- 1. <u>Superintendent Reza Namin:</u> Introduced himself to the selectman and spoke about the upcoming school budget and the impact it would have on the property taxes.
- 2. **Roll Call:** Selectwoman Robin Cyr, Selectman Doug Dixon and Selectwoman Melissa Patterson.
- 3. <u>Secretary's Report</u>: Selectwoman Cyr motioned to accept, Selectman Dixon seconded.
- 4. Accessing and Abatements: None
- 5. Citizens Concerns: None
- 6. <u>New Business</u>: River Herring Ordinance: Motioned to accept Selectwoman Patterson, seconded by Selectwoman Cyr. All in favor.
- 7. **Transfer Station Agreement:** There will be additional discussions on upcoming renewal of transfer station contract.
- 8. <u>Public Hearing on Subdivision on the East Benton Road:</u> Neighbors have been notified via certified mail of the upcoming Public Meeting and Planning Board Meeting.
- 9. Old Business: Mowing Contract: There has been additional task assigned to the 2019 contract. The pay would be weekly instead of monthly.
- 10. **Pump Station Upgrade**; Snowden Engineering was waiting on a price for a part. Once they receive it they will put the job up for bid. Selectwoman Cyr was looking into grants to help with cost.
- 11. <u>Sewer Fee Increase</u>: Robin Patterson asked about the increase. The increase was implemented in September and was added to the January bill.
- 12. <u>Pump Station Talk</u>: Snowden Engineering will give an update on the Center Line Survey, Core drilling and the companies that are interested.

- 13. Walking Trail, Crummet Street Update: The town will be looking to add 4 new parking spaces and to pave the lot.
- 14. **Bog Road Bridge**: The Economic Development Committee will look at details at the next meeting. Also it is a TIF district.
- 15. **LED Lighting:** Selectman Dixon stated he will bring details to the next selectman's meeting and that the saving should be huge.
