My feelings of helplessness and deep sadness cannot even be expressed in words. We finally laid Sadie to her rest on March 25th. Then a cloud of paralyzing grief, despair, and depression was threatening to engulf me. I have never felt so alone and desperate. After many tears and much prayer, I visited the Friends of Stokes website. As I looked at all those cute little faces, one caught my attention. The face I had been looking for in my mind's eye, "Lillibeth"!

I set up a meet & greet, but I felt it did not go well. She just wasn't interested. The staff encouraged me to come back, to be patient, to spend more time, and to let her come to me on her own terms. Their advice really paid off.

I spent many hours just sitting on the floor with Lillibeth in her kennel. During that same week at home, I cleaned her crate, washed blankets and bowls, re-dog-proofed the house and the yard. The day she offered me her paw and licked me in the face, I floated to my car! I just want to thank God first of all for finding her for me. (I changed her name to Grace) I also want to express my gratitude to Friends of Stokes, their financial supporters, and both shelters. (Everyone who is invoiced in this endeavor), for saving not only these precious creatures but also the humans who adopt them.

Grace has been here for a month, settling right in, being gentle and attentive to my fragile weak husband. And as for me she is lazer focused on loving me and just content to be with me. She has been suca a solace and sweet companion, actually enabling me to be a better caregiver. The love, laughter, and loyalty they give us is priceless.
