

Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2024, 6:00 P.M.

1. Review/ Approve minutes.

Robert Flint moved to accept and approve September 3rd, 2024, minutes as written. Dale Minter seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the minutes.

2. Review/ Approve warrant.

Dale Miner moved to accept and approve the September 17th, 2024, warrant. Robert Flint seconded the motion. The Selectmen voted 3-0 to accept the warrant.

- Select Board Chair, Jim Dolloff suggested the Select Board scheduling interviews with the two
 individuals which have expressed interest in joining the Planning Board.
- Tom Wight, T.W. Enterprises presented the Select Board with a letter expressing bias concerns with the Planning Board. He related that two planning board members refused to sign CUPs after approval by planning board majority four months prior. Mr. Wight said that he wanted it noted, should there be problems with getting CUPs for future projects.
- Selectman, Dale Miner, although pleased with edits made to the proposed Cannabis Ordinance, still noted his concern with some of the wording. Selectman, Robert Flint, recommended passing the ordinance and consider amendments later. September 27th, 2024 was confirmed to be the expiration date for the Cannabis Moratorium.
