“When Jesus Borrows Your Boat”

Parts 1-2 Loaning to God & There’s No Free Fish

Read Luke 5:1-11

(Monday)

Simon Peter and his partners had fished all night and caught nothing. Do you suppose he felt like getting back in the boat when Jesus asked?

When was a time when Jesus asked you to do something and you just didn’t feel like it, but later was glad you did it?

(Tuesday)

In part 1, Pastor Todd made the statement, “It’s never about the boat, it’s always about you.” What do you think that means?

(Wednesday)

Read vs. 4 again. Has there been times that Jesus was leading you somewhere, but you didn’t really know what He wanted?

In vs. 5 we see Simon doesn’t really want to fish, but reluctantly agrees because Jesus asked. Have you ever been somewhat reluctant to obey Jesus’ requests?

(Thursday)

Why do you think Jesus would tell the fisherman, “Don’t be afraid” in verse 10?

Can you recall a “scary moment” when you did something Jesus asked you to do?

In verse 8, what do you think it was that “Peter saw”?
