Nominations will be accepted at our regular meetings on January 11, February 8, and March 14, 2016. The current officers and directors of the Board have agreed to extend their terms until the results of the upcoming election on March 14, 2016 are announced.

NRA BASIC HANDGUN SAFETY COURSE

This NRA Certified Basic Handgun Safety Course is an 8 hour training course (4 hours classroom lecture plus 4 hours range time). The course will cover and emphasize the safe and proper handling of firearms, i.e., field stripping, cleaning assembly and shooting fundamentals.

Participants will learn firearms safety, firearms parts, firearms functioning, shooting fundamentals, cleaning and storage, etc.

Participants will need to supply 200-250 rounds of ammunition (NO MAGNUM rate cartridges and for safety reasons NO RELOADED ammunition will be permitted), a firearm (revolver or semi auto pistol is OK), eye and ear protection.

Participants at the conclusion of the class will receive an NRA Certificate of Completion.

A maximum of 10 participants per class can be enrolled.

The cost of the NRA Basic Handgun Safety Course is \$120.00.

The Basic NRA Handgun Safety Course will be scheduled in a one 8 hour block on Saturdays. The training session will be from 8:00 am to approximately 4:30 pm. Please check the Rod & Gun Club activities calendar for the NRA Basic Handgun Safety Course.

BASIC HANDGUN MARKSMANSHIP

This Basic Handgun Marksmanship is a 4 hour training course (1 hour lecture and 3 hours range time). This course will cover firearms safety, safe firearms handling, proper stance, grip, sight alignment and trigger follow through.

Participants will learn the proper shooting techniques by combining all of the above listed skills for accurate shooting.

Participants will need to supply 250 rounds of ammunition, a firearm (revolver or semi auto pistol is OK. PDW, LLC strongly recommends that either 22LR, 9MM or 38 Special chambered handguns be used, NO MAGMUM rated cartridges and for safety reasons, NO RELOADED ammunition will be permitted), eye and ear protection.

If interested the participant does not have a firearm, the participant may rent a firearm from PDW, LLC. PDW, LLC rents the Ruger MK III 22/45 22LR semi auto pistol for \$15.00 for each training session. PDW, LLC can also provide the 22LR ammunition at \$9.50 per 100 rounds.

A maximum of 10 participants per class can be enrolled.

The cost for this 4 hour basic handgun marksmanship course is \$120.00, if class enrollment is 4 or less participants.

If class enrollment is 5 or more students, the cost per participant is \$95.00.

The basic handgun marksmanship course sessions will be scheduled in two four hour blocks on Sundays. Session #1 will be 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. Session #2 will be from 12:30 pm to 4:30 pm. Please check the Rod & Gun Club activities calendar for the Basic Handgun Marksmanship course.

INTRODUCTION TO ACTION PISTOL CLASS

This activity is in a safe and non competitive environment with a priority on giving participants a 'hands on' introduction to some pistol skills that should never stop building and improving on.

Class overview: The purpose of the class is to give participants an introduction to basic knowledge and skills necessary to take a next step beyond the static range experience. To either participate in some type of action pistol competition and/or to just experience weapon handling in a more dynamic environment. The class starts with a short general discussion on the foundations of safety and weapons handling. Following that, there will be activities with discussions of specific skills accompanied by live fire drills to experience them.

Material covered will include: Range safety, equipment, drawing from a holster from concealment, types of reloads, malfunction clearances, competition range commands and procedures, drawing while seated, turn and draw, tactical priority/sequence target engagement, correct use of cover, shooting while moving, reloading while moving, strong and weak hand shooting, and going through a doorway. If time and interest permit, we have a bit of fun after with a couple of moving (reactive) targets. *Note: Moving things add another whole level of complexity that is common in competition, and the real world.*

Alec Libante is the lead instructor for this class. This class is offered on the second Saturday of the month and starts at 08:30! Typically is finished around 13:00. Participants should be at the range by 08:00!

Class size is limited to 10 participants.
