### **Focus on Veterinary & Human Healthcare**

  Sperrin Mountains and is a 4th generation family run sheep farm.

### **Focus on the Community & Culture**

- Explore some of the iconic sites of Ireland, including Guinness Storehouse, Cliffs of Moher, and the Titanic Belfast exhibit.
- Visit **Merry Ploughboy Pub** where you can enjoy a farewell dinner and some traditional music.
- Enjoy walking tours through a variety of locations including the Derry Walls, the heart of this historic city, dating back to the seventeenth century. Your tour through Galway will start at Eyre Square and finish at the Claddagh.
- Visit the Connacht Distillery, the result of a dream shared by four men (three Americans and one Irishman) to bring single malt pot still Irish whiskey back to the West of Ireland after an absence of over 100 years.
