AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interests of the Village of Chapin, Illinois, to retain ownership of the old and worthless items of personal property listed on <u>Appendix A</u> attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities determine that it is in the best interests of the Village of Chapin to throw away and discard the items listed on <u>Appendix A</u>.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and Board of Trustees find that the personal property listed on Appendix A, now owned by the Village of Chapin, are no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by their disposal.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the Village President is hereby directed to take all necessary action to throw away and discard the items listed on <u>Appendix A</u>.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
