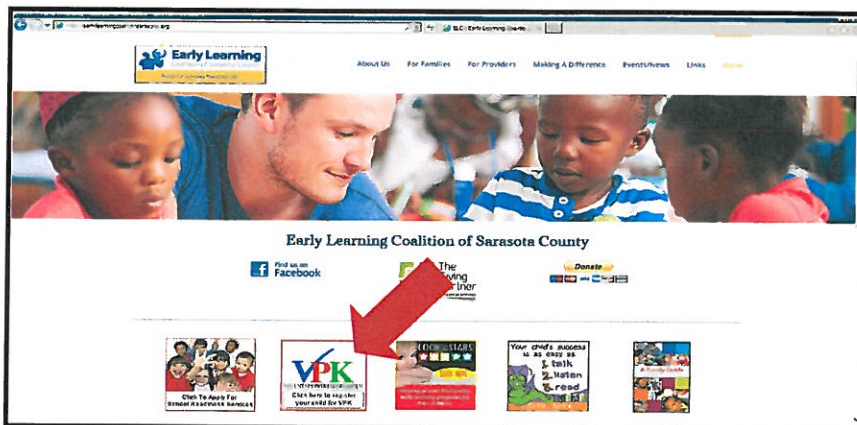
VPK is a FREE program to prepare every Florida four-year-old\* for kindergarten and build a strong foundation for continued educational success. \*Exceptions may apply.

You will need to upload two documents to complete your online application:

**1. One Document for Proof of your Child's Age:**

- Birth Certificate (original or certified copy **NOT** hospital issued birth certificate)
- Current immunization record from the Health Department
- Passport or other non-citizen documents issued by the United States
- Certificate of Baptism (original or certified copy)
- Religious record of birth with a notarized statement from parent OR Religious Exemption document
- Life insurance policy for the child (must have been in effect for at least 2 years)
- Valid military dependent identification card

**2. One Document for Proof of Parent's Current Address (must show your COMPLETE address with city, state and zip code, and be in the parent's name with whom the child resides):**

- Current FPL or water bill (**most recent**)
- Florida Driver's License or Florida ID Card with current address
- Current pay stubs (**most recent**)
- Vehicle registration
- Residential rental agreement (Rental only, **NOT** mortgage), **signed by tenant and landlord**
- Property tax assessment showing a homestead exemption
- Letter from homeless shelter or (SPARCC)

Regular postal mail or post office addresses are **NOT** acceptable as documentation.
