The newly formed Carolina Cardinals Optimist Club has signed a contract with the Adopt-A-Highway Program to be responsible for cleaning The Plaza between Eastway and Milton Roads. Part of the reason for selecting this street is that is runs in front of Briarwood Academy and that is one of our partner schools. It also is in front of Greater Bethel AME Church who has been gracious enough to let us meet there for our first couple meetings.

We are only required to clean 4 times a year, so we have elected to do this quarterly unless we see a need to do additional cleanups.

Signs with our name on them will be posted at each end of the street designating it as ours. The signs will let people know that there is an Optimist Club in the Community. We are hoping to get a few more members, but we would like to stay under 25 to be classified as a small club.

We have not selected our dates to do the cleanup yet because all persons wishing to help us must sign a form with the State and it has to be submitted to Raleigh before they can clean the street. We will be provided reflective vests, trash bags and gloves to do the cleanup. We are suggesting checking the weather on the day of our cleanup to determine how to dress.
