to love one another and help one another. (See Hebrews 10:24-25) A few years ago I asked my wife to remind me when I get angry at someone, that they are a "beloved child of God". It doesn't happen often, but occasionally when I car cuts me off or is driving erratically I may become upset, but that gentle remind that they are a "beloved child of God" encourages me to change my attitude, offer prayer for the individual, and breath in the peace of Christ as I calm down. The church helps us encourage one another!

The church provides the space and the means to worship God with other believers. (see Luke 4:8, psalm 95:6-7) Praising God is one of the chief purposes of humankind and doing it together invites the presence of God. (see Matthew 18:20) By coming together as the church of God we find that our worship is enhanced by our shared focus and devotion. We learn from each other and are challenged by each other to worship and learn.

The church teaches us more about ourselves and God. We learn through the sharing of scripture, through preaching, through Sunday school class, through bible studies, and through interactions with each other. One of the beautiful things about the gathered church is that we are not all the same. We have different views and experiences that when

shared cast insight into how we understand ourselves and how we understand our God. (see Colossians 3:16-17, Matthew 28:20)

There are many other reasons I believe gathering as the church of God is important, but I believe I have shared enough to convince you that church is both important and scripturally called for. In fact, if you are taking the time to read this newsletter article you are probably already connected to the church in some way, so you may be wondering why I would go to such lengths to convince you of something you probably already know. The reason is that almost all of us know someone who is not connected to a church community and I believe it is part of our responsibility as the church to help connect them to a worshipping community. (whether it is Mars UP or another church!) What's more interesting is that studies consistently find that people who are not part of a church community are willing and often interested to have conversations with churched folks about their faith. My dad always used to say that the best time to plant a tree was twenty-five years ago, and that the next best option was today. Today we should start planting the seeds of faith and the vitality of the community of faith in our family members lives, in our neighbor's lives, in our friend's lives, in their children's lives and so forth. (see Matthew 28:19)

Being the church matters. It matters to the community we live in. It matters to families and individuals who are lifted up by it. It matters to those who are looking for that Spirit filled fellowship or for the peace that surpasses our understanding. And friends, we are the church. The church is not the brick and mortar of the building in which we gather, it is you and me and everyone else who chooses to gather as one; to be encouraged, to learn, to worship, to praise God, and to truly be the body of Christ. Don't wait to plant more seeds or invite a friend back to the church, plant seeds today so that the church will grow tomorrow.

MY School Preschool awesome updates

















