Misleading Finals

James Madison (+11) shocked North Carolina 70-50. However, North Carolina did have a 616-611 yard edge. JMU got a blocked punt TD and an interception return TD.

Auburn (-2.5) lost to Arkansas 24-14. The Tigers had a 431-334 yard edge but were done in by 5 turnovers for the 2nd time in 3 weeks (vs Cal).

Jacksonville State was +5 in TO's in their 44-7 win over Southern Miss.

UL-Lafayette (+1.5) lost to Tulane 41-33. However, ULL had a 413-355 yard edge but were -2 in TO's including a "Pick 6". Tulane also got a 94-yard kickoff return TD to open up the second half.

Utah led Oklahoma State 22-3 in the middle of the fourth quarter.

Memphis (-9) was upset by Navy 56-44. However, Memphis had a 659-566 edge.

Eastern Michigan got a 99-yard fumble return TD and a blocked punt TD in their 36-0 win over St. Francis (PA).

SMU (+1) beat TCU 66-42. However, TCU had a 480-375 yard edge but were done in by a -4 TO margin. SMU got a 51-yard fumble return TD, a 69-yard punt return TD and a 60-yard interception return TD.

Michigan lost to Boston College 23-19. However, MSU had a 368-292 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

Cal (+2.5) lost to Florida State 14-9. However, Cal had a 410-284 yard edge but missed two short FG's.

Fresno State (-12) beat New Mexico 38-21. However, New Mexico had a 485-345 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

BYU (+7) crushed Kansas State 38-9. Upon closer review, Kansas State had a 367-241 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. Kansas State led 6-0 with 2:30 left in the second quarter. By 10:45 left in the third quarter, they trailed 31-6 as BYU got a 30-yard fumble return TD and a 90-yard fumble return TD.

Bad Beats

East Carolina (+7.5) led Liberty 17-0 in the middle of the 2Q. They had a first and goal but ended up missing a field goal. In the second half they got stopped on downs at the Liberty 31-yard line and also fumbled at the Liberty 19-yard line. They still led 24-21 entering the 4Q. Liberty got a TD and then instead of taking a knee got a 21-yard TD run in the final minutes to win 35-24.



Michigan RB Kael Mullings rushed for 159 yards and 2 TD's in No. 18 Michigan's 27-24 upset over No. 11 USC last Saturday. Mullings got the game-winning TD run on 4th and goal with 37 seconds left. The Wolverines found a way to win despite only passing for 32 yards.

Baylor (+2.5) led Colorado 31-24 with 2:19 left. The Bears would miss a 45-yard FG. Colorado went 72 yards in 8 plays including a 43-yard "Hail Mary" TD pass on the final play to force OT. After a Colorado TD made it 38-31, Baylor fumbled at the goal line to end the game.

Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, September 26th

Army 29 TEMPLE 18. Army is 3-0 both straight up and ATS. Their defense is allowing just 9.3 ppg (No. 7). They're facing a Temple that has struggled with turnovers this year (-10 margin) but the Owls did pull off the upset vs Utah State last week. This is only the 10th time since 1990 that Army is a double-digit road favorite. We lean Temple.

Friday, September 27th

MIAMI, FL 37 Virginia Tech 19. We thought the Canes would be improved this year but not a National Title contender. They are No. 3 in the country in yards per play margin and yards per game margin. QB Cam Ward has thrown more TD passes (14) than anyone. They're taking on a 2-2 VT team that has lost twice as a favorite this year. This is only the 10th time since 1997 that VT is catching 2 TD's or more.

RUTGERS 23 Washington 21. Both have impressed us so far this season. Washington is No. 12 in ypp and ypg margins and off a win and cover over Northwestern. Rutgers took a lot of money in the market last week and won outright at VT. Short week and a long travel spot for UW but statistically they are the better team.

Saturday, September 28th

Eastern Michigan 31 KENT STATE 17. Kent State has played the toughest schedule so far but have paid the price as they are dead last in ypp, ypg and ppg margins. They are 0-4 ATS with an average non-cover of 15.3 ppg! They also lost their top 2 QB's for the season to injury. EMU is 4-0 ATS covering by 9.4 ppg. Since 1990, this is only the 6th time EMU has been a double-digit road favorite.

Liberty 30 APPALACHIAN STATE 28. Appalachian St failed to cover the spread by 6 TD's last week in their 48-14 loss at home to South Alabama as 8-point favorites. Their defense is allowing 7.0 ypp (No. 129). Liberty is 4-0 straight up but 1-3 ATS and had a very fortunate cover last week (see page 1). This is just the 5th time App State has been a home underdog since joining the FBS a decade ago.

EAST CAROLINA 27 Utsa 26. ECU has been the better team so far at +1.2 in ypp margin while UTSA is -0.9. ECU backers did suffer a bad beat last week as they blew a 17-0 lead vs Liberty in a game that was delayed 4 hours. However, it's tough trusting a ECU team that struggles with TO's. Our numbers lean UTSA here.

CLEMSON 40 Stanford 18. Since losing 34-3 to Georgia in the opener, Clemson's offense has scored 56 and 45 points in the FIRST HALF of their last two games. Stanford is off the big upset win at Syracuse but is travelling across the country again here. We bet Clemson and OVER on the open but the market has caught up.

GEORGIA STATE 30 Georgia Southern 29. Georgia State has won 3 of the last 4 meetings but Georgia Southern won 44-27 last year. Georgia St is off a bye after their big upset win over Vanderbilt. They are -0.9 in ypp margin but Georgia Southern is actually -2.6. Georgia State opened a 3-point underdog but now find themselves a 3.5-point favorite. We'd lean Georgia Southern at the current numbers.

NC STATE 30 Northern Illinois 21. After their historic win over Notre Dame, Northern Illinois was predictably flat vs Buffalo and lost outright as a 13-point favorite in OT. The Huskies still out-gained the Bulls by 175 yards and are No. 11 in ypg margin this season. NC State is 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 16.4 ppg. We bet them this week though as we liked what we saw from them in the second half vs Clemson.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 27 San Diego State 25. San Diego State comes in off the bye. Their offense has struggled ranking No. 117 in yards per game and scoring. Meanwhile, CMU is off a comeback win over Ball State. We bet UNDER especially with San Diego State's QB being a question mark.

WAKE FOREST 30 UL-Lafayette 27. Wake Forest is off a bye and needs a win if they are going to have any bowl hopes this season. This is their 4th straight home game. ULL deserved better vs Tulane as the Green Wave scored two non-offensive TD's vs them. Wake and the OVER have taken the money so far. We bet Wake.

JAMES MADISON 38 Ball State 20. JMU comes in off one of their biggest wins in school history. They put a 70-spot on North Carolina as 11-point underdogs and don't look now but we project them to be favored in all of their remaining games. Meanwhile, Ball State is allowing 8.9 yards per play (No. 134) and 532 yards per game on defense (No. 133). We bet OVER.

DUKE 28 North Carolina 27. North Carolina has won 5 straight in the rivalry. The Tar Heels come in off one of their most embarrassing losses in school history as they allowed 70 points to James Madison. This is likely Mack Brown's final season. Duke is 4-0 under new coach Manny Diaz but the schedule has been soft. We bet NC and the OVER on the openers.

OHIO 29 Akron 18. Ohio QB Parker Navarro did not play in last week's blowout loss to Kentucky. We think he will be back here. Akron's offense has been struggling ranking No. 129 in yards per play. However, they have played 3 Power conference teams already. We bet Akron on the openers.

INDIANA 30 Maryland 24. We've upgraded Indiana more than any other team in our power ratings so far this season. The 4-0 Hoosiers are No. 6 in ypp margin, No. 5 in ypg margin and No. 6 in scoring margin. Obviously, Maryland hasn't been as impressive and can ill afford to drop to 0-2 in Big Ten play but the Terps have played the tougher schedule.

CONNECTICUT 27 Buffalo 20. Since getting destroyed by Maryland in the opener, Connecticut is 3-0 ATS covering those games by 26 points per game. Last week they destroyed FAU 48-14 while rushing for 421. They're catching Buffalo off the big upset win over NIU in overtime last week. The Bulls were out-gained by 175 yards in that one. We like UConn here.

MIAMI, OH 34 Massachusetts 14. Miami, OH is 0-3 but have played Northwestern, Cincinnati and Notre Dame tough. They're taking a major step down in class here vs a UMass team that almost lost to FCS Central Connecticut last week. We bet Miami on the openers.

CENTRAL FLORIDA 38 Colorado 24. Colorado's prayers were answered last week as they hit a "Hail Mary" on the final play of regulation and then Baylor fumbled at the goal line in OT. The schedule gets much tougher from here on out starting with a 3-0 UCF team fresh off a bye. The Knights rank No. 8 in ypg margin and No. 9 in scoring margin. UCF took a lot of professional money earlier this week.

MARSHALL 28 Western Michigan 25. Both teams have played tough schedules so far but WMU his +0.3 in ypp margin while Marshall is -0.1. Marshall QB Stone Earle got banged up in last week's game at Ohio State while WMU is fresh off a bye. We bet WMU.

BOWLING GREEN 30 Old Dominion 22. BG's last two performances were impressive. They lost at Top 10 Penn State by 7 and then followed that up with a 6-point loss at Kyle Field to Texas A&M last week. Yes, they're 1-2 but the Falcons could be the best team in the MAC this season. ODU is 0-3 and off a bye. Their offense has struggled averaging just 4.4 yards per play (No. 127). We do like the spot here for them though.

BOSTON COLLEGE 32 Western Kentucky 21. Bill O'Brien continues to impress in year one as the Eagles are 3-1 after their dramatic win over Michigan State last week. WKU has won 3 straight since losing to Alabama and got a big come-from-behind win over Toledo last week. WKU is capable of a back-door here.

Nebraska 31 PURDUE 20. Nebraska lost a heart-breaker to Illinois last week in OT. It's nothing new to Nebraska as the Huskers are now on a 8-31 run in one-possession games. We don't think this one will be decided by one-possession though as Purdue was run over for the 2nd week in a row allowing 341 yards rushing to Oregon State.

SMU 27 Florida State 23. FSU got their first win of the season last week albeit they were out-gained 410-284 by Cal and benefited from a pair of short missed FG's. SMU scored 3 non-offensive TD's in their big rivalry win over TCU last week. This is their ACC debut in what should be a good home atmosphere. We bet the Noles here.

OLE MISS 35 Kentucky 17. Ole Miss has the best offense in the country as the Rebels rank No. 1 in yards per play (8.9), yards per game (670.8) and points per game (55.0). They have the best point differential (+198) through 4 games in SEC history! This will be their toughest test though as Kentucky nearly upset Georgia two weeks ago. Each of the team's last 3 meetings have been decided by 3 points or less. We don't expect that here but do expect Ole Miss' closest result.

KANSAS STATE 30 Oklahoma State 25. Both teams come in off losses and can ill afford another. Oklahoma State was dominated more than the final vs Utah as they trailed 22-3 in the middle of the fourth quarter. Meanwhile, Kansas State led BYU 6-0 late 2Q. By 10:45 left in the 3Q, they trailed 31-6 as BYU got turnovers and a pair of non-offensive TD's. We think Kansas State is the right side here.

TEXAS TECH 30 Cincinnati 27. Cincinnati has been the more impressive team so far in the box score as the Bearcats are +1.1 in yards per play margin while Texas Tech is flat despite playing a similar strength of schedule. What would this line be had Cincy held on vs Pitt (blew a 27-6 lead) and Texas Tech not held on vs Abilene Christian (won 52-51 in OT). Value on Cincy on the openers.

† **KANSAS 30 Tcu 28.** Kansas is playing their conference home games in Arrowhead this year (47 miles away). Both teams are 0-4 ATS and both teams' seasons are on the line here. We trust Leipold more than Sonny Dykes who was ejected in last week's loss to SMU.

TULANE 33 South Florida 28. For the 2nd time this season, USF played a Top 10 team tough but the final score doesn't reflect it. Miami out-scored them 28-0 in the second half last week. Tulane scored a couple of non-offensive TD's to win at UL-Lafayette last week.

UTAH 30 Arizona 17. Utah's win last week over Oklahoma State is not getting enough love nationally. With a backup QB on the road, they led 22-3 in the middle of the fourth quarter. Arizona has not impressed this year at 0-3 ATS. Both teams are running very slow tempos as Arizona is No. 125 in plays per minute while Utah is No. 128. We bet the UNDER.

BOISE STATE 36 Washington State 28. This is a very important game in the playoff chase. 4-0 Wazzu could be favored in all of their remaining games if they pull the upset here. Meanwhile, Boise State is the best team in the power ratings among Group of 5 teams and they have a quality loss (by 3 at Oregon). Boise should be well-rested off a bye and a blowout win over FCS Portland State while the Cougars went to double-overtime vs San Jose State, a week after an emotional win vs Washington.

† **Texas State 32 Sam Houston State 24.** @NRG Stadium in Houston, TX. Good game here with a pair of 1-loss G5 teams. Texas State is off a bye after blowing a 14-point lead vs Arizona State. We project them to be favored in all of their remaining games so there is plenty to play for here. Sam Houston has already matched their win total from last year and is thinking bowl game and conference title.

Navy 30 UAB 29. Navy comes in off the big upset of Memphis where they put up 56 points and 566 yards (did allow 659 yards). Their new OC Drew Cronin has been a revelation as they are averaging 307 rush ypg (just 195 last year). UAB did have two weeks to prep but the market has been all over Navy here going from +1 to -3.5.

MEMPHIS 42 Middle Tennessee 17. MT is 0-4 ATS under new coach Derek Mason failing to cover by 14.6 ppg. Their defense ranks in the bottom 5 in yards per play, yards per game and scoring. They're catching what should be an angry Memphis team off an upset loss to Navy. Keep an eye to the sky for remnants of Hurricane Helene.

TEXAS 49 Mississippi State 12. Texas is 4-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 12.3 points per game. Mississippi State could be the worst non-Vandy team in the SEC in decades. The Bulldogs are down to a backup QB after Blake Shapen was injured. Not good news for them facing a Texas defense that ranks No. 1 in scoring allowing 5.5 points per game. Whether it's Arch Manning or Quinn Ewers, we expect Texas to roll here.

BAYLOR 25 BYU 24. BYU is 4-0 ATS with an average cover margin of 18.3 ppg. The Cougars come in off the upset of Kansas State last week where they scored 31 points in less than 7 minutes of game action. They're catching a Baylor team off a disastrous loss to Colorado where they gave up a "Hail Mary" TD on the final play of regulation. The market loves Baylor here. We lean BYU at the current numbers.

LSU 43 South Alabama 20. LSU is 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 10.4 points per game. The Tigers aren't overwhelming in any area and actually rank No. 84 in yards per play margin. They're catching a red-hot South Alabama team that has covered their last two games by a combined 82 points! LSU has played the much more difficult schedule and we bet them on the openers.

Iowa State 26 HOUSTON 14. Houston's offense has been a mess this year averaging just 13 points per game (No. 129) and they were shut-out last week at Cincinnati. They're taking on an Iowa State defense that is allowing just 9.7 ppg. We like the UNDER here.

RICE 28 Charlotte 21. Both teams have left a lot to be desired so far this season. They are a combined 0-6 vs FBS teams. Charlotte ranks No. 126 in ypg margin (-129.0) while Rice's offense is averaging just 316 ypg (No. 116). We bet Charlotte and OVER on Sunday but don't have much interest at the current number.

Oklahoma 25 AUBURN 24. The season is on the line here for both teams after tough home losses last week. Michael Hawkins will be making his first career start here after the Sooners benched Jackson Arnold in last week's game vs Tennessee. Auburn already benched their QB Payton Thorne two weeks ago. The turnovers have still continued. Hugh Freeze is 8-12 straight up in his last 20 games as a head coach despite being favored in 14 of those 20 games.

TROY 29 UL-Monroe 18. The market seems to love ULM here. They have a couple of impressive wins vs Jackson State and UAB but we think they're still an unknown commodity. Meanwhile, Troy seems to be getting better after the upset loss to Nevada in the opener. Our numbers like Troy here more than any other side this week.

NORTH TEXAS 36 Tulsa 29. Tulsa got an OT win at Louisiana Tech last week as a small underdog. The Golden Hurricane are +0.9 in ypp margin this year. Meanwhile, North Texas blew out Wyoming and are +0.8 in ypp margin (have played a tougher schedule than Tulsa). We haven't bet side or total here.

UNLV 27 Fresno State 23. Huge news coming out of this game late Tuesday night. UNLV starting QB Matthew Sluka has quit the team due to a NIL payment dispute. UNLV was one of our favorite bets of the week. Sluka led the Rebels in rushing but was completing just 43% of his passes. We actually like the backup QB Hajj-Malik Williams who was a 3-year starter at Campbell. He has 8,200 career passing yards and 1,678 career rushing yards. We still would bet UNLV here at the current numbers!

Oregon 38 UCLA 16. Oregon comes in off a bye. The Ducks finally lived up to their preseason billing in their blowout win at Oregon State prior. Meanwhile, we were impressed with UCLA last week as they were tied with LSU at halftime 17-17 before falling 34-17. This is still an offense that ranks No. 123 in ypp and won't be able to keep up.

† **Texas A&M 27 Arkansas 24.** @AT&T Stadium in Arlington, TX. Huge game in the SEC here as both teams are looking for a 2-0 start to conference play. Texas A&M has won 11 of the last 12 meetings. Arkansas has been the more impressive team in the stats so far at +1.5 in ypp margin vs A&M +0.7. It does look like A&M will go back to QB Conner Weigman here. We bet Arkansas.

NOTRE DAME 24 Louisville 18. We thought we would be betting Louisville in this matchup. Then the Georgia Tech performance happened where Louisville got a blocked FG TD and a fumble recovery TD for a fortunate 31-19 win and cover. ND has been "Jekyll and Hyde" so far this season but have certainly played a tougher schedule so far. They have revenge for an upset loss to Louisville last year.

PENN STATE 34 Illinois 16. Illinois got the upset win at Nebraska last week and are a surprising 4-0. QB Luke Altmyer is one of the most improved QB's in the country. Last year Altmyer had a 13-to-10 TD-to-INT ratio...this year it is 10-to-0 so far. Penn State is off a blowout win over lowly Kent State. We know the Nittany Lions are good but are they great. This is a good data point to

MICHIGAN 26 Minnesota 15. Michigan comes in off the big win over USC last week where they scored on 4th & Goal in the final minute. RB Mullings was the star with the Wolverines only throwing for 32 yards. Minnesota is making their first road trip of the season. They are a disappointing 2-2. Minnesota is better in the stats but Michigan has played the much tougher schedule. We're fading the market move.

USC 32 Wisconsin 18. Wisconsin comes in off the bye. QB Van Dyke is out for the season and Locke will get the start here. USC blew it late vs Michigan last week. The Trojans took some body blows with several players dinged up. Can they continue to hold up in a more physical conference? We lean Wisconsin.

Louisiana Tech 28 FIU 26. LT comes in off the OT loss to Tulsa. This is an important game for head coach Cumbie who is just 7-20 here. FIU is off an upset loss to FCS Monmouth in the final seconds. We lean OVER here as both teams rank in the Top 50 for plays per minute.

Georgia 25 ALABAMA 23. The biggest game of the year so far in CFB. Both teams 3-0, both off a bye. Possibly more intrigue this year with Nick Saban no longer on the Crimson Tide sidelines. Alabama under Saban had gotten the best of Kirby Smart over the years including last year's SEC Championship game. Will that change here with DeBoer in charge? Alabama is +4.0 in yards per play margin while Georgia is +3.4. However, Georgia has played the tougher schedule and the Clemson performance has aged well. Can the Alabama OL hold up? Will Georgia find some play-makers at the skill positions outside QB Beck? More questions than answers at this point. Just because it's the biggest game of the year doesn't mean it's the best value of the year. We haven't bet side or total this week.

New Mexico 31 NEW MEXICO STATE 24. New Mexico has played the tougher schedule so far and is -1.5 in yards per play while New Mexico State is -2.9. New Mexico has the much better QB and head coach but we're not wild about the current price.

Ohio State 36 MICHIGAN STATE 13. The first reasonable test for Ohio State who has been 35-plus point favorites in every game so far. MSU has played the tougher schedule and ranks in the Top 25 in ypp and ypp margins. However, Spartans QB Chiles needs to take care of the football (4-to-7 ratio) for MSU to keep it close.

Air Force 19 WYOMING 18. One of the ugliest games of the day. Neither team has covered a point spread so far this season and Wyoming is notably failing to cover by 19.1 points per game (worst in country). A lot of early money on AF. We lean with the Pokes.

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

This year's record is 7-11 so far. Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Michigan -9**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Betting CFB Openers

Every Sunday in Vegas at 11am PT, Circa Sports is the first book in the world to release CFB lines and we bet them every week. We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). Last year we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Below is some of what we bet already. Starting last season, Fan Duel and Draft Kings have been releasing select CFB games a couple hours before Circa so those bets are included below as well.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Dallas 24 N.Y. GIANTS 20. Both teams come in at 1-2 although the Giants should be feeling better about themselves having just upset Cleveland 21-15 as 6.5-point road underdogs. It was a legit result with the Giants holding the Browns to 217 yards and 3.4 yards per play. Meanwhile, the Cowboys are off back-to-back home losses. The final looked respectable vs Baltimore but that was after a huge 4Q. We know Dallas has dominated the series winning 13 of the last 14 but we can't get near this current number.

Sunday, September 29th

ATLANTA 23 New Orleans 20. Both teams come in off disappointing home losses. New Orleans was dominated in the box score by Philadelphia as they were out-gained 460-219 and were -2.9 in yards per play. That's the same Philly team that Atlanta beat on the road on MNF the week prior. Meanwhile, Atlanta missed some opportunities to upset Kansas City on SNF. Atlanta is +0.8 in ypp margin on the season and has played the tougher schedule than New Orleans who is +0.6. We lean Atlanta.

INDIANAPOLIS 20 Pittsburgh 19. Pittsburgh is 3-0 on the season despite a 0.0 yards per play margin. They took advantage of an injury to Chargers QB Herbert last week and rallied for the win. Meanwhile, Indy is +1.0 in ypp margin. They're off their first win of the season and are playing their 3rd home game in 4 weeks while Pittsburgh is playing their 3rd road game in 4 weeks. Indy outright.

HOUSTON 27 Jacksonville 20. The Jags have been one of the biggest disappointments in the NFL so far especially after that no-show on MNF vs the Bills. Jacksonville actually took a lot of the bigger money in that game only to get crushed. Meanwhile, Houston is 0-3 ATS on the season and off a 34-7 loss to Minnesota. It was misleading as they had a 296-274 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. We think they get their first cover here.

GREEN BAY 23 Minnesota 21. The Packers somehow went 2-0 with Jordan Love at QB. Matt LeFleur does not get enough credit for being a Top 5 coach in the NFL. Love likely returns here but won't be 100%. He will be facing a blitz-heavy Minnesota defense that has played a big role in their 3-0 start to the season both straight up and ATS. We lean Minnesota here but prefer them in a teaser.

Cincinnati 25 CAROLINA 22. Cincinnati has lost outright twice this season at home as a TD-plus favorite. Somehow the Bengals are 0-3 on the season despite a +0.6 ypp margin. Andy Dalton just ended Bryce Young's career with that performance last week. A lot of Young apologists complained he had no weapons and then Dalton goes out and throws for 319 yards and 3 TD's in their upset win over the Raiders. Can't lay points here with a Cincy team that has proven nothing while the Panthers season could be on the rebound.

CHICAGO 21 L.A. Rams 20. The Bears come in after a pair of road losses. Rookie QB Caleb Williams did play his best game yet (not saying much) as he threw for 363 yards. However, he took 4 sacks and threw 2 INT's. They're taking on a Rams team that has new life after an upset win over San Francisco last week. It was a misleading final as the 49ers had a 425-296 yard edge. Not sure how you lay points here with the Bears with the Rams having the edge at HC and QB.

N.Y. JETS 23 Denver 16. Denver got their first win of the season last week upsetting the Bucs 26-7 as 6-point underdogs. Denver had a 352-223 yard edge and were +1.5 in yards per play so it was a legit win. Meanwhile, the Jets have extra rest after crushing the Patriots on Thursday Night Football 24-3. The Broncos have played a tough schedule so far and are +0.1 in yards per play. We lean with them here getting the hook especially with a low total.

Philadelphia 23 TAMPA BAY 20. Philly rebounded nicely with a road win at New Orleans last week. The Eagles dominated the box score including a 460-219 yard edge and a 6.9-4.0 ypp edge. They face a Tampa team that was embarrassed by Denver 26-7 as 6-point home favorites. Philly has played the much tougher schedule so far and is -0.1 in ypp margin while Tampa is -0.9. We lean Philly.

ARIZONA 27 Washington 22. Washington is better than expected so far this season but this is a tough spot for them. They're on a short week after the MNF road upset of the Bengals as 7.5-point underdogs. In that game, Washington was out-gained 436-356 and were -1.1 in yards per play. Arizona is +0.5 in ypp margin and has played a tough schedule including 3 playoff teams from last year.

SAN FRANCISCO 24 New England 13. The 49ers limp in at 1-2 after suffering back-to-back road losses. They outgained the Rams 425-296 but lost outright as 6-point road favorites. While they are banged up, we don't mind laying the big number here vs a Patriots team that seems to get worse by the week. Last week they were destroyed by the Jets as they were outgained 400-139 and were -2.8 in yards per play.

LAS VEGAS 19 Cleveland 18. We're not a fan of either team right now. Both come in off home upset losses. The Browns fell to the Giants 21-15 as they were outgained 340-217. QB Deshaun Watson has been sacked 16 times so far this season. Only Bryce Young has a worse QBR. The Browns offense has yet to hit 20 points. What a disaster. On the other side, the Raiders fell to the Panthers 36-22 as they allowed 319 yards passing from Andy Dalton. Cleveland will have a ton of fans in the stands and their defense is the most trusted unit. Cleveland is a good teaser option with the total super low.

Kansas City 24 L.A. CHARGERS 16. It is likely that Justin Herbert will be out for this game. He's worth at least 5 points to the line as KC opened a 3-point favorite in this game on the look-aheads. You saw that offense collapse without him last week in Pittsburgh much to our dismay. KC is 3-0 on the season but the Chiefs have won 3 "coin-flip" games and are -0.3 in ypp margin. The Without Herbert, the Chargers are a bottom 3 team in the league so we're passing here.

BALTIMORE 25 Buffalo 22. The power ratings don't support it but this seems like a good spot for Baltimore. The Bills come in 3-0 "fat and happy" after destroying the Jags on MNF. Who have they played though so far this season? Meanwhile, after a couple of disappointing last-second losses, the Ravens got their first win last week in Dallas and have a chance to really right their season here.

Monday, September 30th

MIAMI 19 Tennessee 18. Both teams are 0-3 ATS on the season. We're not sure if there was a more pathetic performance than the Titans last week. In desperation mode at 0-2 and facing a backup QB that you released from your team, the Packers blew them out. However, the Titans are only -0.2 in ypp margin as their first two losses were misleading vs the Bears and Jets. They take on a Miami team that managed just 205 yards and 3 points with Skylar Thompson at QB. We don't expect to be involved in this game.

DETROIT 25 Seattle 21. The Seahawks have played the easiest schedule so far in the NFL. They played a rookie QB making his first start (Bo Nix), a rookie head coach (Jerod Mayo) and a backup QB (Skylar Thompson). Now they go to what has become one of the most intimidating atmospheres in the NFL. Although the Lions did lose outright in their last home game. Seattle has a +1.0 yards per play better margin and the early money is on them here due to some injuries on Detroit. We'll pass for now.
