How do I get Started Recycling?

- Single stream recycling is currently being implemented for most recyclables. All recyclables can be mixed in the bins on the trailer **EXCEPT** for cardboard and glass. Place cardboard in the bins on front of the trailer, glass in the barrels on the back of the trailer.
- Cleanliness is very important! Rinse cans, plastic and glass containers. It's okay to leave labels on metal cans, glass and plastic.
- Paper, magazines and cardboard should be clean and dry.
- Please, no trash or plastic bags in the trailer!
- Styrofoam IS NOT recyclable!



Newspapers
 - Clean and dry



Cardboard Boxes

- corrugated and chip board
 (ie. cereal boxes)

Glass Containers

- Clear, Brown or Green
 - Remove lids and rinse



Mixed Paper

-Junk mail, office paper, shredded paper, school papers



Plastic

HDPE 2 - opaque milk bottles
 HDPE 2 - colored detergent bottles
 PETE 1 - juice and pop bottles, can be colored or clear.
 - Mixed Plastic, ie. plastic with recycle symbol #3, #4, #5, #6, #7, #8.
 - remove lids & rinse.

Tin (steel) Food Containers

- Rinse
 - Labels okay



Aluminum

- Rinse



Magazines

-Clean and dry
