Financial Report

Tasha Beghtol reviewed the financial summaries and the monthly postings report from Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center. The report now shows both Muscatine and DHLW finances for FY25. Muscatine 6 month contracts are reflected in a new column. The Muscatine bank account has been closed and funds transferred. CIJDC reported that the account was \$0.13 short. The difference will be applied to EC Interest. Tasha Beghtol noted that the shortage could have happened years ago and the amount does not warrant the time in research.

Program Presentations

Dental Services

Rachel Patterson-Rahn, Lee County Health Department, shared updates and answered questions about the dental program and services provided in Des Moines, Henry, Louisa, and Washington counties. The program has shown long-term success with reduction in decay. The region continues to be challenged by the reduced number of dentists who take Medicaid.

Preschool Scholarships

Kalisha Lutz, Community Action of SE Iowa, provided a background of the scholarship program and reviewed current program details. Enrollment is low and the program is looking at ways to provide additional support to current families. Kalisha noted that the quality criteria of IQ4K participation has been a struggle for some. The number of participating preschool has declined.

Imagination Library

Shane Orr, United Way of Muscatine, provided information about the Dolly Parton Imagination Library program serving children in Muscatine County. The program has served 1200 children and is funded through several partnerships including United Way, ECI, and Muscatine Charities.

Administrative update

A written report was provided. Additional discussion was held regarding handouts released following the ECI State Board meeting on March 7th 2025. The handouts provide information about membership requirements for the new ECI District Boards and the breakdown of proposed funding changes in FY26. Members agreed by consensus to add an April 15th DHLW+M Board meeting to the calendar.
